INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING THE CONTRACTOR PREQUALIFICATION PACKAGE TO THE PREQUALIFICATION REVIEW BOARD FOR THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY AND TRUSTS OF WHICH IT IS A BENEFICIARY

1. It is the intent of The City of Oklahoma City to update and maintain its list of prequalified contractors for construction of public improvements. As the result, the following application and procedures have been developed to better serve the City, the public and the contractors.
2. Contractors that are presently prequalified with The City of Oklahoma City will continue to be prequalified until the completion of their present prequalification period. These contractors shall submit the new prequalification application one month prior to the anniversary of the date of Prequalification.
3. Read pages iii and iv of the prequalification package to determine the class(es) of work that best describes your qualifications.
4. Fill out the Prequalification Statement of Experience and Equipment for The City of Oklahoma City. Make sure that the application is complete. An incomplete application may be returned to the contractor and which would result in a delay in review and approval of prequalification.
5. The current annual fee per classification for Prequalification is as follows:
 - \$360.00 per classification for persons with a business address and yard within a forty (40) mile radius of the City Engineer's office, 420 W. Main Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
 - \$470.00 per classification for persons with a business address or yard within the State of Oklahoma but a business address or yard outside the forty (40) mile radius from the City Engineer's office, 420 W. Main Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
 - \$1480.00 per classification for person with a business address or yard outside the State of Oklahoma.

6. The documents required for the review of the Prequalification Application include the following:

- a. Class/Subclasses of Work form.
- b. The completed Prequalification Statement of Experience and Equipment with all the required supporting documents.
 1. A letter of assurance from your bonding company. The bonding company must indicate the total amount of bonds that they are willing to execute on your behalf and provide a copy of their Power of Attorney.
 2. Full set of Financial Statements, reviewed or audited by a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) within the last 6 months or accompanied by the Contractor's certificate if the review is more than six (6) months but less than one (1) year old.
 3. Sign and notarize the Statement and Release of Financial Information
 4. Complete the "Supplement to Section 3.C.2." of the Resolution pertaining to Prequalification. The yard location option is limited to companies located within a 40 mile radius of the City Engineer's office, 420 W. Main Street, Oklahoma City, OK.
 5. Supply the contractor's identification numbers.
- c. A business check or cashier's check or money order for the application processing fee payable to: CITY TREASURER. City ordinance provides for a fee of \$20.00 to be charged on returned checks.

Omission of any of the listed documents will cause a delay in the processing of your application and additional documentation of information may be required in some instances. The Final Checklist on the cover sheet is for your use.

7. Additionally all applicable licenses must be obtained at the time of Prequalification approval. There is an associated City license with each area of Prequalification and in some instances additional State licenses are required. Licenses renew concurrently with the Prequalification period.

4. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Water Pipeline contractor “A”

(All water pipeline sizes and materials, EXCEPT steel and PCCP pipe.)

1. Applicant has water pipeline experience and successful completion of:
 - a. 1 mile, or
 - b. 2 projects with a minimum length of 1,000 linear feet, of at least 42-inches in diameter pipes; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$10 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Water Pipeline contractor “B”

(Water pipeline smaller than 42-inches in diameter and all water pipeline materials, EXCEPT steel and PCCP pipe.)

1. Applicant has water pipeline experience and successful completion of:
 - a. 1 mile, or
 - b. 2 projects of greater than 1,000 linear feet, of at least 20-inches in diameter pipes; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$5 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Water Pipeline contractor “C”

(Water pipeline from 6 to 20 inches in diameter and all water pipeline materials.)

1. Applicant has water pipeline experience and successful completion of:
 - a. 1 mile, or
 - b. 2 projects of greater than 1,000 linear feet, of at least 6 inches in diameter pipes; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$1 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Water Facilities contractor “A”

(All water facilities including WTPs, tanks, booster stations, and pump stations).

1. Applicant has experience and successful completion of at least 2 of the above described water facilities projects of:
 - a. greater than 20 million gallons per day in capacity, or

- b. \$25 million or more; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$10 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications if required.

Water Facilities contractor “B”

(Water facilities including tanks, booster stations, and raw water pump stations.)

1. Applicant has experience and successful completion of at least 2 of the above described water facilities projects of:
 - a. greater than 10 million gallons per day in capacity, or
 - b. \$5 million or more; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$10 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications if required.

