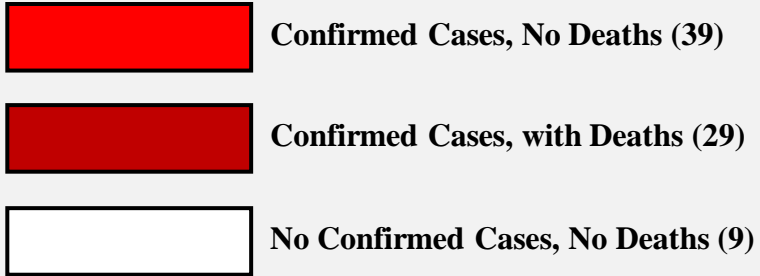

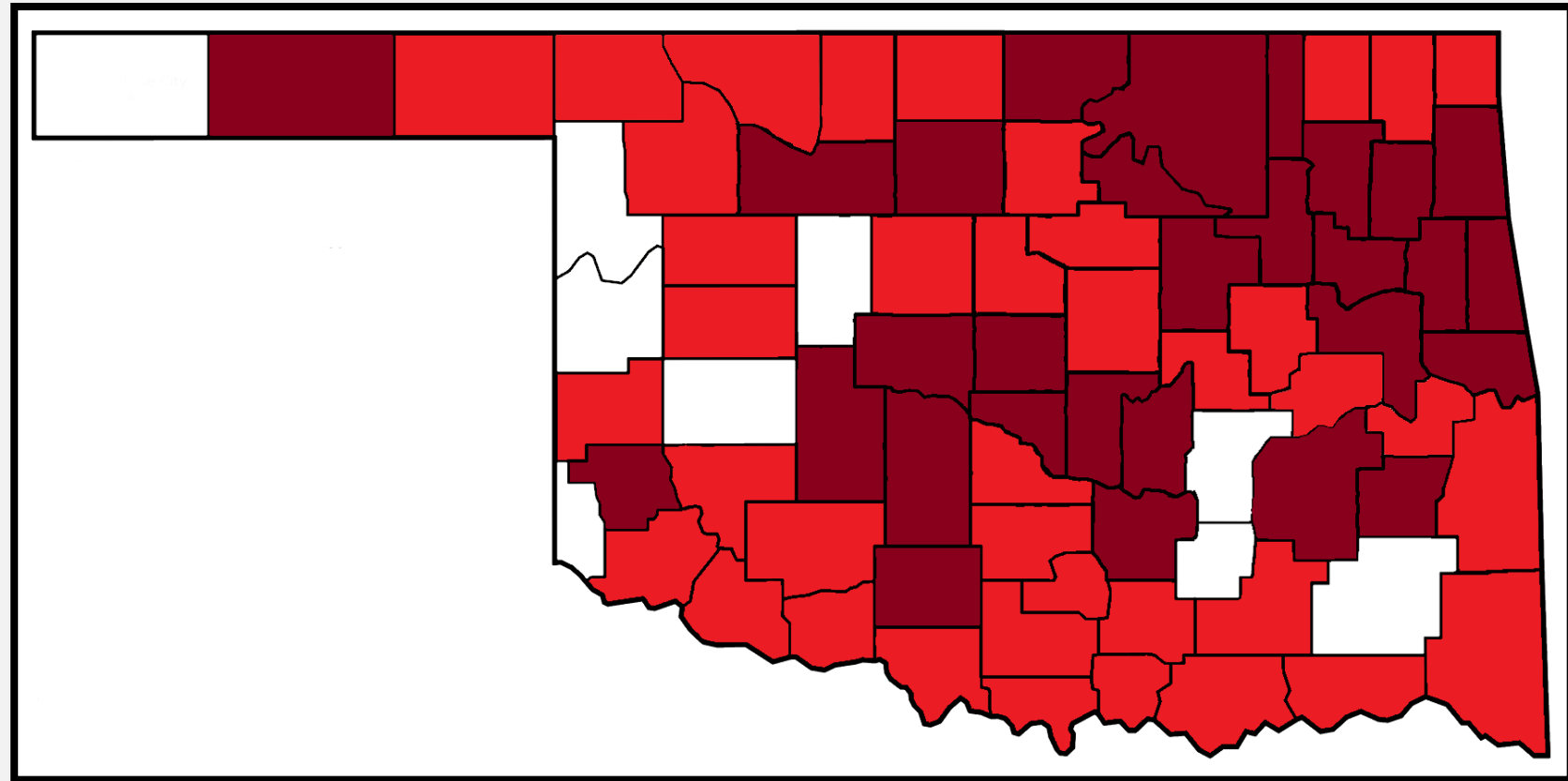

