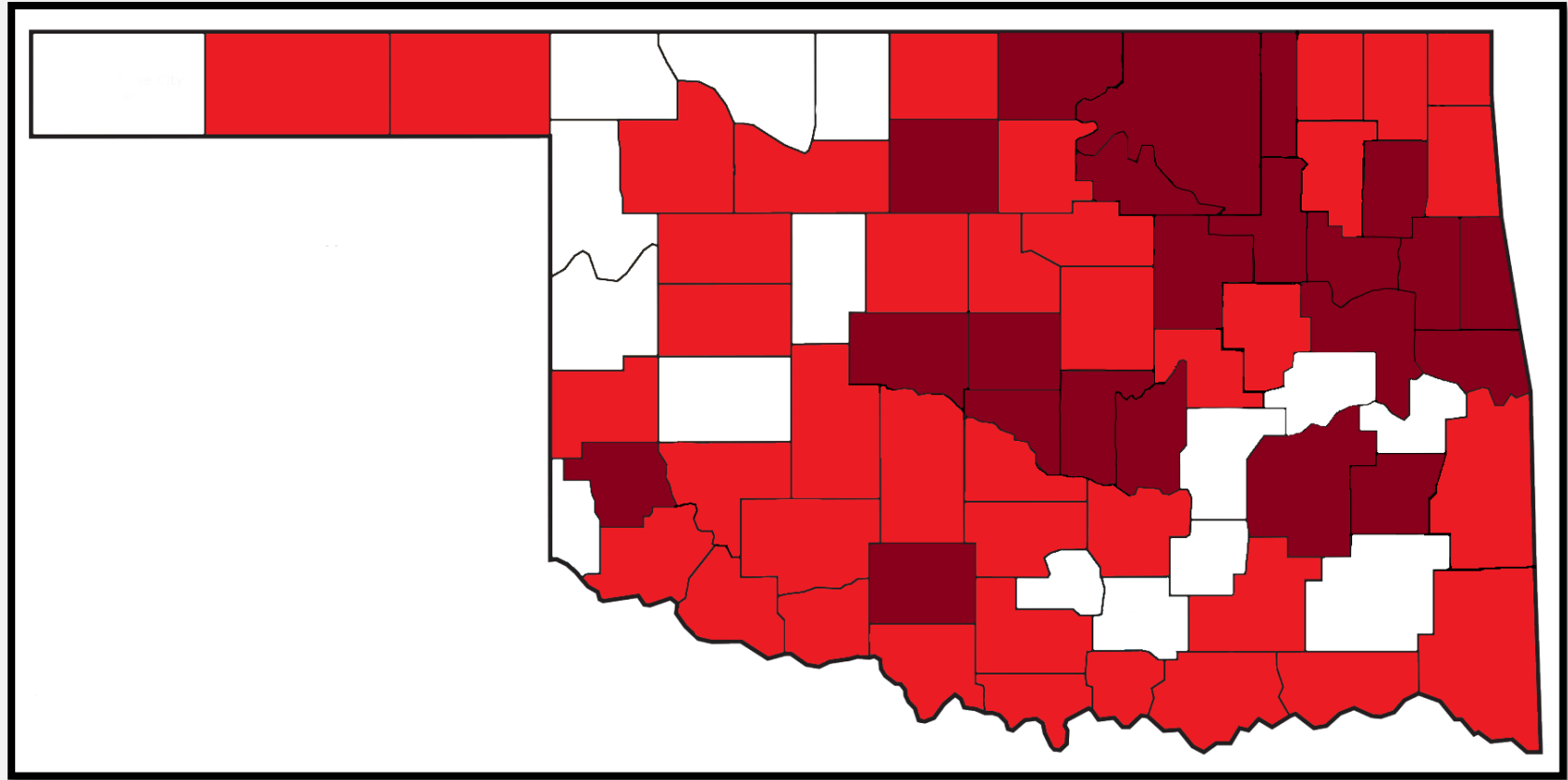
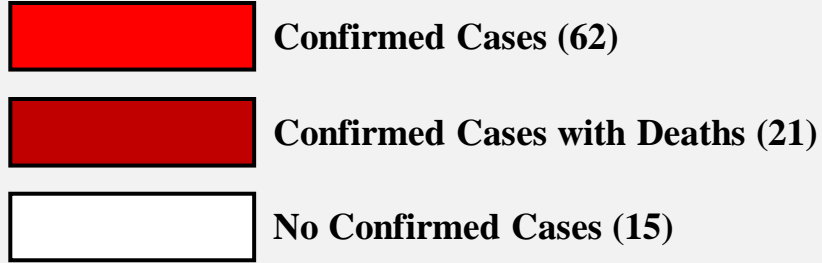

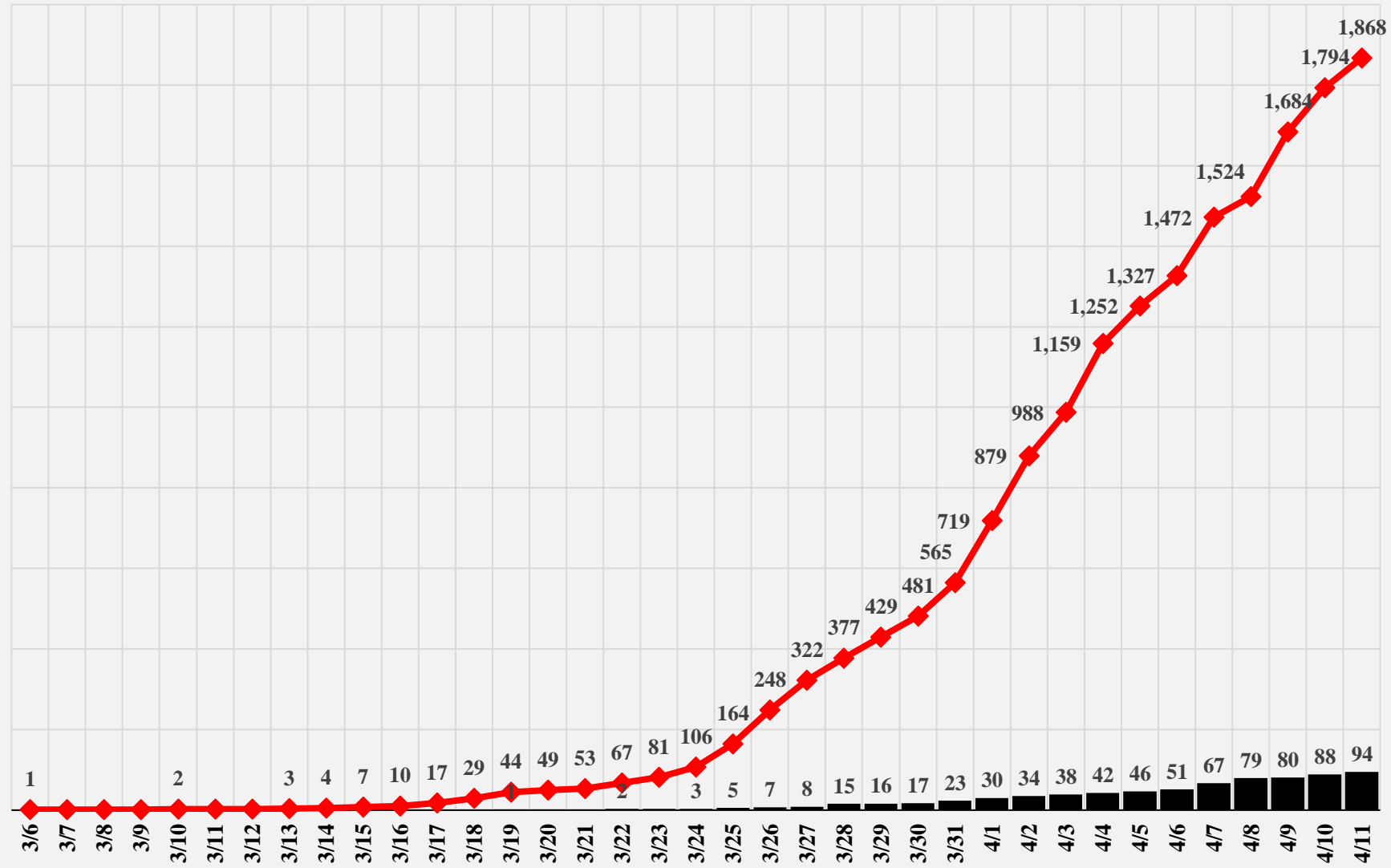
# COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Deaths

