WHO: K – 6th Graders at public schools serviced by Oklahoma City Utilities Department

WHAT: 2019 Water Conservation Fix a Leak Week Poster Contest

WHEN: Entries due April 12, 2019 at 5:00 PM, / Contest winners will be notified April 19, 2019, / Certificate Presentation April/May 2019

WHY: Drought in Oklahoma is unpredictable, and water is our most important resource. Nationally, 1 trillion gallons of water is wasted from household leaks each year. Helping children become stewards of water is essential and students learning how to identify, and report household leaks will make an impact on our local water supply and their monthly household water bills. Lessons can highlight tips like watering at the right times, planting water-wise plants, taking 5-minute showers, fixing household leaks, and washing full loads of dishes and laundry.

THEME: WaterSense® Fix a Leak Week 2019

Think about how you use water, how much you value it, and the impact of a household leak. Then draw how you, your friends, family, classmates, or community can conserve water today. We all need to do our part to squeeze every drop and use water wisely.

- 2) All posters must be drawn horizontally (landscape) on 11" x 17" white poster paper.
- 3) Students may use crayon, watercolor, poster paint, markers, ink, cut paper, tissue paper or fabric. Please do not use materials that may smear, crack or chip. Students are encouraged to use large lettering, few words, heavy lines, and vibrant colors.
- 4) Entries can be made individually or collaboratively.
- 5) Only original artwork will be accepted. Computer-generated drawings will not be considered. Reproduction of popular cartoon characters or three-dimensional work will be disqualified.
- 6) Posters will not be returned. They will remain the property of the City of Oklahoma City Utilities Department and may be reproduced.

Posters must fit the following requirements:

Poster size: 11" x 17" paper; horizontal (landscape)

Permitted Art Material: Crayon, watercolor, poster paint, markers, ink, cut paper, tissue paper, or fabric. Please do not use materials that may smear, crack or chip. Students are encouraged to use large lettering, few words, heavy lines, and strong colors.