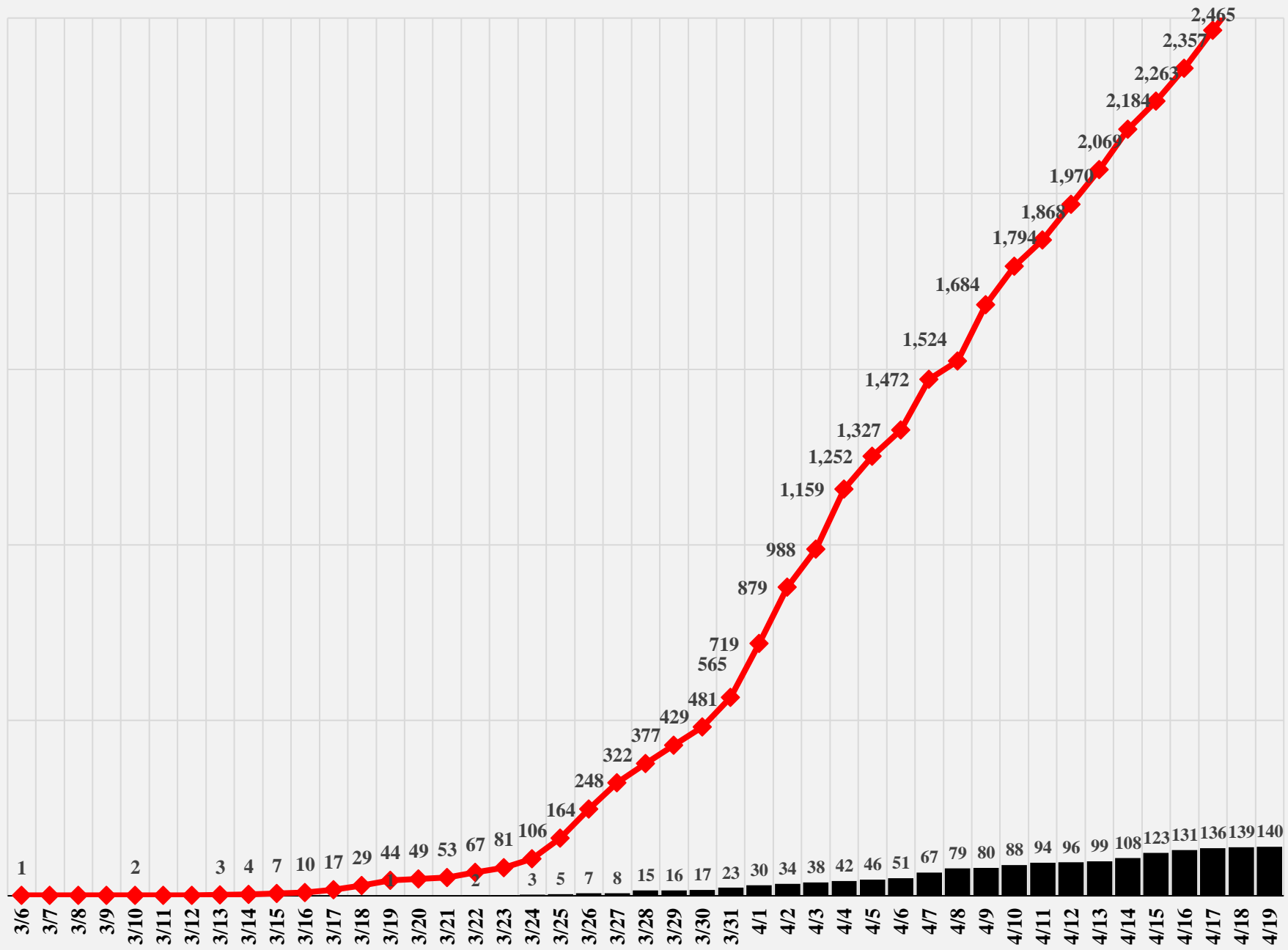
# COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Deaths