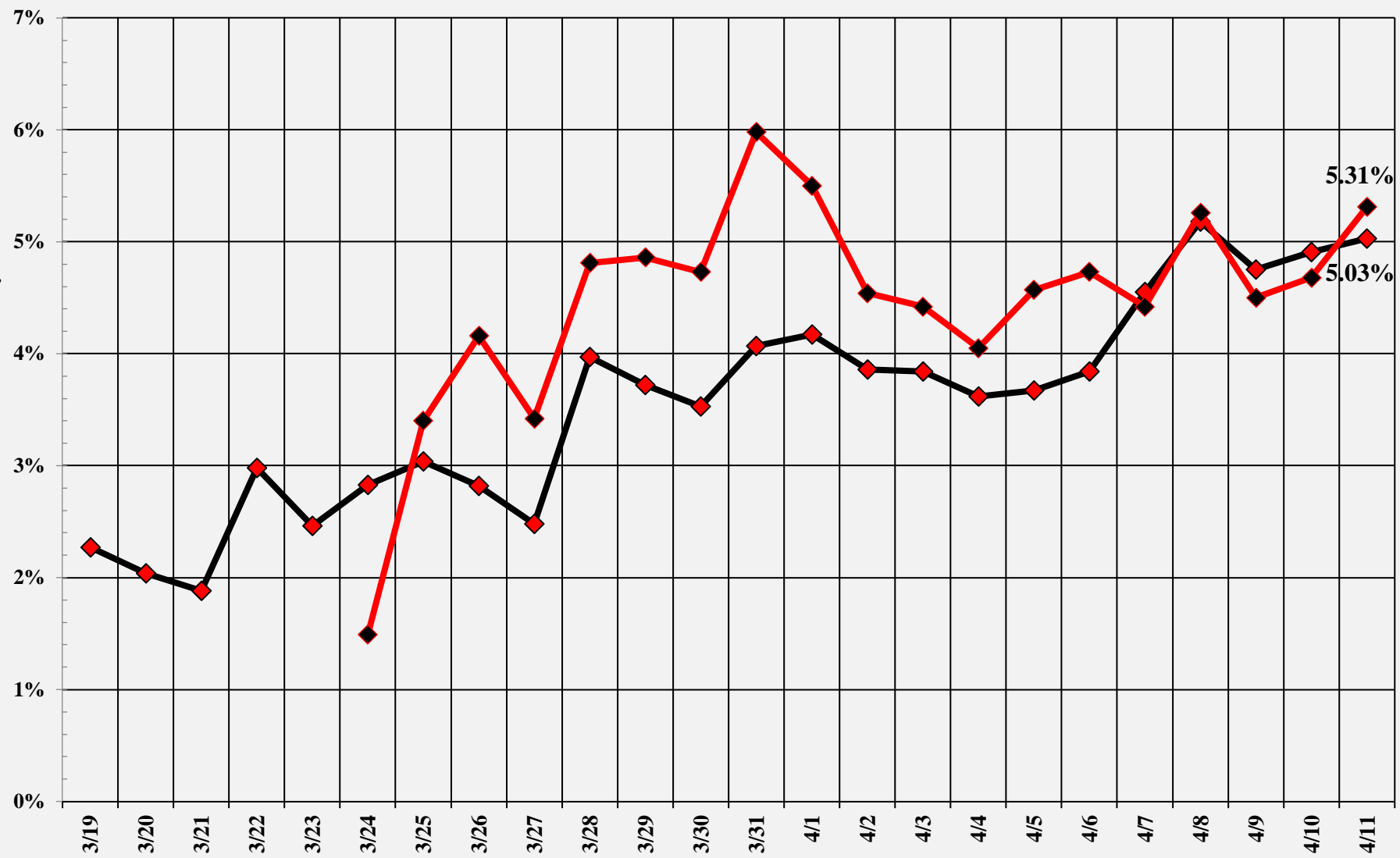
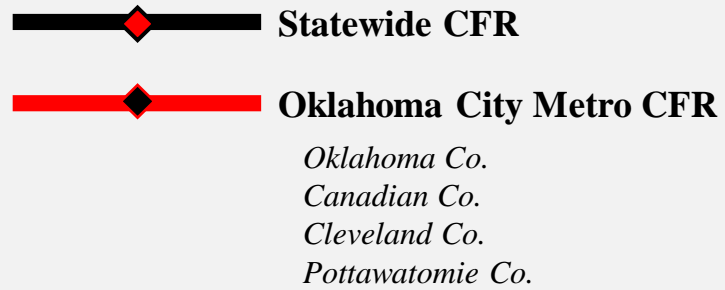


# COVID-19 Statewide Case Fatality Rate (CFR) Per Day

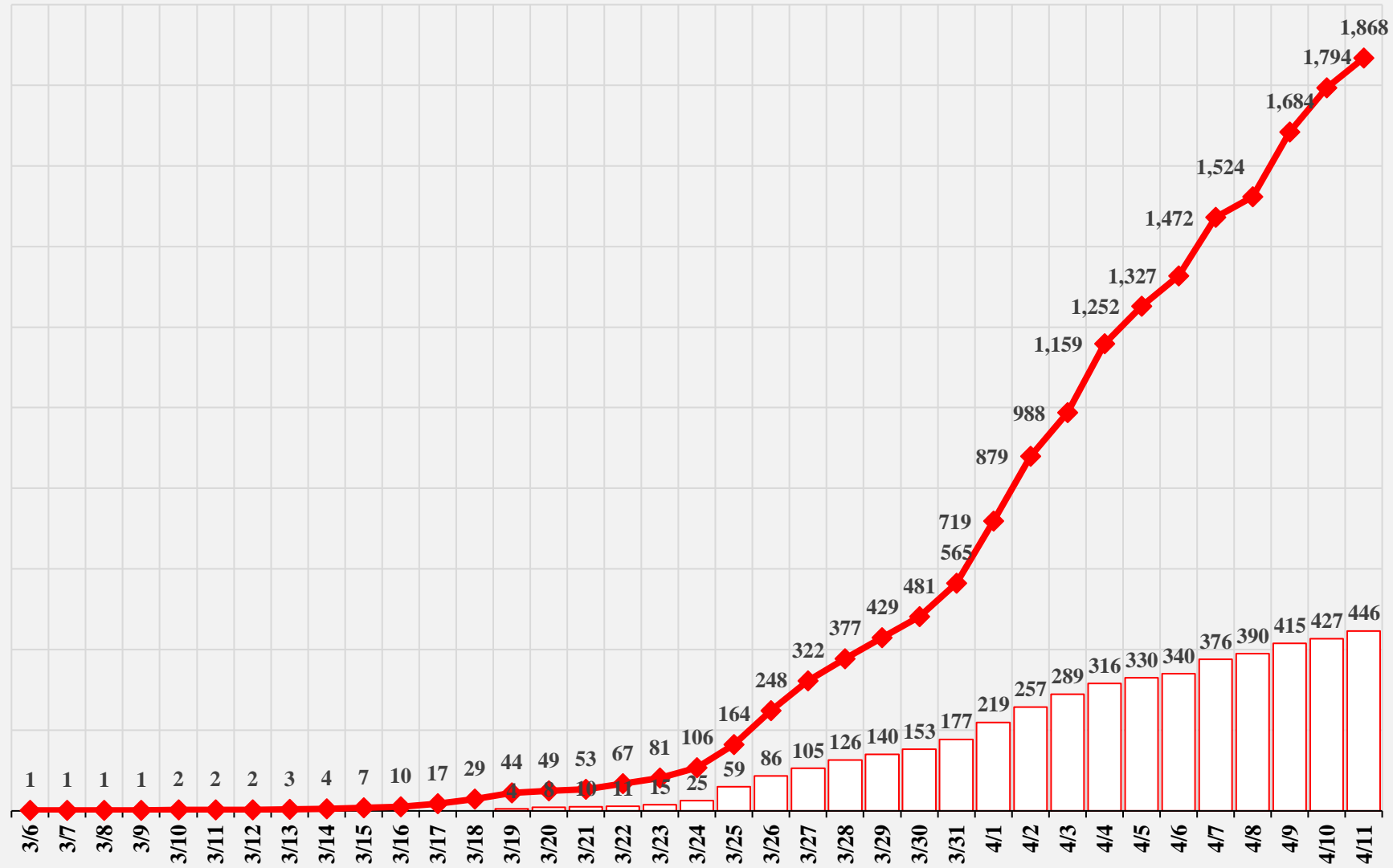


# COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Hospitalizations

 Hospitalizations

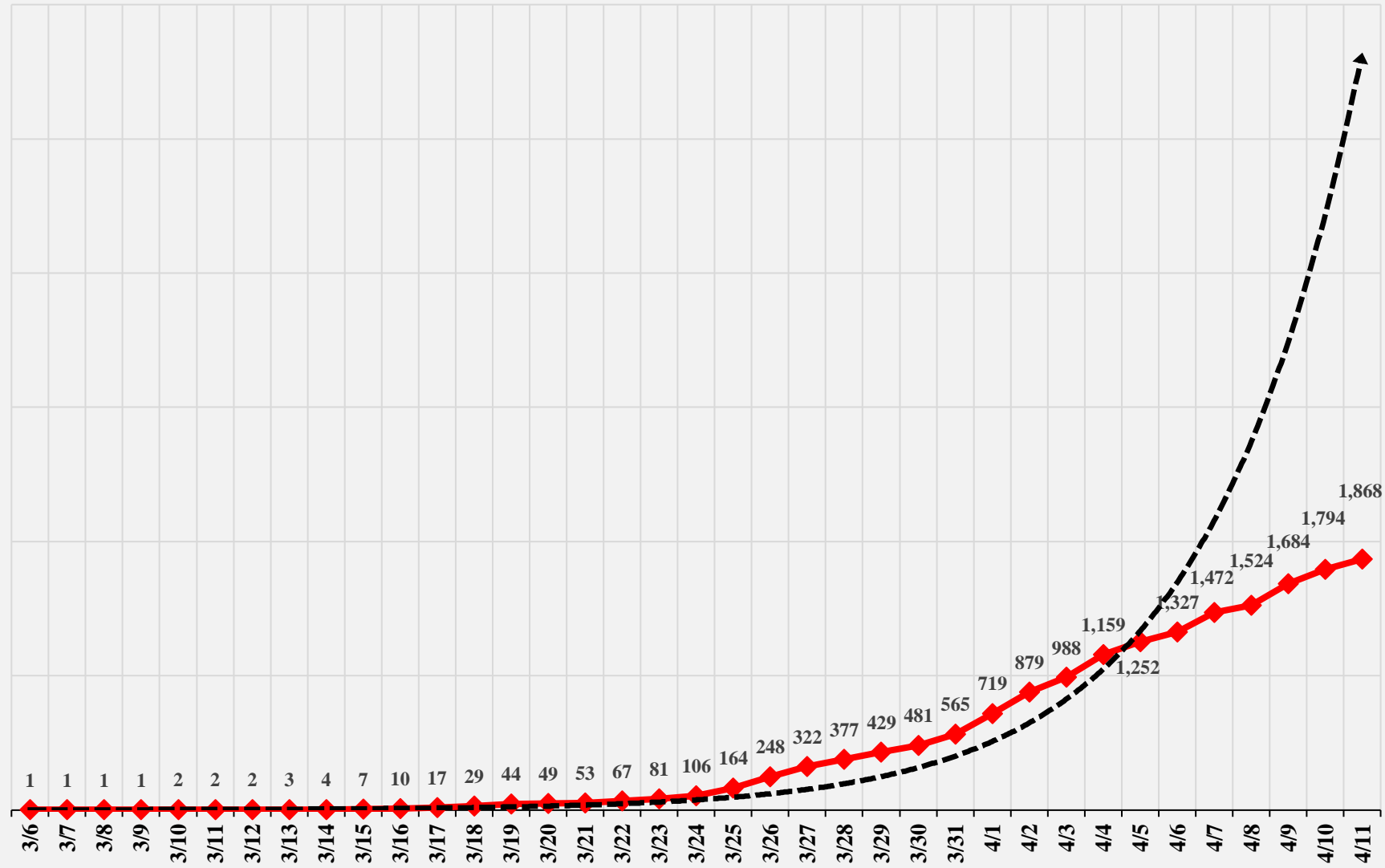


# COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Exponential Growth Estimate

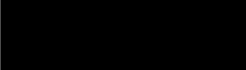
# COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Age Cohort