Wastewater Pipeline contractor “A”

(All wastewater pipeline sizes and materials.)

1. Applicant has wastewater pipeline experience and successful completion of:
 - a. 1 mile, or
 - b. 2 projects of greater than 1,000 linear feet, of at least 42-inches in diameter pipes; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$10 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Wastewater Pipeline contractor “B”

(Wastewater pipeline smaller than 42-inches in diameter and all wastewater pipeline materials.)

1. Applicant has wastewater pipeline experience and successful completion of:
 - a. 1 mile, or
 - b. 2 projects of greater than 1,000 linear feet, of at least 21-inches in diameter pipes; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$1 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Wastewater Pipeline contractor “C”

(Wastewater pipeline smaller than 21-inches in diameter and all wastewater pipeline materials.)

1. Applicant has wastewater pipeline experience and successful completion of:
 - a. 1 mile, or
 - b. 2 projects of greater than 1,000 linear feet, of at least 8-inches in diameter pipe; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$1 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Wastewater Facilities contractor “A”

(All wastewater facilities including WWTPs and lift stations.)

1. Applicant has experience and successful completion of at least 2 of the above described water facilities projects of:
 - a. a capacity greater than 5 million gallons per day, or
 - b. \$25 million or more; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of at least \$10 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications if required.

Wastewater Facilities contractor “B”

(Wastewater facilities including lift stations smaller than 5 million gallons).

1. Applicant has experience and successful completion of at least 2 of the above described wastewater facilities projects of:
 - a. at least 250,000 gallons per day in capacity, or
 - b. \$10 million or more; and
2. Applicant has a bonding limit of \$1 million; and
3. Applicant has ODEQ certifications if required.

Provisional Classification Contractor Prequalification Policy is applicable to all prequalification classifications. **Provisional Classification Contractor Prequalification Policy** is applicable to all contractors applying for an elevation of a classification, except elevation to Class “A” Water Steel or Class “A” Water PCCP.

Elevation of Prequalification Classification:

Elevation of a classification is a higher or broader class than the classification the contractor holds at the time of the application. *For example*, elevation from Class “C” to Class “B” or from Class “B” to Class “A”.

Any applicant may apply for elevation of a classification; however, any grant of an elevation of a classification will be provisional and subject to the restrictions herein until the Prequalification Review Board revises or removes the restrictions at a Prequalification Review Board meeting.

Provisional Restriction:

A contractor granted a provisional classification may only be awarded one contract in the provisional classification at a time. A contractor awarded a contract in a provisional class may not bid on and may not be awarded another contract in the provisional classification until the Prequalification Review Board determines the provisional classification contract has been fully and timely completed and the provisional restriction has been removed by the Prequalification Review Board.

However, the contractor may simultaneously bid on and may be awarded any number of contracts and may work as a subcontractor:

- (a) in other classifications granted by the Prequalification Review Board that are not subject to a provisional restriction, or
- (b) in a classification, below the provisional elevated classification, held by the applicant at the time of the application for the elevation of classification,

while performing work on the provisional classification contract.

Should a contractor not fully and timely complete a contract in a provisional classification, the Prequalification Review Board may continue the provisional restriction or revise the provisional restriction.

Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor and Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor Prequalification Restrictions

Applicants that cannot meet the Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor Prequalification requirements, listed within the Oklahoma City Prequalification Classifications, at the time of application or have not been a Prequalified Class “A” Water Steel/PCCP Pipeline Contractor within one calendar year of the time of application, may apply to elevate their prequalification only by being granted the applicable Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor Prequalification.

Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor must have the following requirements:

- Class “A” Water Pipeline Contractor prequalification,
- Applicant has a bonding limit of at least Ten Million Dollars.

- Applicant has ODEQ certifications as required.

Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor Prequalification may only perform one Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline project at a time. During this provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline project, the provisional contractor must meet the following requirements:

1. Retain a manufacturer’s representative on site for Steel and/or PCCP pipeline projects who is licensed or certified to work with the Steel and/or PCCP and who guides the provisional contractor’s work for the first 1,000 feet of installed pipe; and
2. Install a minimum of 2 miles of Steel and/or PCCP pipe which must be successfully tested in accordance with all Construction Contract Documents requirements and then be certified by the Engineer of Record for the Construction Project.