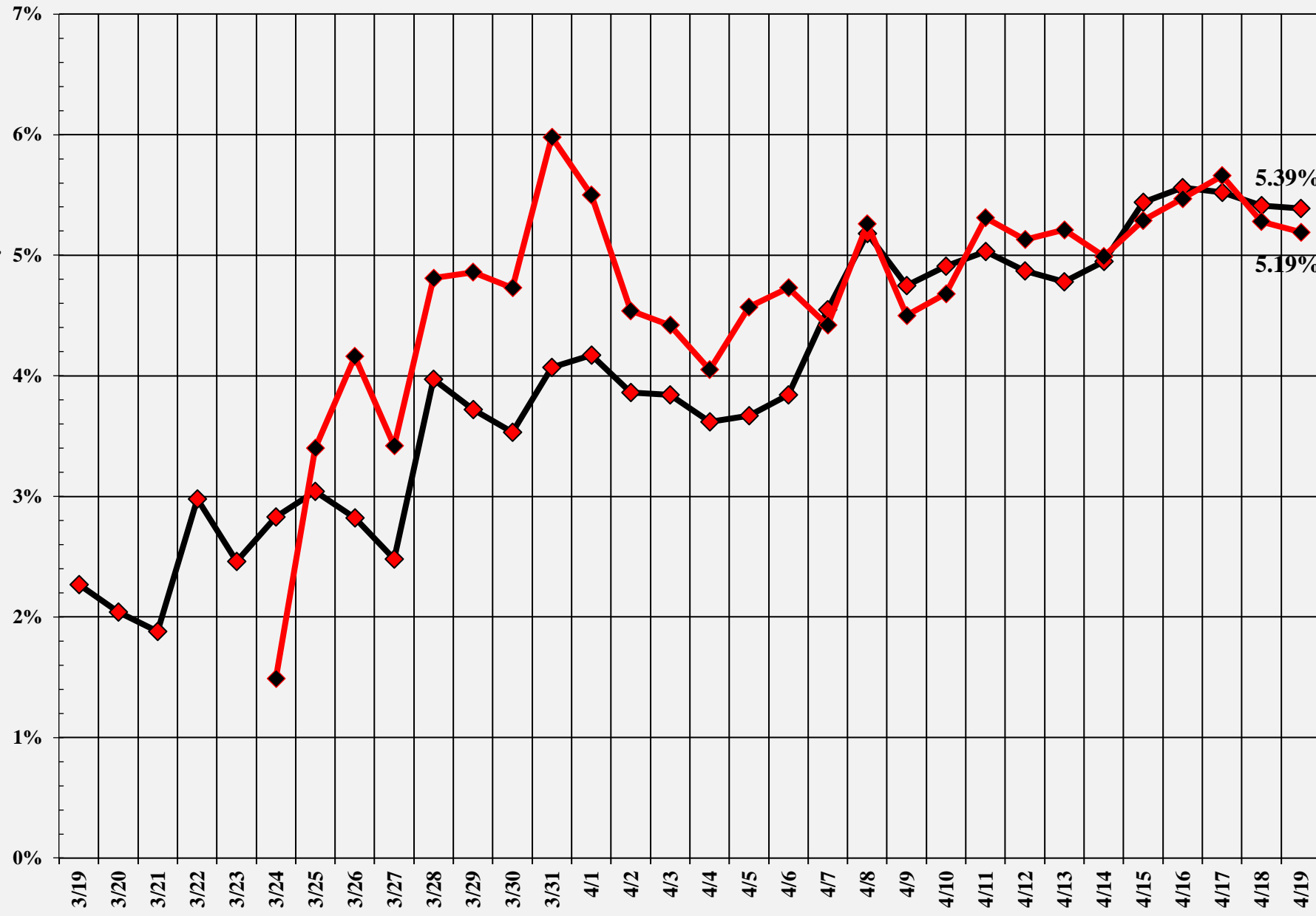

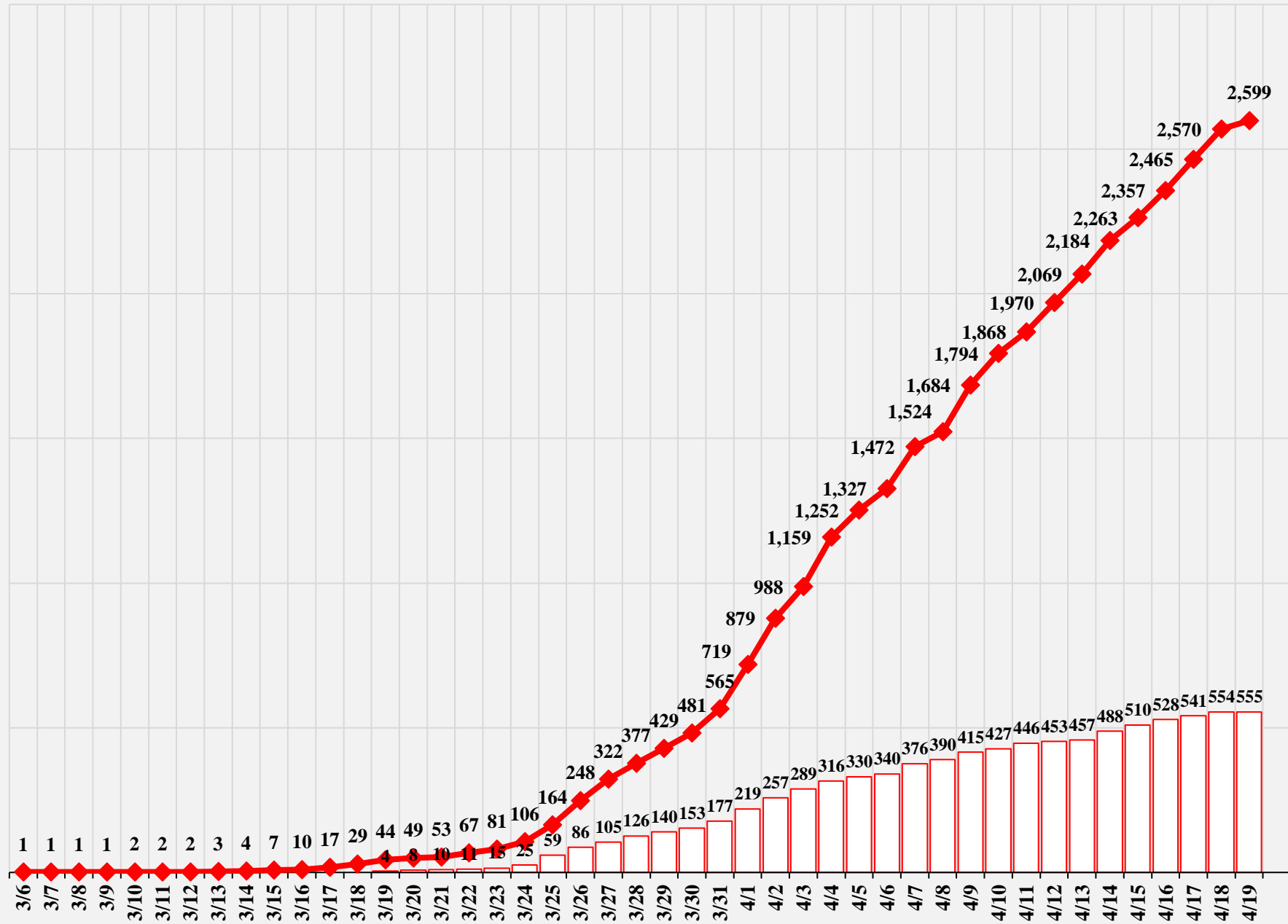
# COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Hospitalizations



