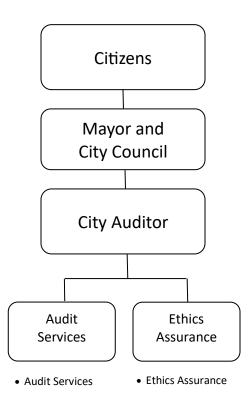

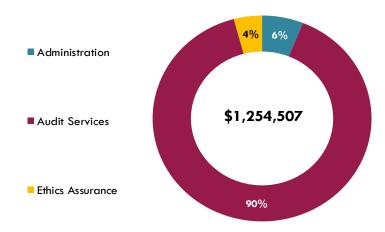

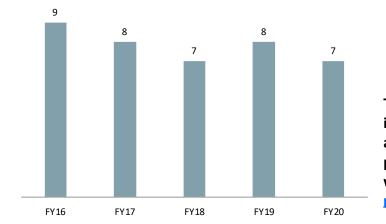


DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Office of the City Auditor (OCA) has a FY20 budget of \$1,254,507, an increase of 2.01%. Seven positions are authorized in the FY20 budget, a decrease of one position. Budget is being reallocated from a vacant Senior Auditor position to a new contracted IT audit function. Procuring this expertise allows the OCA to thoroughly examine and uncover potential information systems vulnerabilities within the City.

Department Facts

- The OCA is audited every three years to ensure compliance with Generally Accepted Government Auditing Standards.
- The OCA develops and operates by a triennial Audit Plan based on a citywide risk assessment.
- So far in FY19, the OCA has completed six audit reports, and completed eight reports in FY18. All reports are available on the Department's official City website

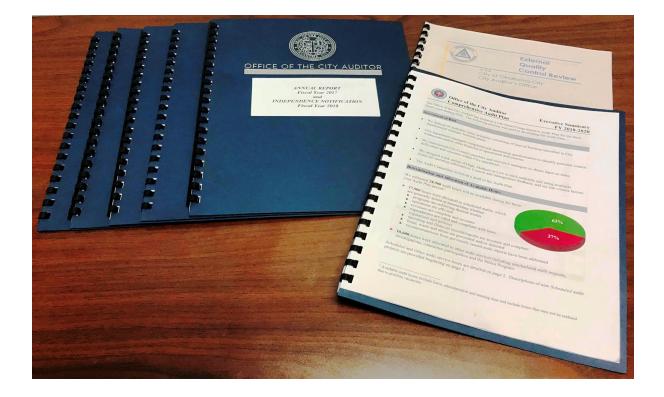