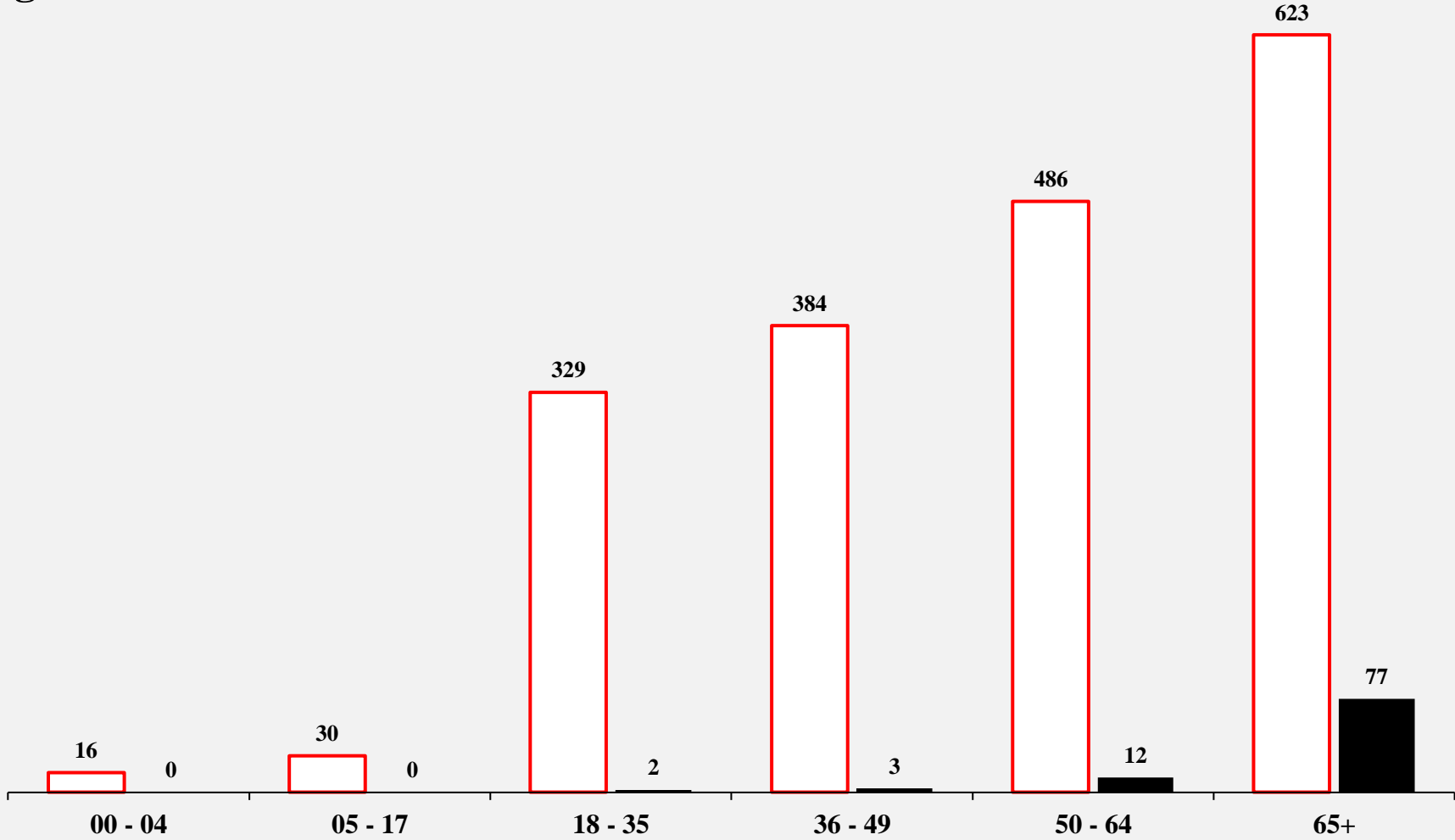

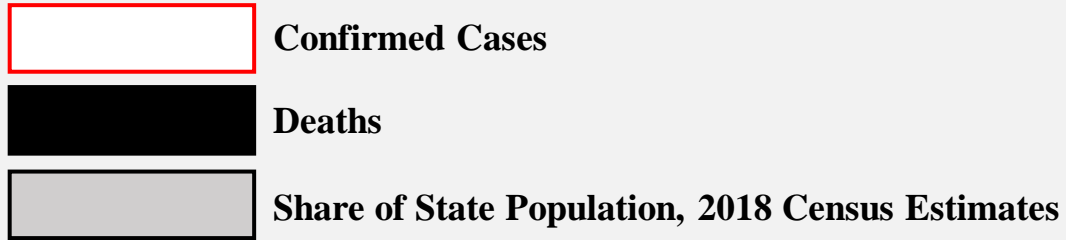




# COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Race and Ethnicity

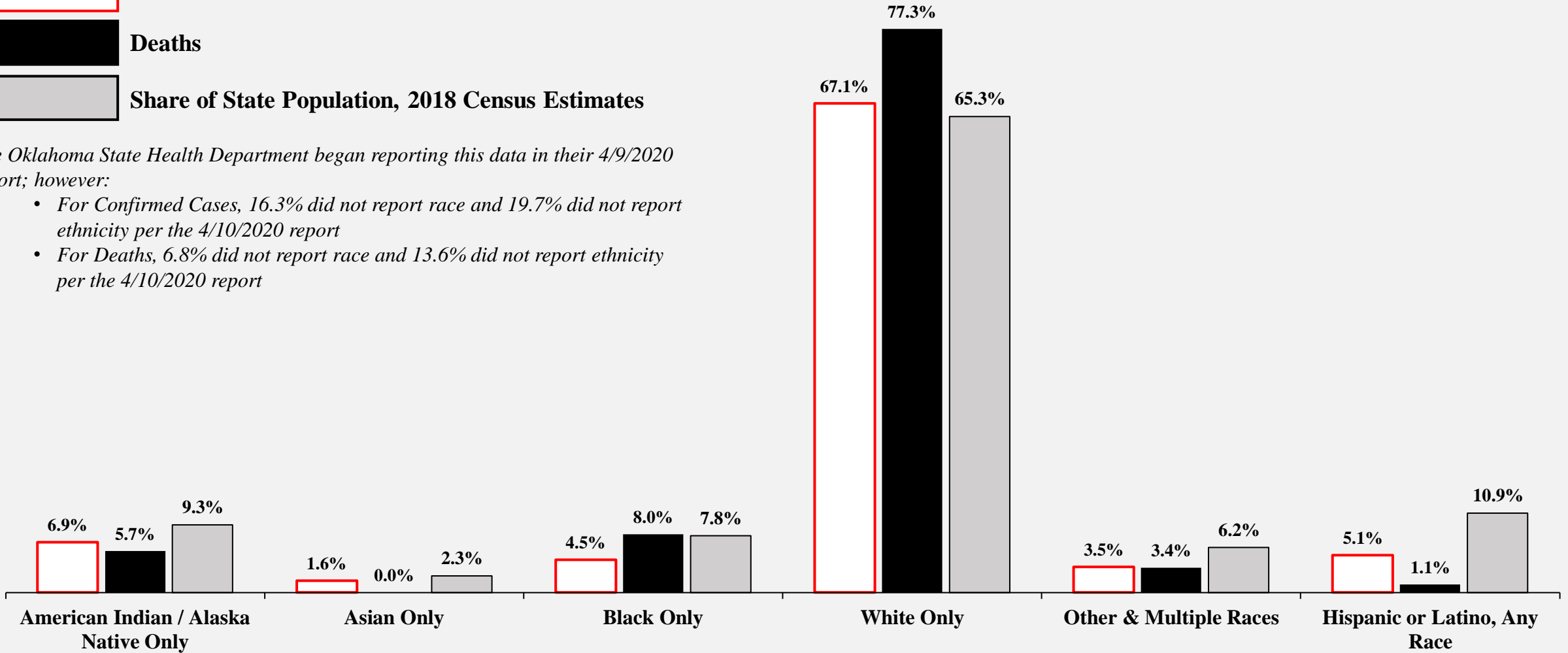

- For Deaths, 6.8% did not report race and 13.6% did not report ethnicity per the 4/10/2020 report



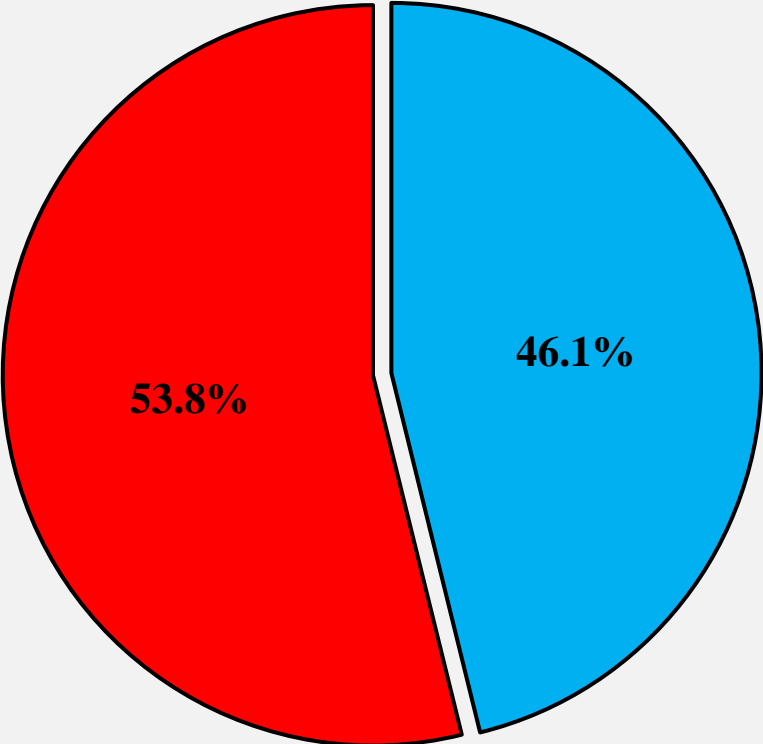
# COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender