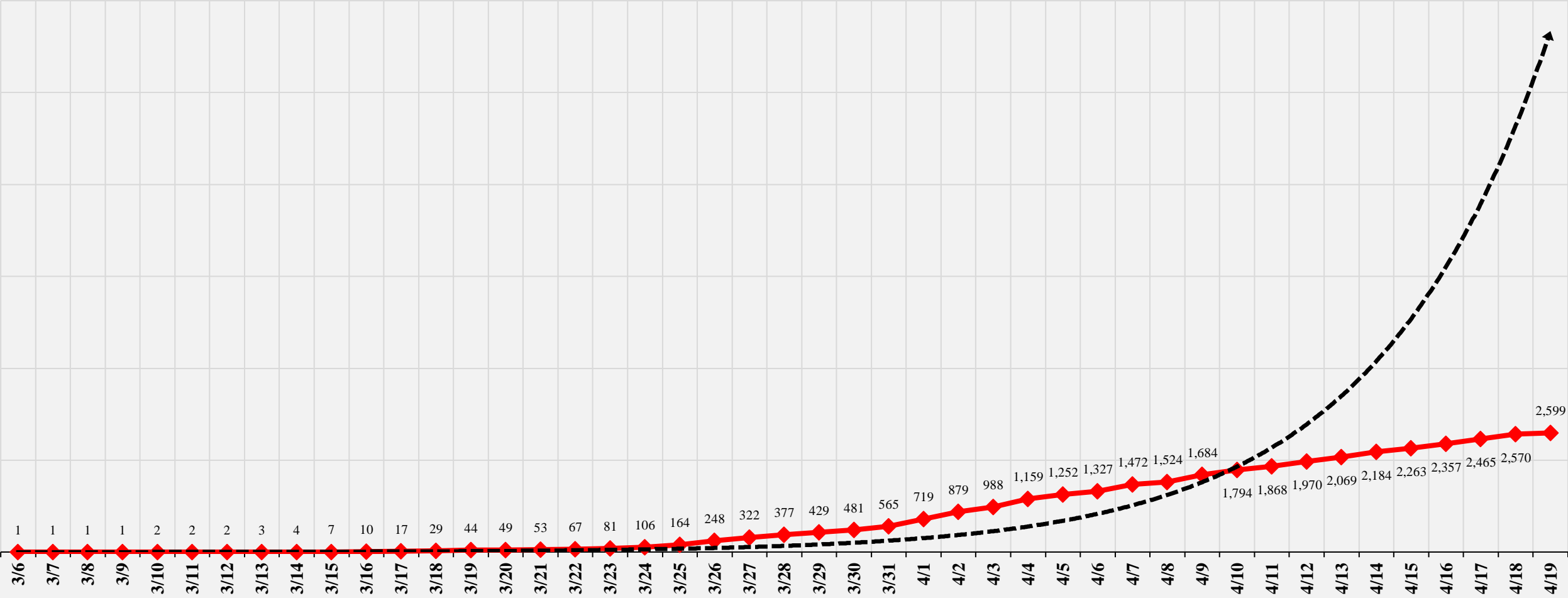


# COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Exponential Growth Estimate