Upon timely and successful completion of Items 1 and 2, the Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor Prequalification, can request for removal of Provisional status through application to the Prequalification Board.

Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor may not bid on another Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline project until it has completed its current Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline project; however, the Provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor Prequalification or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor may simultaneously perform any number of Class “A”, Class “B” or Class “C” Water Pipeline projects while performing the provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline project.

After removal of the provisional restriction, the provisional Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor will become a Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor which may bid upon and may perform multiple Class “A” Water Steel Pipeline Contractor or Class “A” Water PCCP Pipeline Contractor projects concurrently.

Applications for an Elevation of Prequalification Classification will be subject to the Provisional Restriction until revised or removed by the Prequalification Review Board or until prequalification is terminated by the Prequalification Review Board or expires by failure to renew prequalification.

Provided however, the Prequalification Review Board may grant an Elevation of Prequalification Classification without Provisional Restriction, as determined by the Prequalification Review Board in its discretion.

The following characteristics of the Applicant, among others, may be considered by the Prequalification Review Board in determining whether to grant an Elevation of Prequalification Classification without Provisional Restriction:

- A. Previous timely, successfully, fully completed projects in the requested classification.
- B. Experience of existing supervisors with projects in the requested classification.
- C. Previous timely, successfully, fully completed projects in the class below the requested classification, with particular emphasis on projects of the approximate size and type in the requested classification.
- D. Experience of existing supervisors with projects in the class below the requested classification, with particular emphasis on projects of the approximate size and type in the requested classification.

- E. Previous timely, successfully, fully completed projects in the unexpanded classification of the requested classification, with particular emphasis on projects similar to or in the nature of the requested classification.
- F. Experience of existing supervisors with projects in the unexpanded classification of the requested classification, with particular emphasis on projects similar to or in the nature of the requested classification.
- G. Number of projects not timely, successfully or fully completed in any classification.
- H. Number of projects timely, successfully and fully completed in any classification.
- I. Number of projects not timely, successfully and fully completed in Oklahoma City in any classification.
- J. Number of projects timely, successfully and fully completed in Oklahoma City in any classification.
- K. Supervisors with the licenses required for the elevated classification.
- L. Such other characteristics, factors, experiences and projects as deemed relevant by the Prequalification Review Board or any of its members.

Nothing herein restricts the authority or ability of the Prequalification Review Board to set or include any additional or other conditions, limitations or requirements on any applicant or for any applicant's classification.

This Provisional Classification Contractor Prequalification Policy is subject to revision or amendment by the Prequalification Board at any meeting.

Title 25. Definitions and General Provisions

Chapter 21 - Discrimination

Article Article 3. Discrimination in Employment

Section 1313 - Public Employers - Status Verification System - Unauthorized Aliens - Contracting and Employment Practices

A. Every public employer shall register with and utilize a Status Verification System as described in subparagraphs a or b of paragraph 1 of Section 6 of this act to verify the federal employment authorization status of all new employees.

B. 1. After July 1, 2008, no public employer shall enter into a contract for the physical performance of services within this state unless the contractor registers and participates in the Status Verification System to verify the work eligibility status of all new employees.

2. After July 1, 2008, no contractor or subcontractor who enters into a contract with a public employer shall enter into such a contract or subcontract in connection with the physical performance of services within this state unless the contractor or subcontractor registers and participates in the Status Verification System to verify information of all new employees.

3. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any contracts entered into prior to the effective date of this section even though such contracts may involve the physical performance of services within this state after July 1, 2008.

C. 1. It shall be a discriminatory practice for an employing entity to discharge an employee working in Oklahoma who is a United States citizen or permanent resident alien while retaining an employee who the employing entity knows, or reasonably should have known, is an unauthorized alien hired after July 1, 2008, and who is working in Oklahoma in a job category that requires equal skill, effort, and responsibility, and which is performed under similar working conditions, as defined by 29 U.S.C., Section 206(d)(1), as the job category held by the discharged employee.

2. An employing entity which, on the date of the discharge in question, was currently enrolled in and used a Status Verification System to verify the employment eligibility of its employees in Oklahoma hired after July 1, 2008, shall be exempt from liability, investigation, or suit arising from any action under this section.

3. No cause of action for a violation of this subsection shall arise anywhere in Oklahoma law but from the provisions of this subsection.