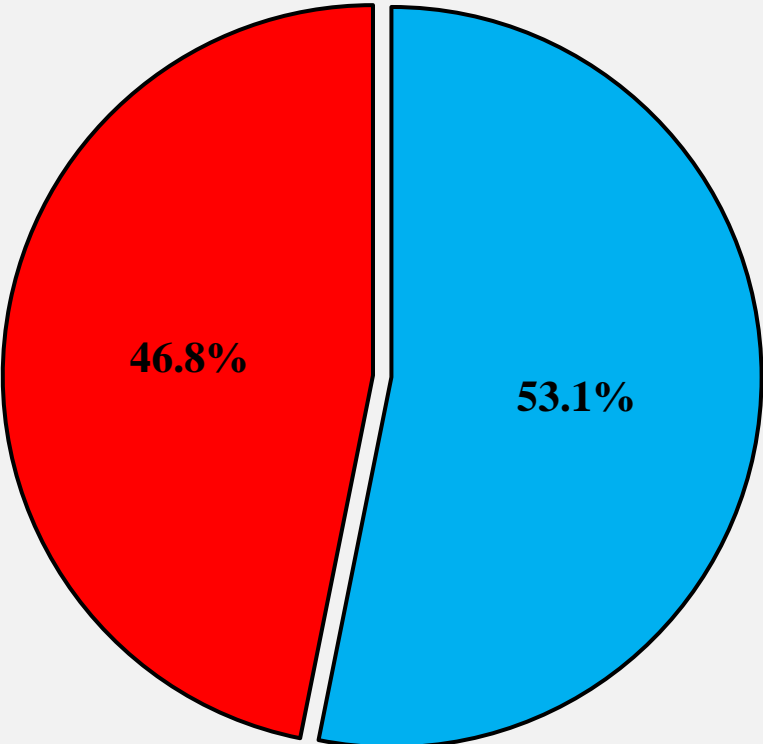

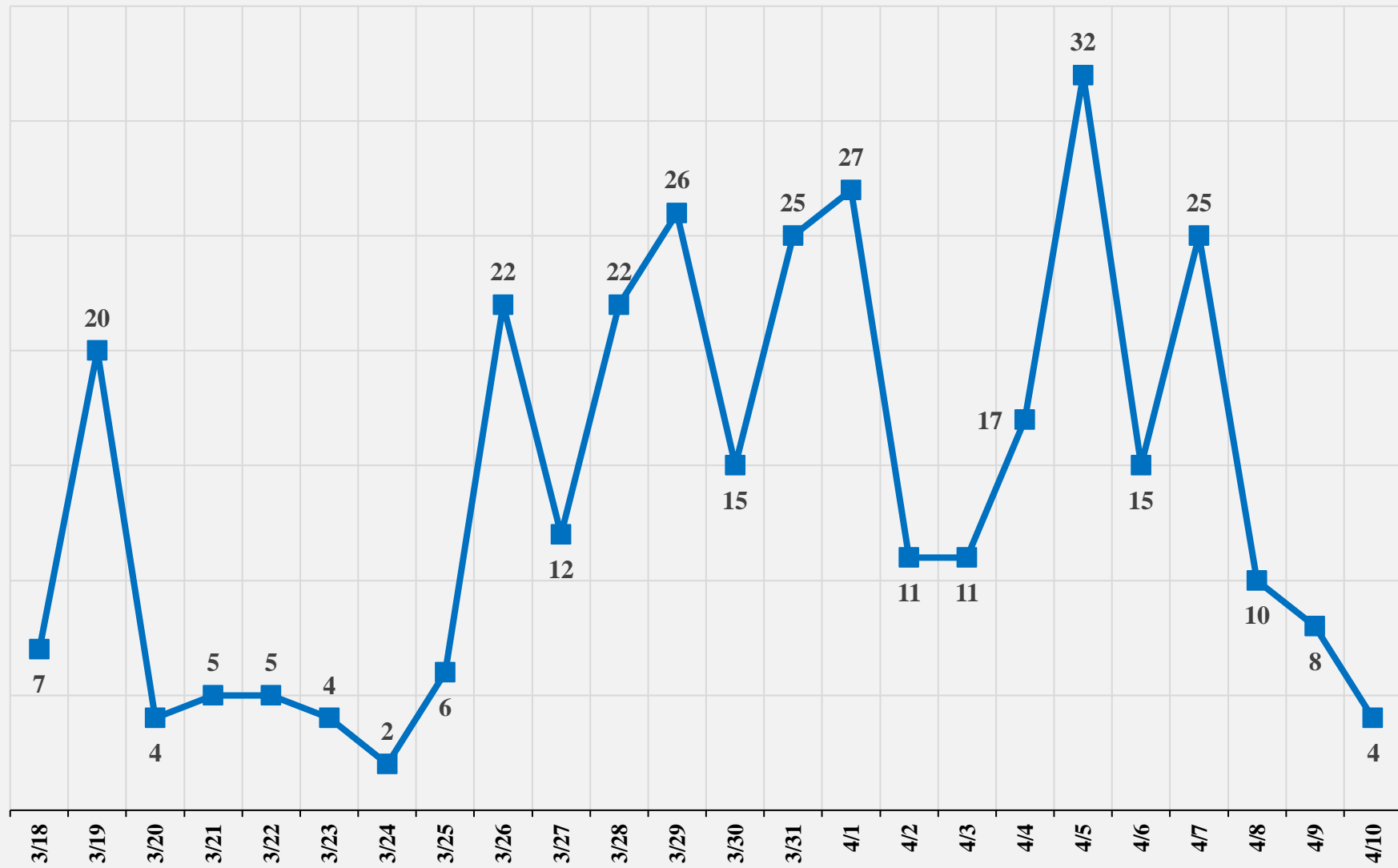
# COVID-19-Related Calls for Service Received by OCPD