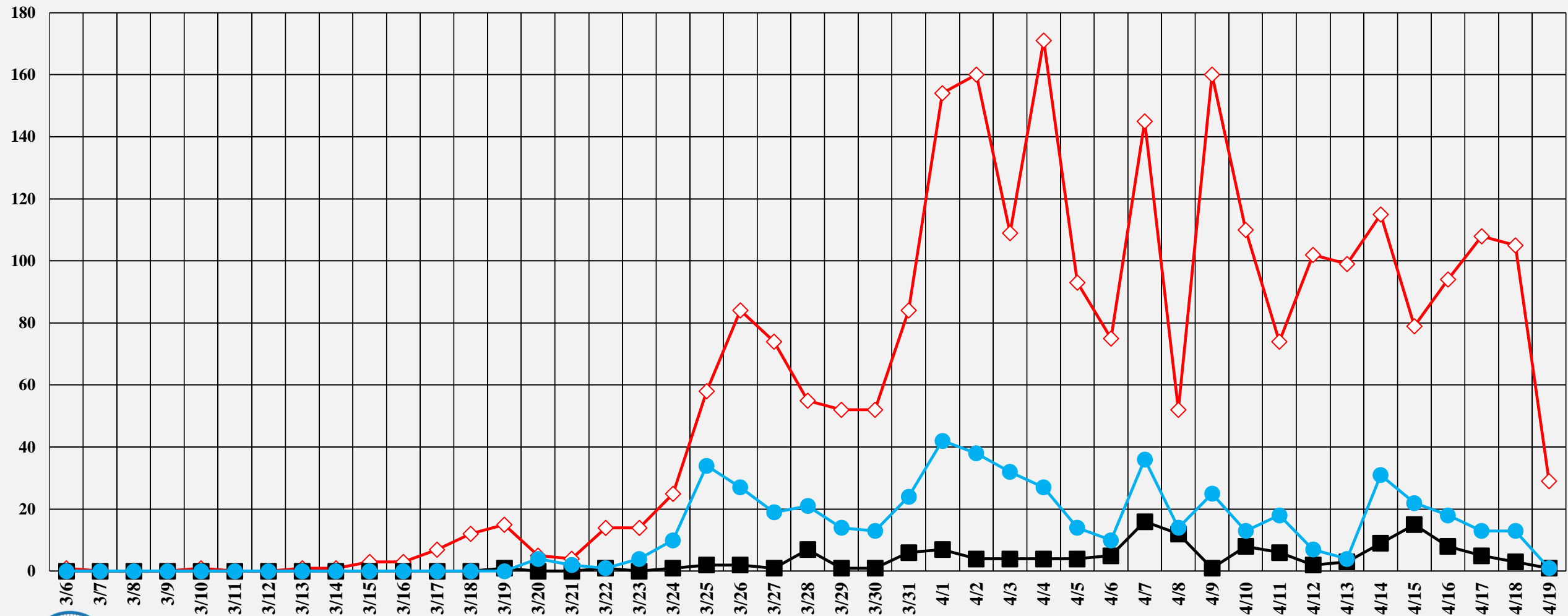

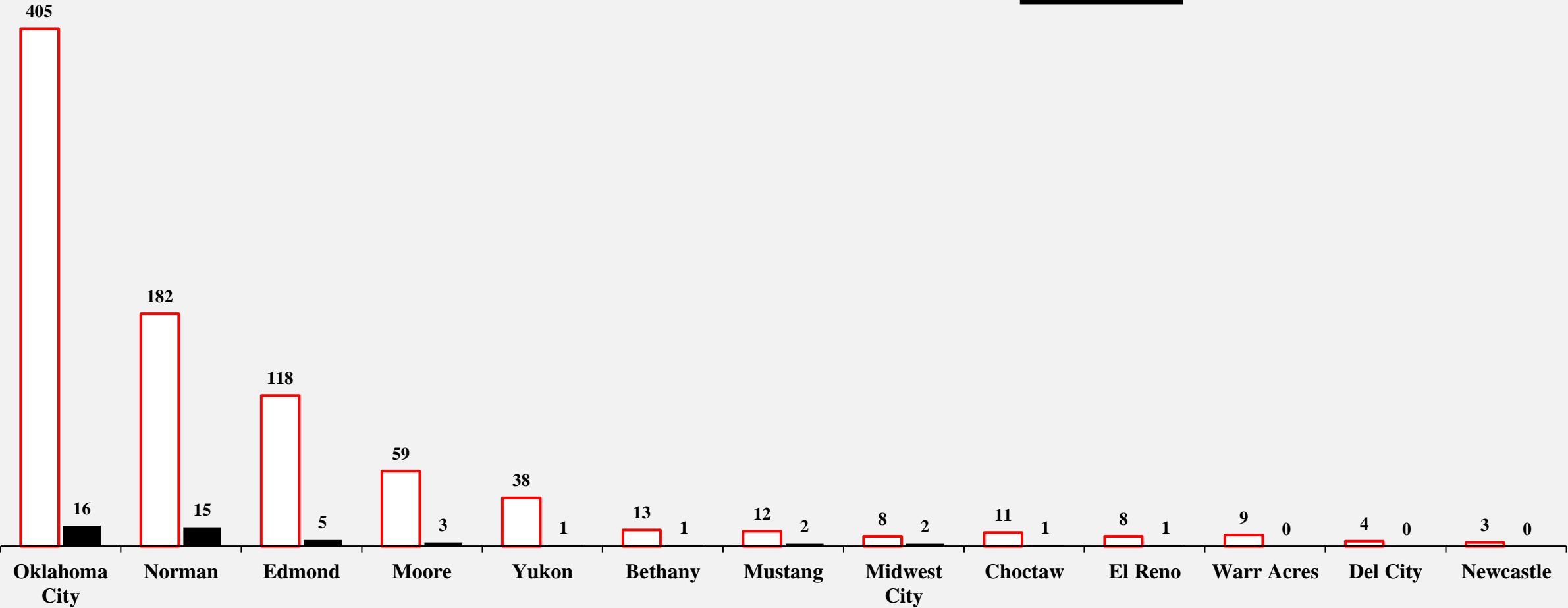
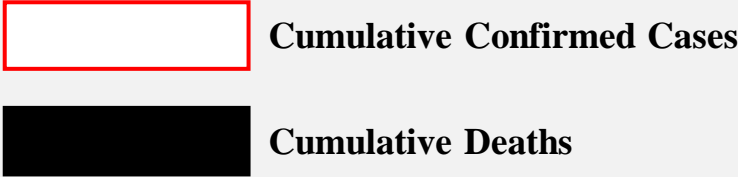




# COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Oklahoma City Metro City, Town

3/19/20 through 4/19/20

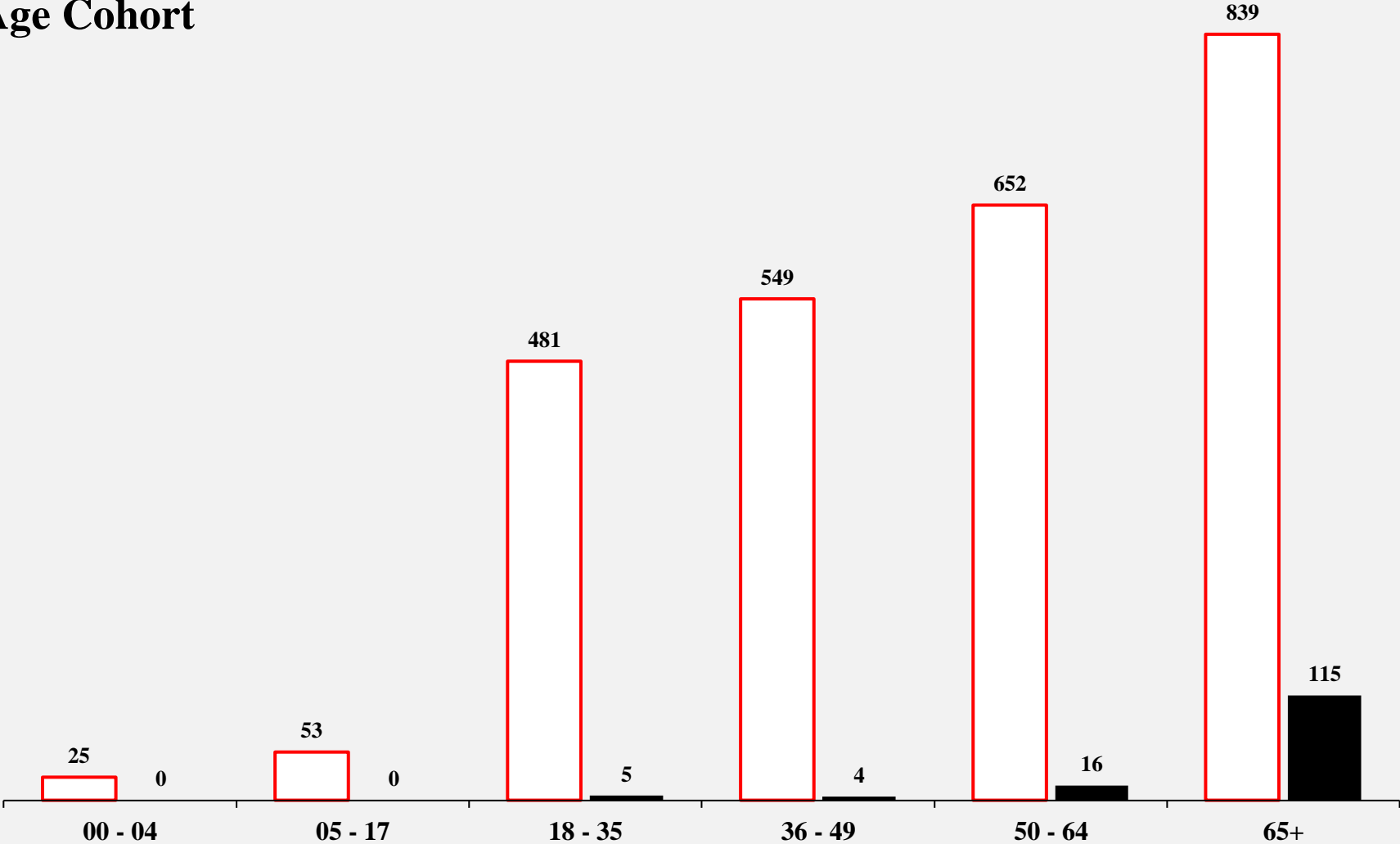

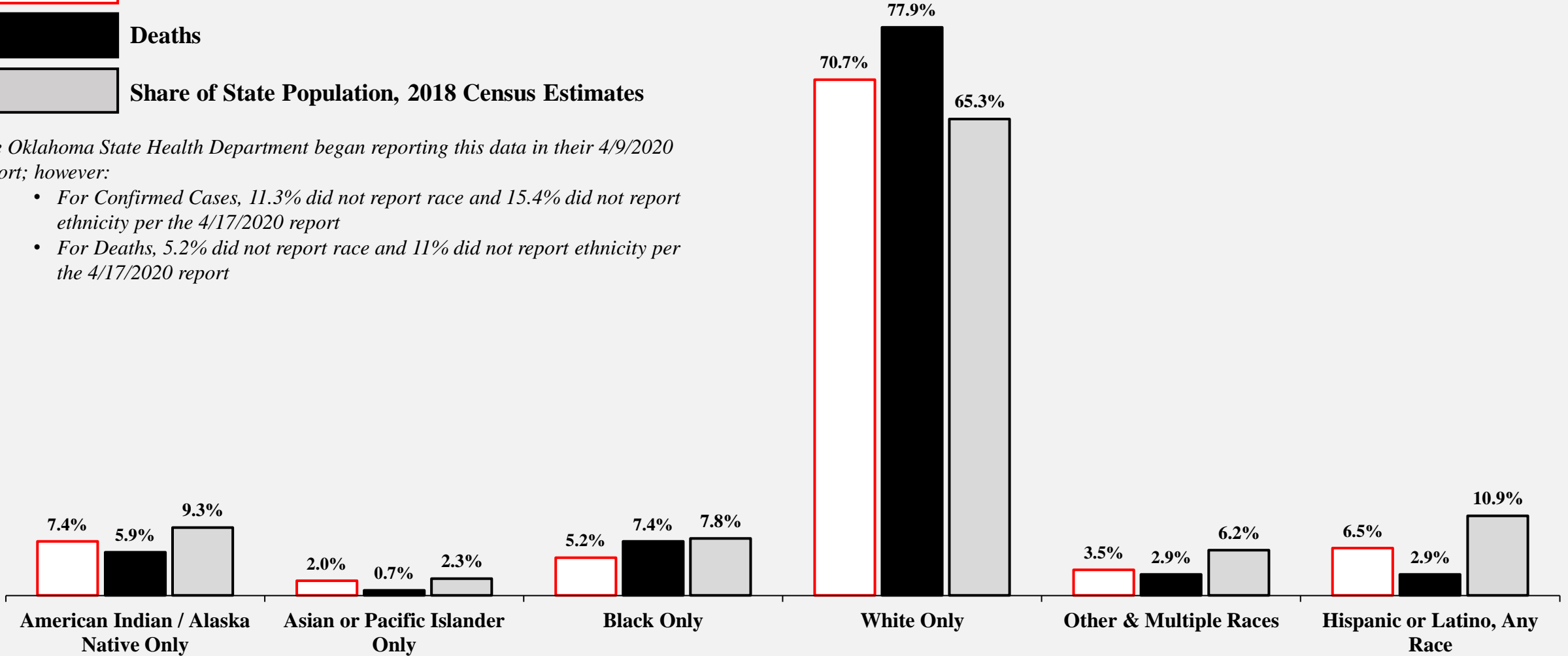

- For Deaths, 5.2% did not report race and 11% did not report ethnicity per the 4/17/2020 report



