LEGAL DESCRIPTION: A tract of land being a part of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Four (4) West of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, being the East 120 feet of Lots Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18), the West 150 feet of Lots Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30), Thirty-one (31), Thirty-two (32) and Thirty-three (33) and the West 87 feet of Lot Thirty-four (34), all in Block Four (4) of AIRPORT HEIGHTS ADDITION according to the Plat recorded in Book 22 of plats, Page 49.

Your property is not included within the area proposed to be rezoned. This notice is being provided to you because you own property nearby.

You are not required to attend the hearing, but if you wish to you may. You can also have someone appear on your behalf.

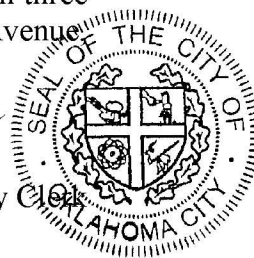

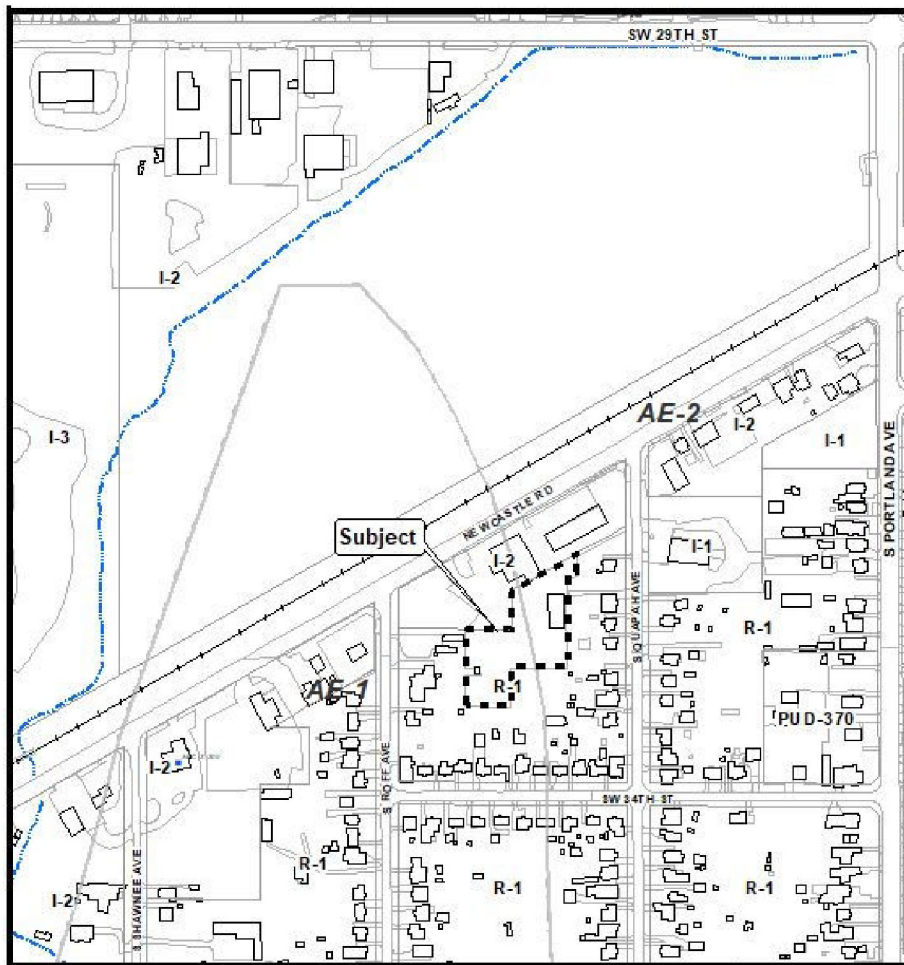

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City Council of Oklahoma City will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance, extending the limits of the I-2 Moderate Industrial District from the R-1 Single-Family Residential District. A public hearing will be held by the City Council on May 21, 2019. **The City Council meets in the Council Chambers, Third Floor, Municipal Building, 200 North Walker Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma beginning at 8:30 a.m.**

Under the terms of said ordinance, the limits of and boundaries of the I-2 Moderate Industrial District would be extended to include the following described property:

A tract of land being a part of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Four (4) West of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, being the East 120 feet of Lots Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18), the West 150 feet of Lots Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30), Thirty-one (31), Thirty-two (32) and Thirty-three (33) and the West 87 feet of Lot Thirty-four (34), all in Block Four (4) of AIRPORT HEIGHTS ADDITION according to the Plat recorded in Book 22 of plats, Page 49.

PROPOSED USE: Industrial development

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ZONING DISTRICT:

I-2 Moderate Industrial intended primarily for the conduct of light manufacturing, assembling, and fabrication, and for warehousing, wholesale, and service uses which may generate moderate impacts on surrounding uses.

Any person having any objections to the proposed rezoning may appear before the City Council in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** on the above date set for hearing and show cause why the proposed rezoning should not be carried out in accordance with said ordinance. At any time not later than three days prior to said hearing, any owner of property within the district affected, or any owner of property within a 300 foot radius of the exterior boundary of the subject property, may make legal written protest by filing the same with the Office of the City Clerk, 200 North Walker Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73102.