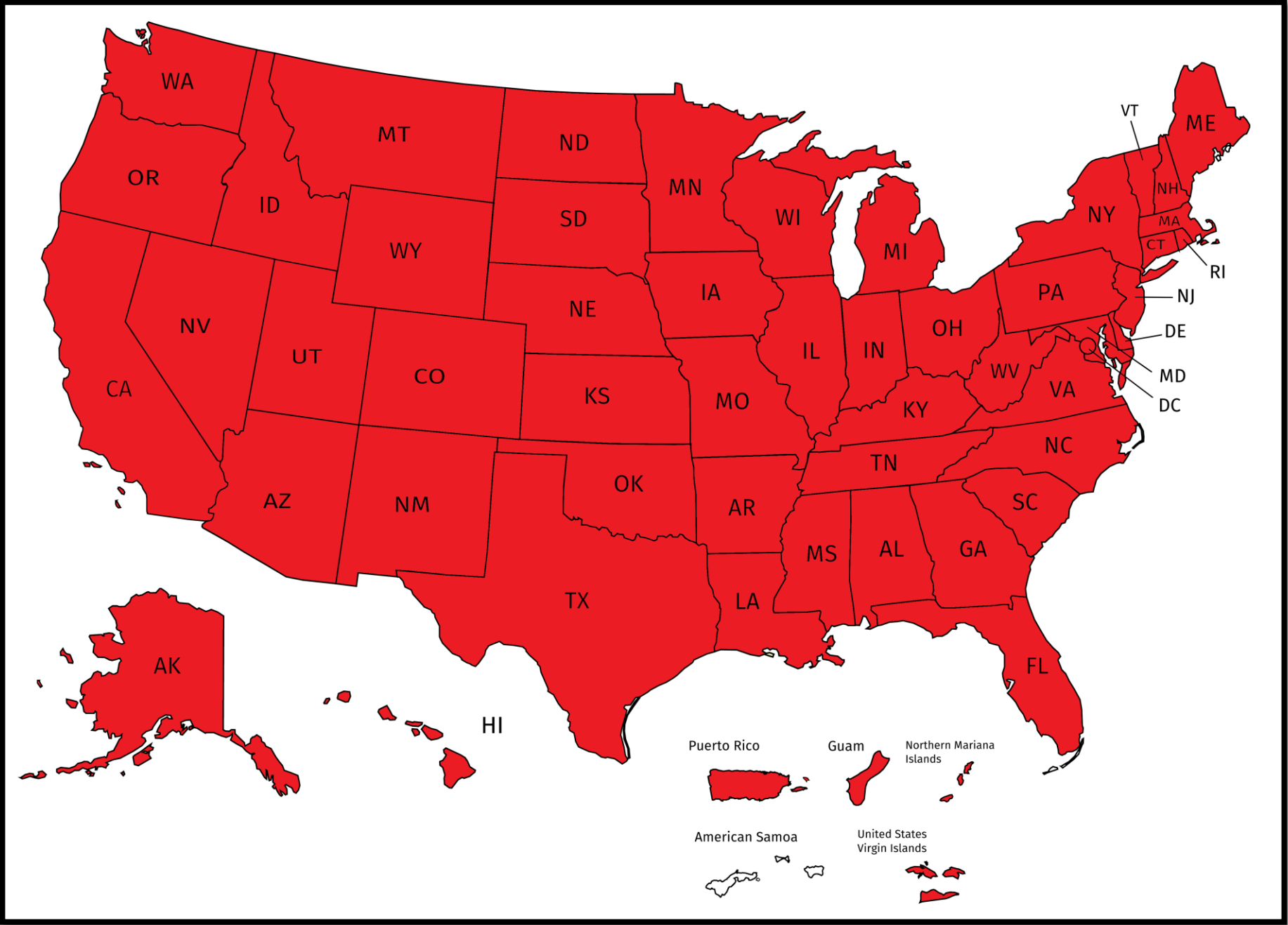

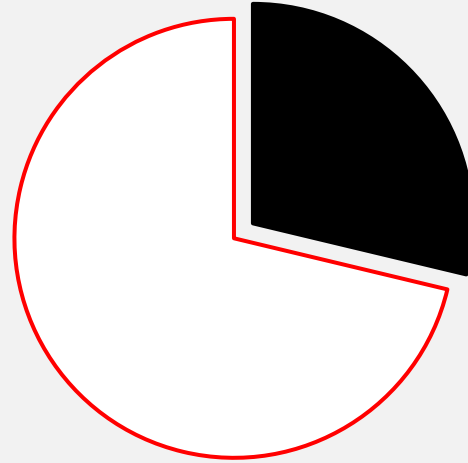

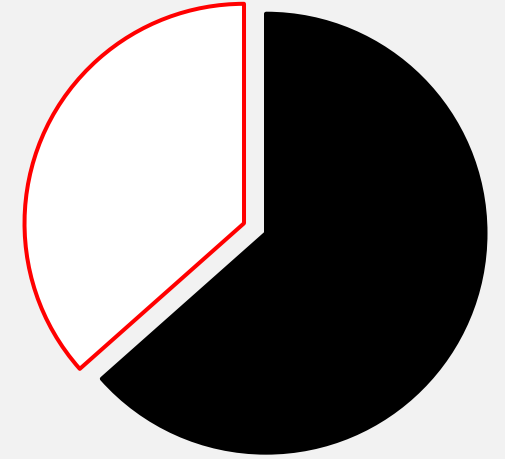

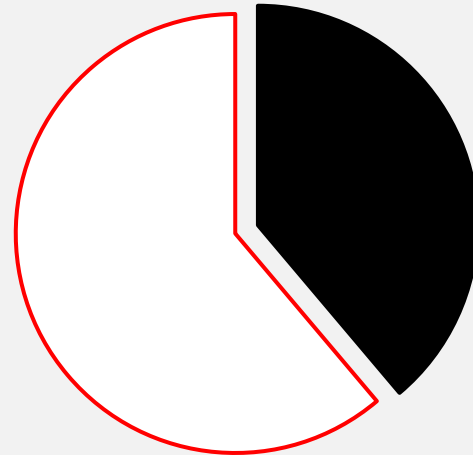

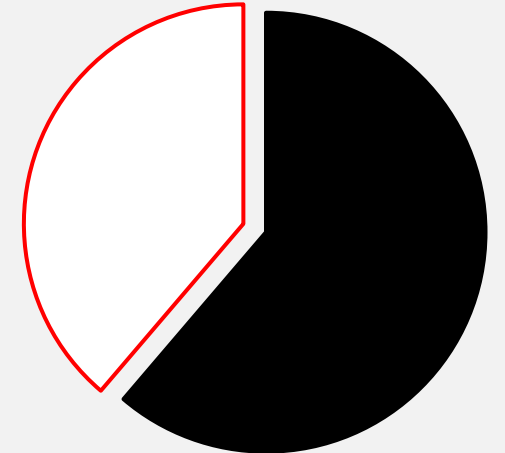

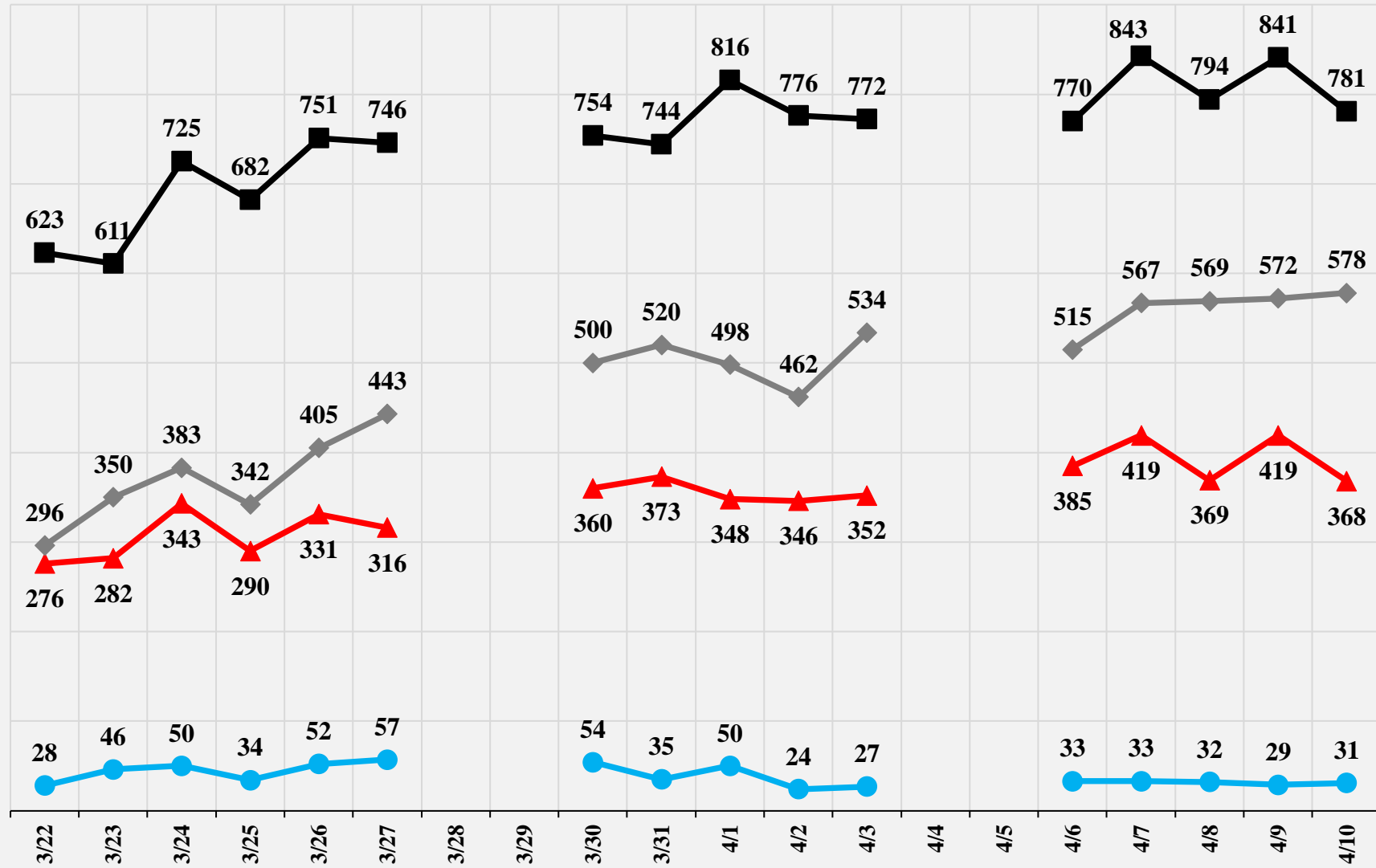

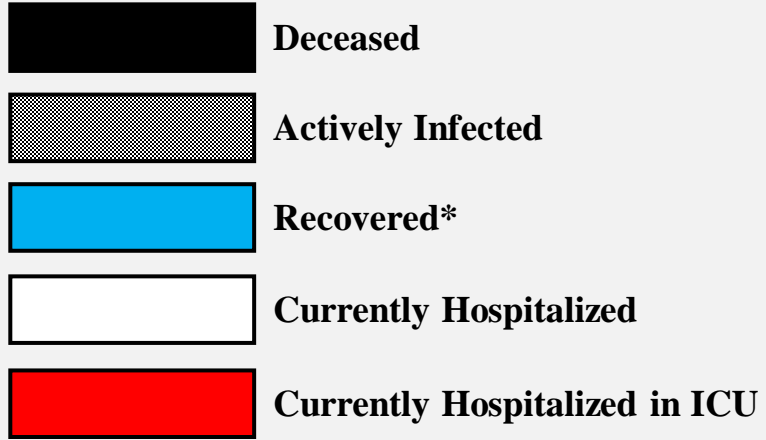