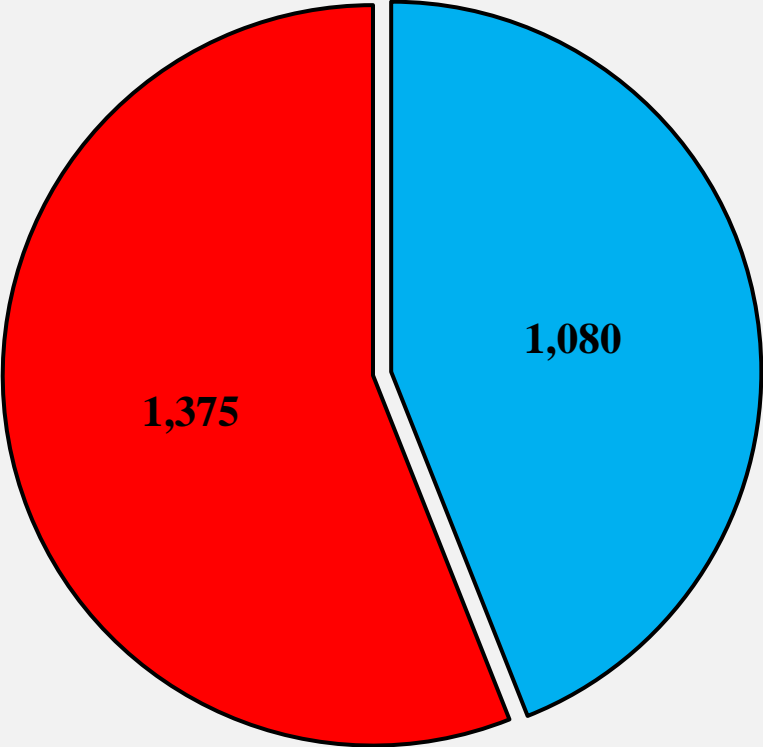

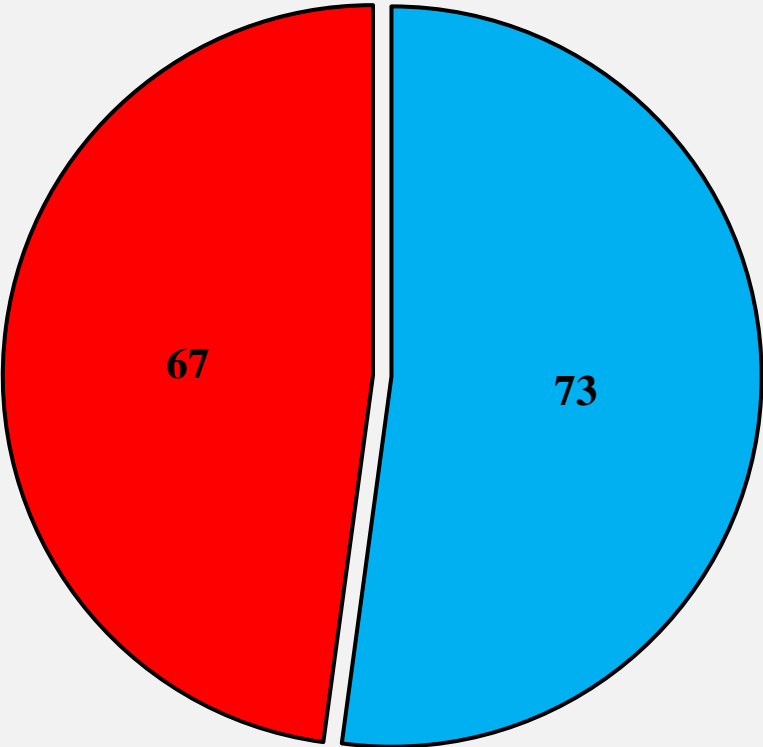

### Cumulative Deaths



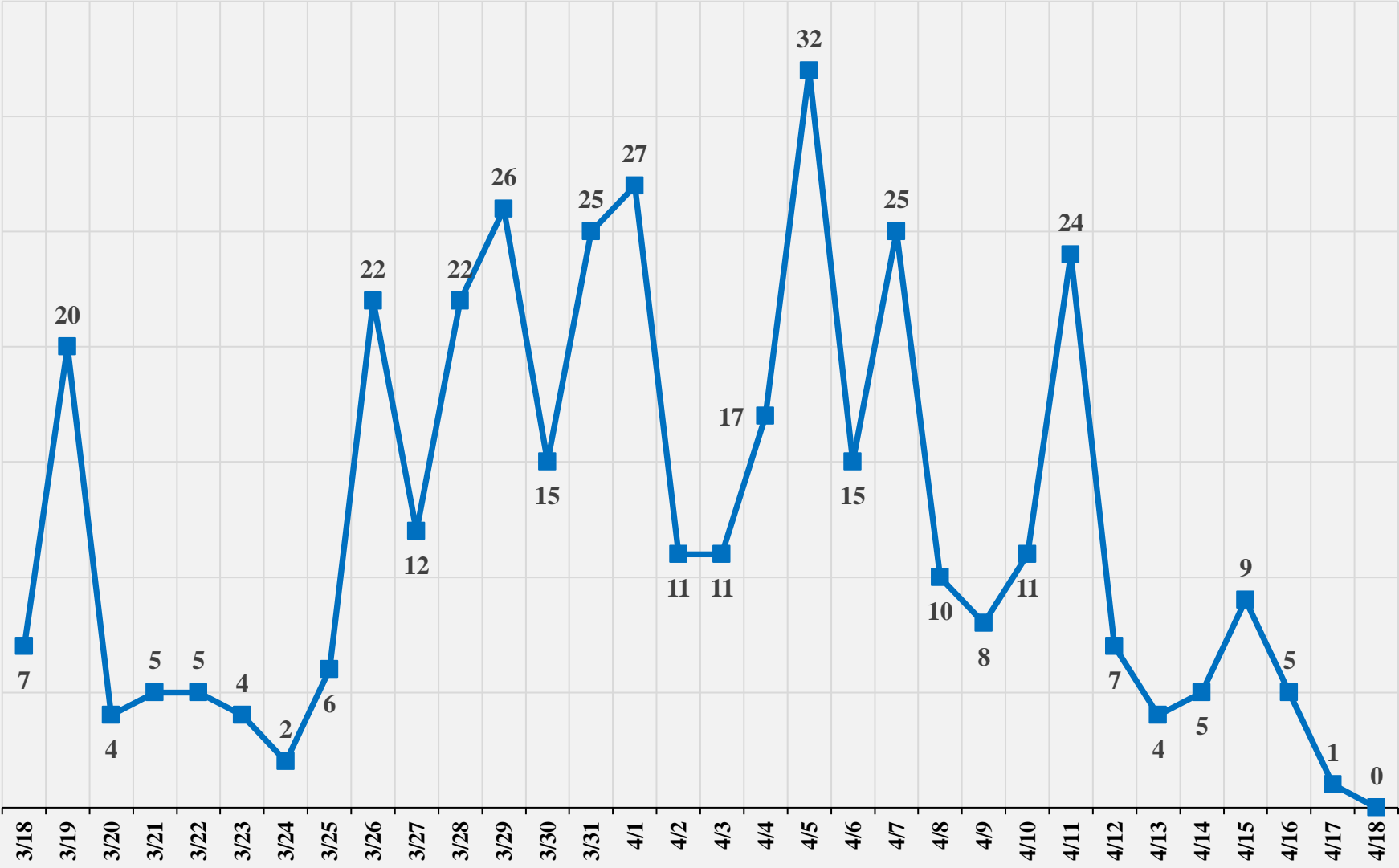
# COVID-19-Related Calls for Service Received by OCPD

