







**Cumulative Deaths** 










## COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Hospitalizations

Hospitalizations






#### **COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Exponential Growth Estimate**




### **COVID-19 Statewide Cases, Hospitalizations, and Deaths Per Day**




#### **COVID-19** Cases and Deaths by Oklahoma City Metro City, Town

3/19/20 through 4/16,20, as of 4/17/2020














### **COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender**











## **COVID-19-Related Calls for Service Received by OCPD**



**No Declaration** 

- Mississippi has had a second major disaster declaration approved as of 4/16/2020 applicable to three counties impacted by severe storms, tornadoes, straight-line winds, and flooding on 4/12/2020.
- American Samoa, the only U.S. state/territory without a major disaster declaration due to COVID-19, has submitted a declaration awaiting presidential approval.
- This is the first time in history all U.S. states, albeit not territories, have simultaneously fallen under major disaster declarations.

















### **COVID-19 Case Status Statewide**












#### **COVID-19 Confirmed U.S. Cases**

As reported by the CDC, cases nationwide (661,712) now exceed the estimated 2018 population of Oklahoma City (649,021) per the U.S. Census Bureau.






### Oklahoma Statewide Unemployment Claims