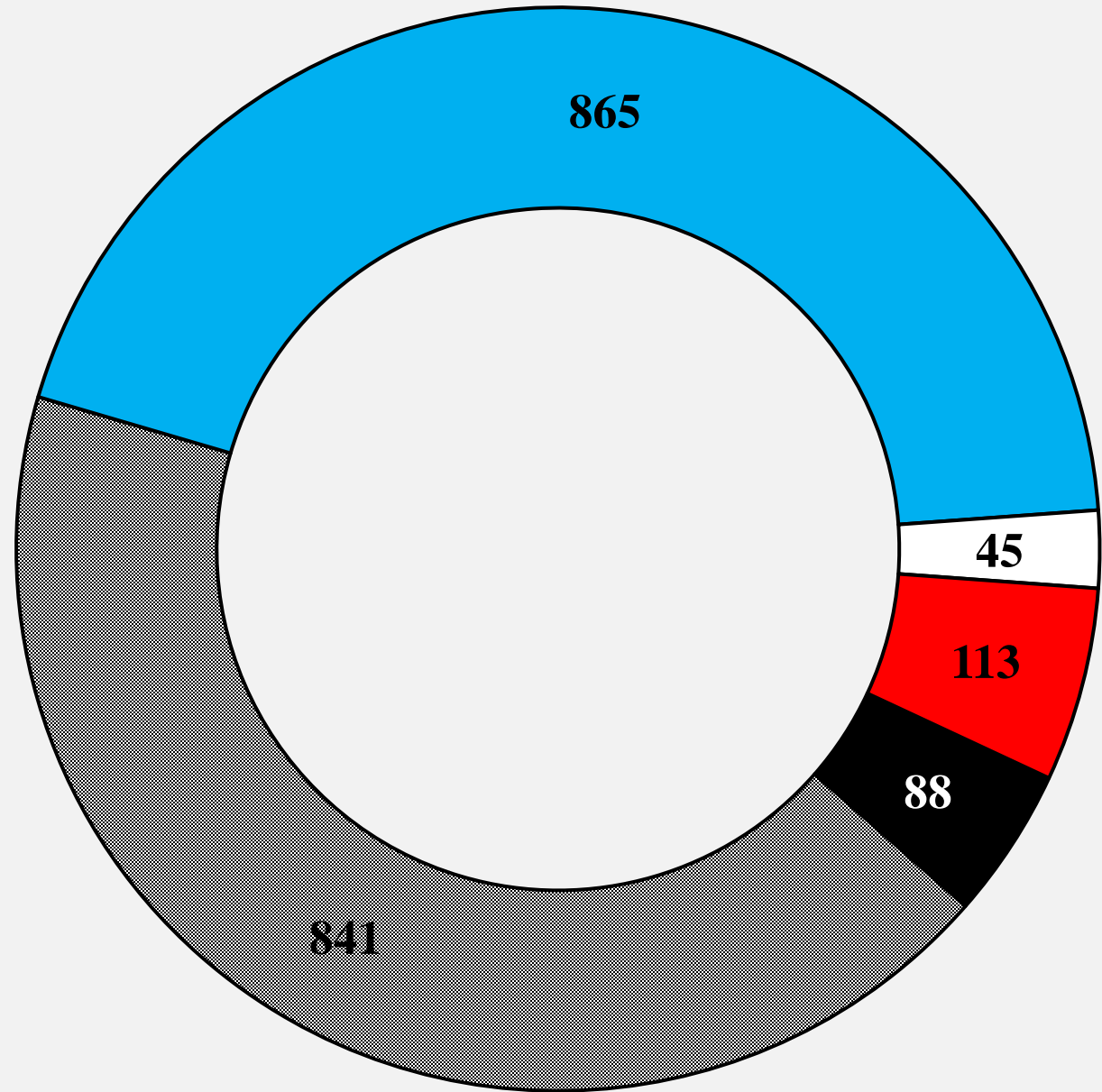

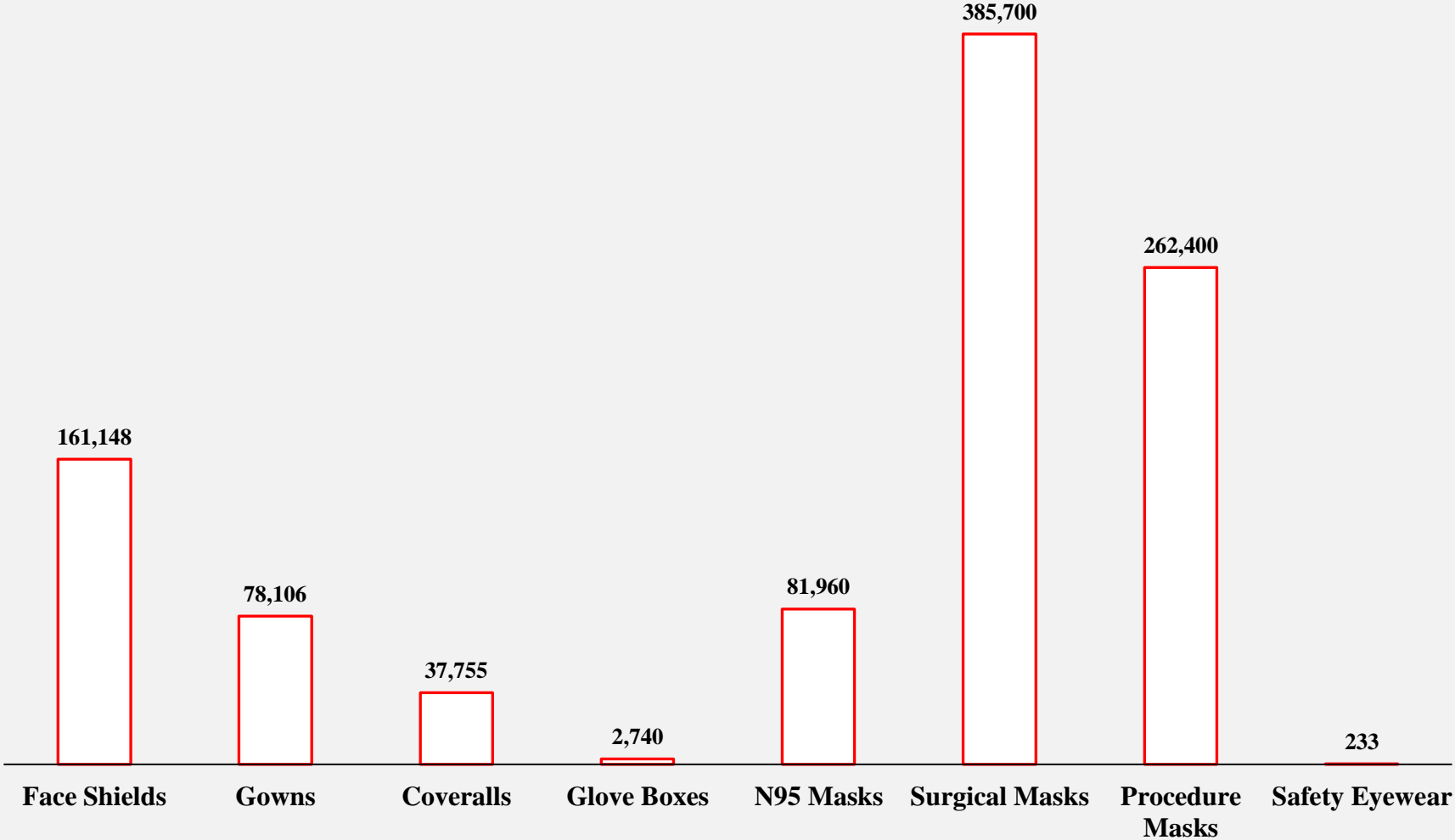

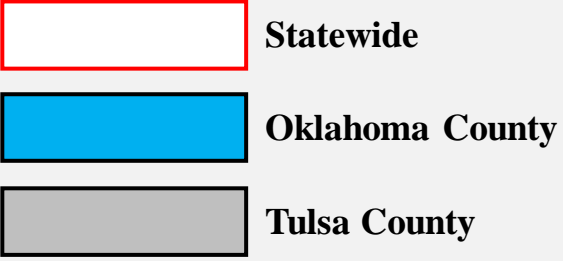

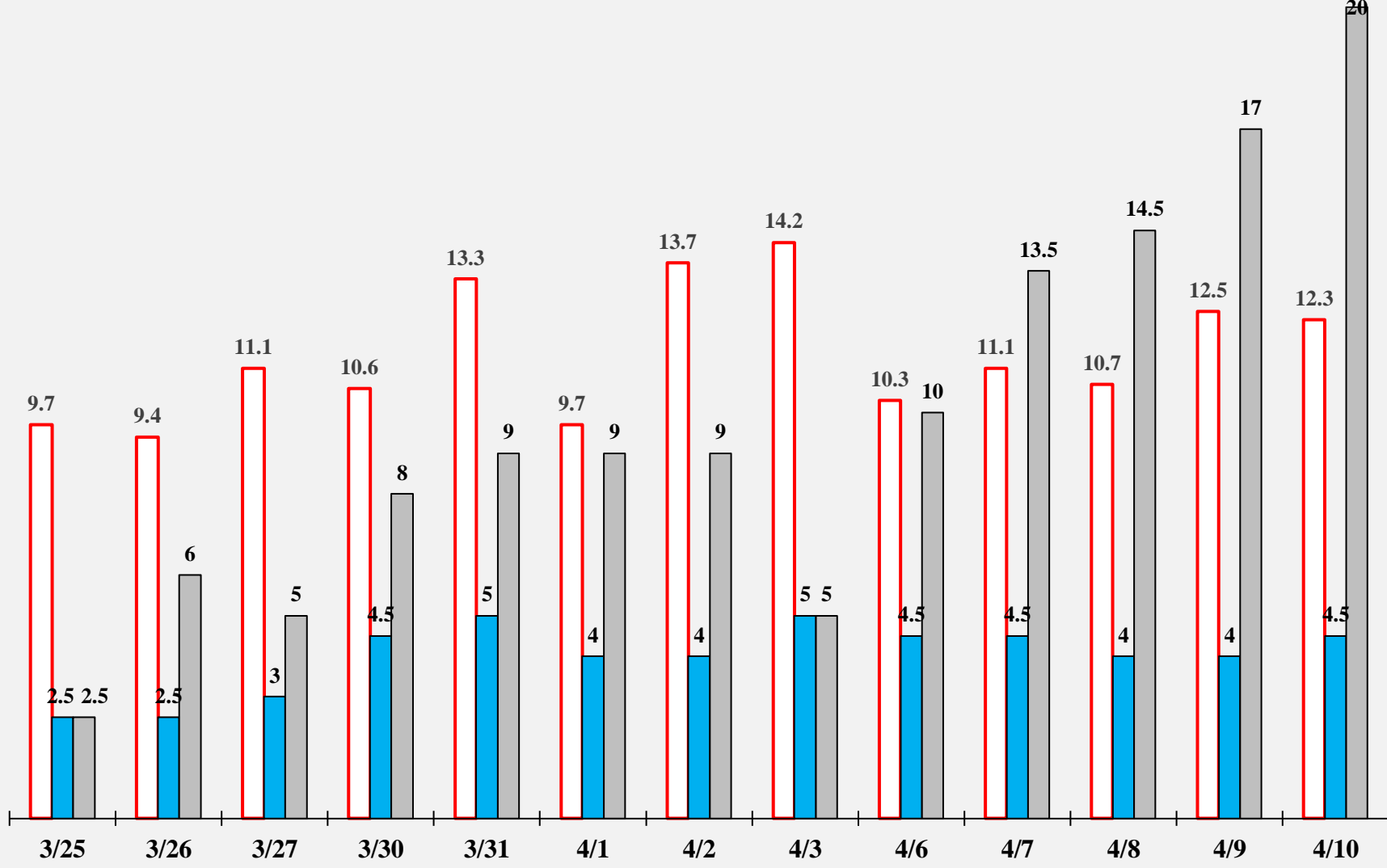
# Statewide Average Days of PPE

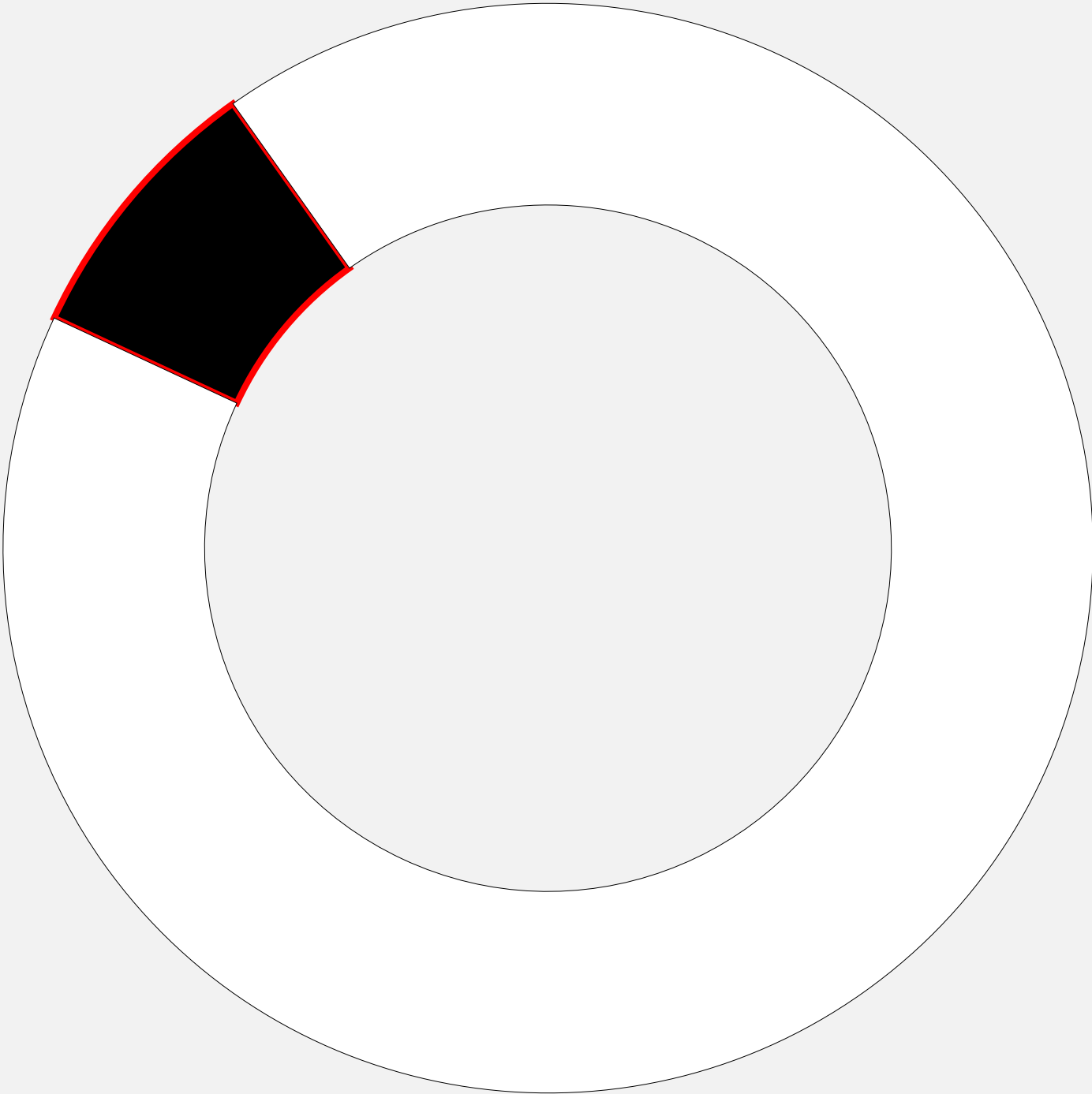


