About Martin Park Nature Center . . .

Located at **5000 West Memorial Road**, the park rests in the section bounded by Memorial, N.W. 122nd Street, Meridian, and MacArthur. The 140-acre park serves as **an educational facility, a recreational area and a wildlife sanctuary**. Many animals make their homes in and around the various native plants in Martin Park. Birds, butterflies, squirrels, and prairie dogs are just a few of the animals in the park. Fortunate visitors may catch a glimpse of a deer, coyote, owl or armadillo. Your powers of observation, the season of the year, and luck contribute to observing the free-roaming wildlife.

Martin Park Nature Center houses a **hands-on museum, a browsing library, and the park office**. Outside the nature center, several **hiking trails** curl through woods and grasslands. One graveled trail is **wheelchair accessible**. Other trails are of gravel and packed soil, containing short stretches of moderate slopes and occasional steps, but may be easily traversed with a good pair of walking shoes.

Martin Park Nature Center is open **Wednesday through Sunday**. The nature center, park, and parking lot are closed and locked except during the **operating hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

Martin Park Nature Center requires no admission fee; self-guided hikes do not require reservations.

Martin Park Nature Center staff offers a variety of guided nature hikes. Programs include **regularly scheduled weekend guided hikes** and **special guided tours for groups**. Make your reservation for the regularly scheduled weekend hikes as soon as the topic is announced. All special guided tours require reservations; call the Naturalist at 755-0676. During spring, when hikes are very popular, call at least two months in advance. A fee of **\$2 per person (\$10 per group minimum)** is required for special guided tours. Additional fees may be charged if materials are necessary for the tour. A variety of topics for the tours are available, or you may suggest one. Current classroom lessons, requirements for scouting badges, or "What's in the park today?" describe the three most requested topics.

Martin Park Nature Center offers the **Green Earth Gang Program** for **9 to 13 year olds**. **Fees are not required**, but old clothing is recommended. The "Gang" works on **conservation projects** in Martin Park under the supervision of a Naturalist from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday during the school year. During the summer, the gang meets from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. each Friday. The summer schedule includes two hours dedicated to a work project and one hour spent in recreation. Past projects include litter control, maintaining trails, restoring native plants and repairing wildlife nest boxes.
