NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held by the City Council of the City of Oklahoma City on the **25th** day of **September, 2018, 8:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, 3rd Floor, Municipal Building, 200 North Walker Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.**

At which time and place will be heard and considered a resolution and ordinance to create the annual assessment roll of the **Downtown Oklahoma City Business Improvement District**, Oklahoma City Improvement and Special Services Assessment District Number Six (6) pursuant to the Oklahoma Improvement District Act, Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, Section 39-101 et seq., on properties located in and around downtown Oklahoma City.

Said resolution and ordinance will consider the establishment of the assessment roll to provide for improvements to include, but not be limited to, streetscape beautification, maintenance, promotion, management, economic development, identification and security, maintenance of special amenities including the underground and overhead pedestrian system, Broadway Avenue and the Bricktown Canal, and enhancements of downtown improvements.

Any person may ascertain in the Office of the City Clerk, Municipal Building, 2nd Floor, 200 North Walker Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, a description of the property to be assessed and the maximum amount of benefit estimated to be conferred on each tract or parcel of land within the district.

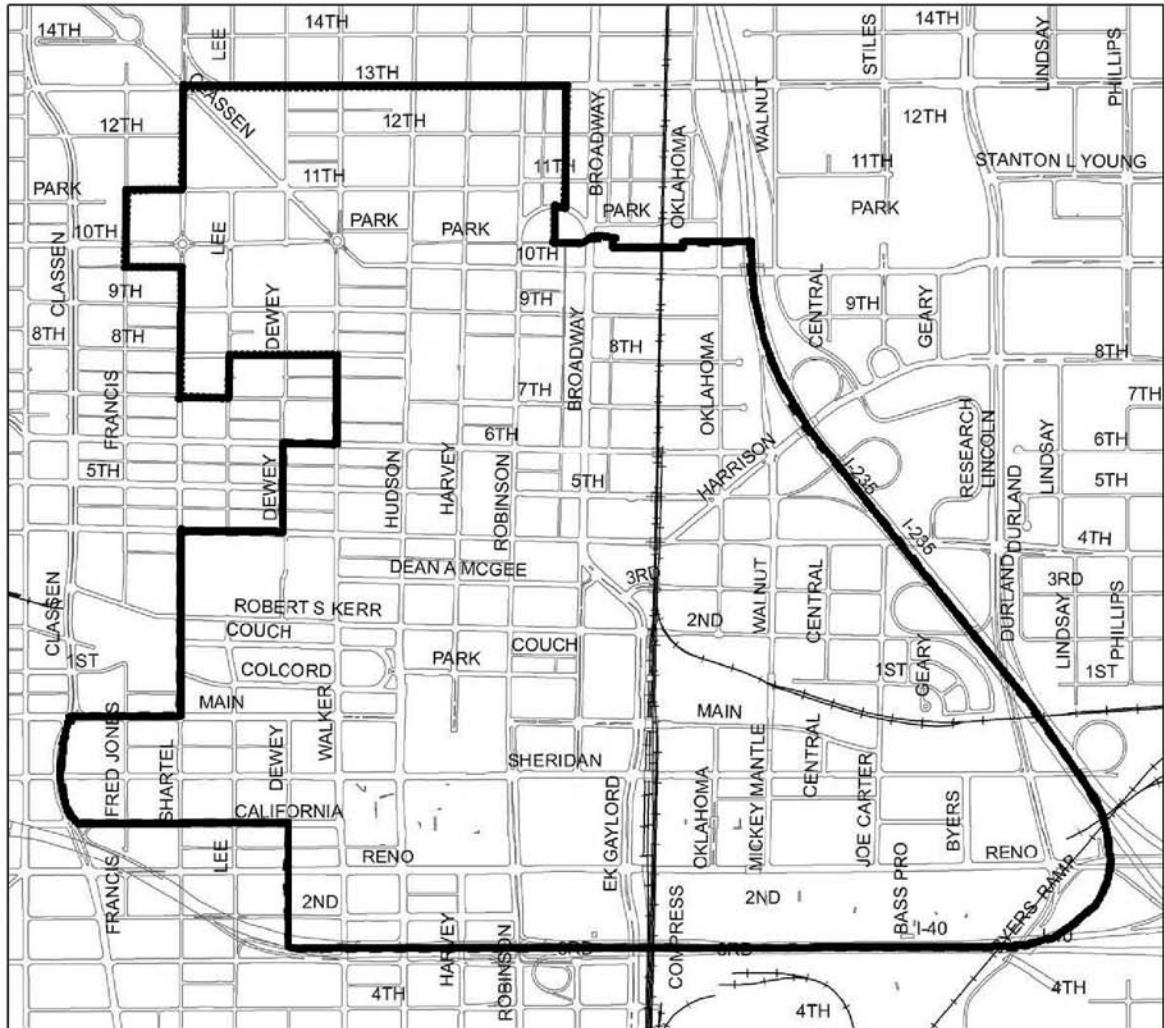