**Positive for COVID-19 (8%)**

*Negative results changed drastically with the Oklahoma State Health Department's addition of re-processed private laboratory test results dating back to February.*



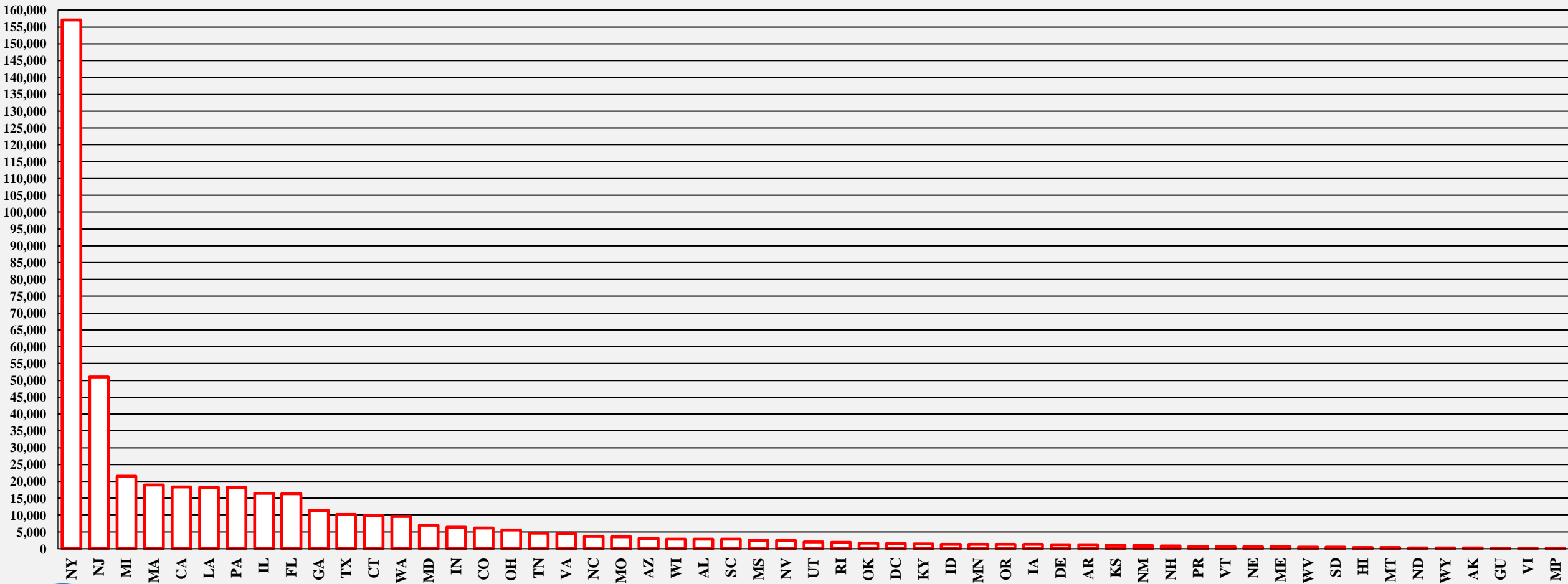
# COVID-19 Confirmed Cases by State/Territory

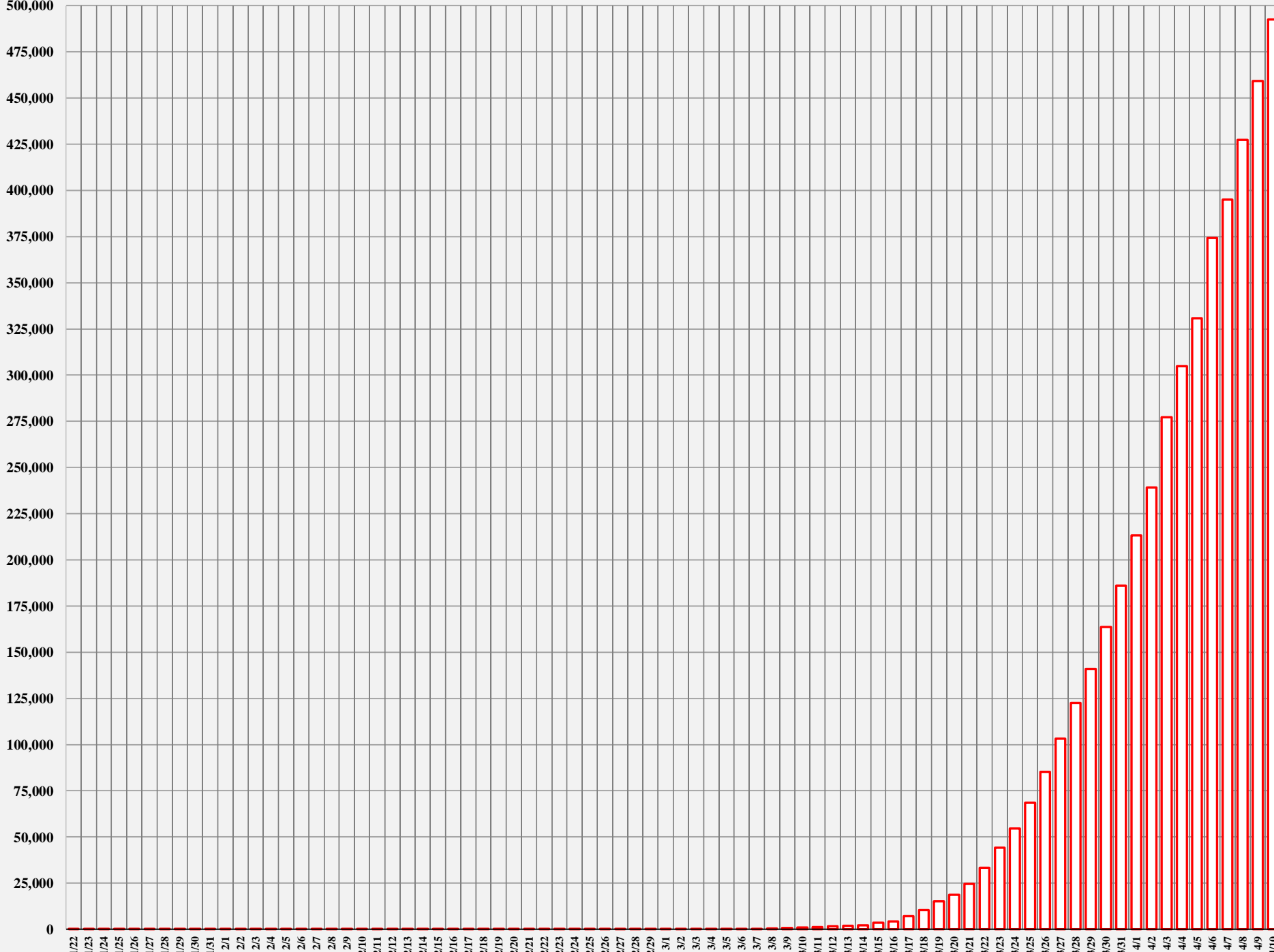


# COVID-19 Confirmed U.S. Cases

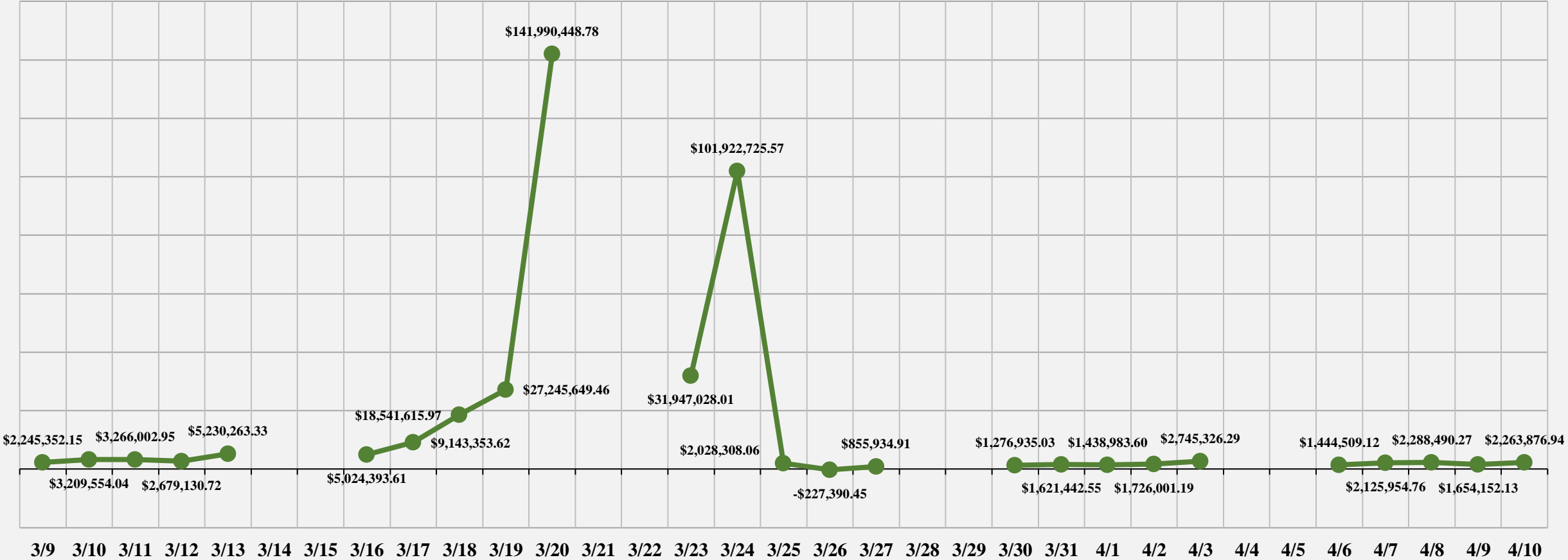

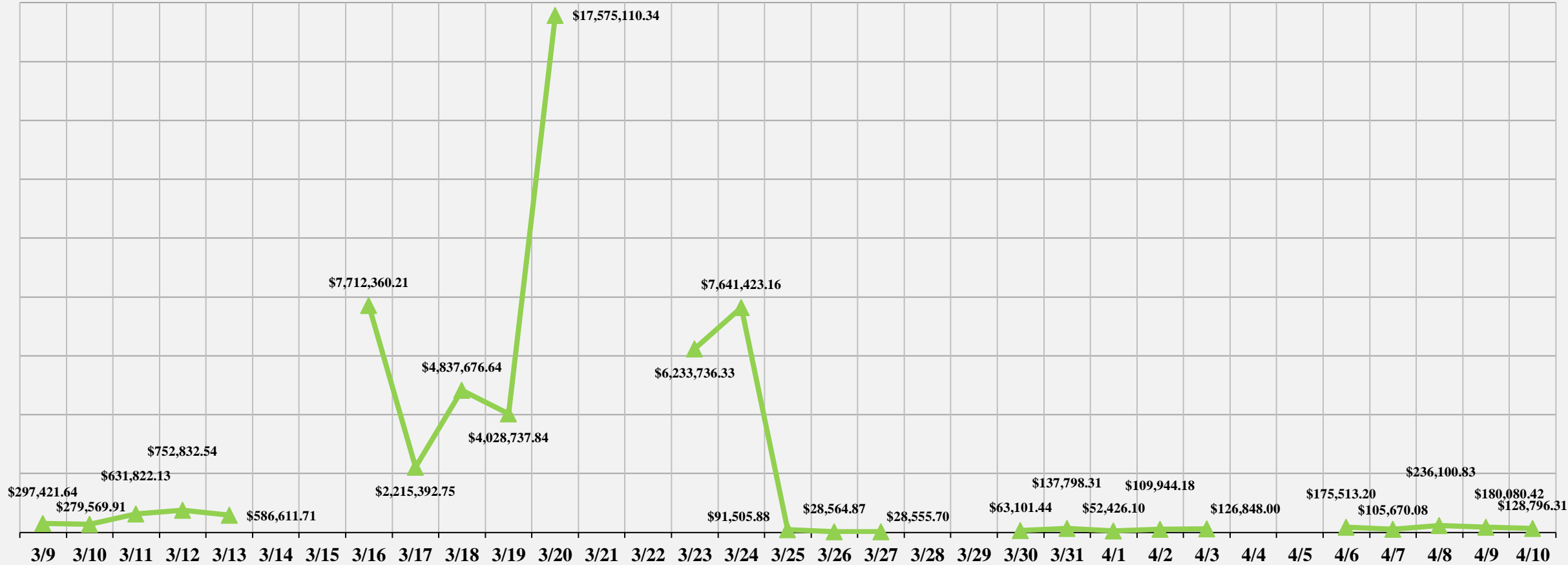

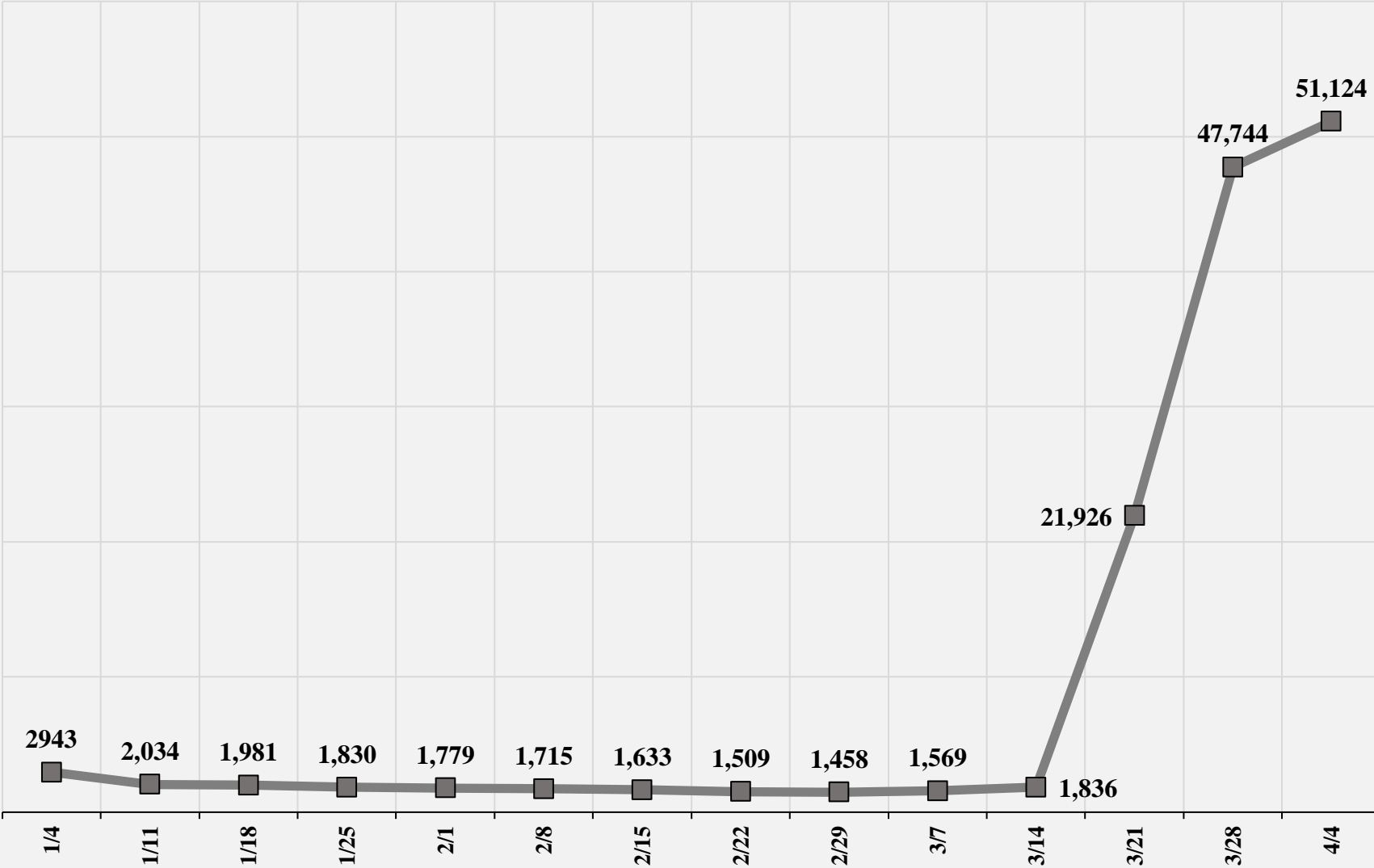
# Oklahoma Statewide Unemployment Claims