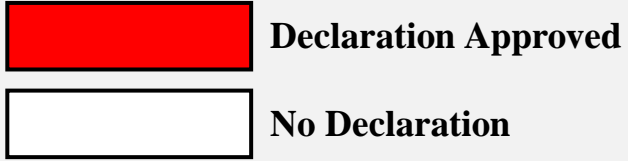

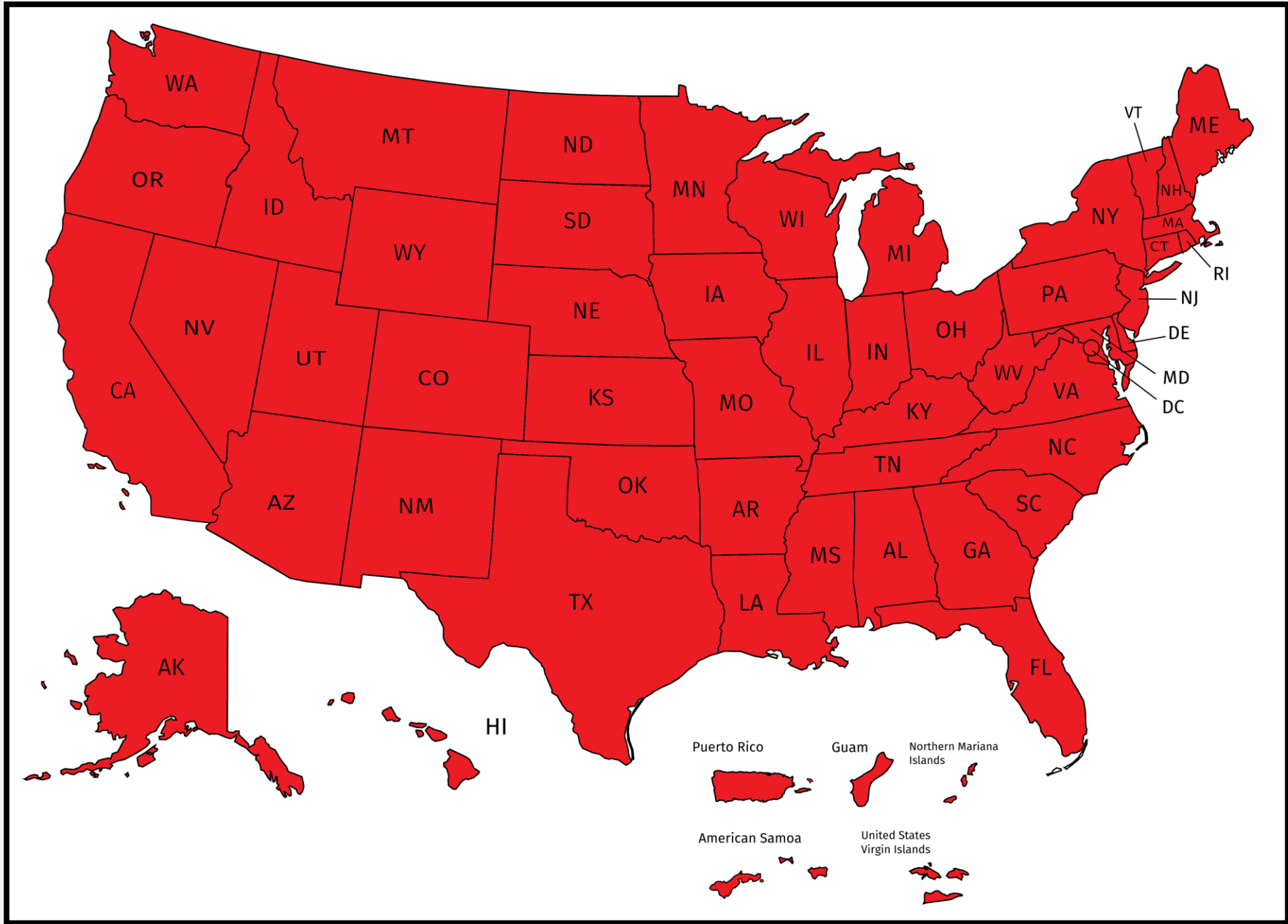
# COVID-19 Major Disaster Declarations by State

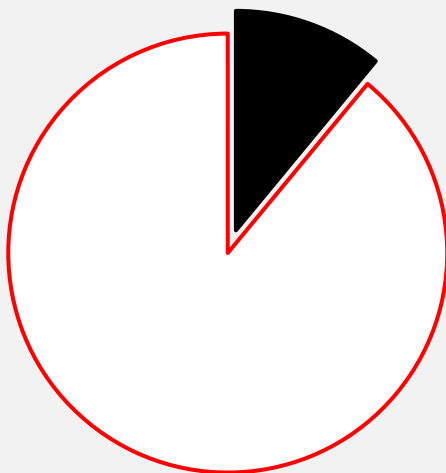

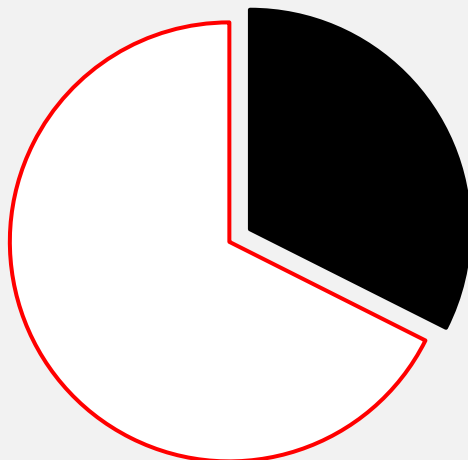

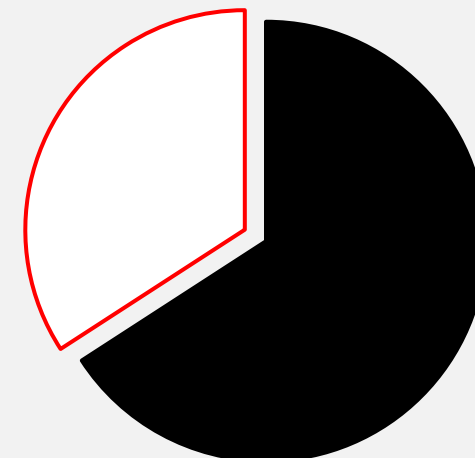

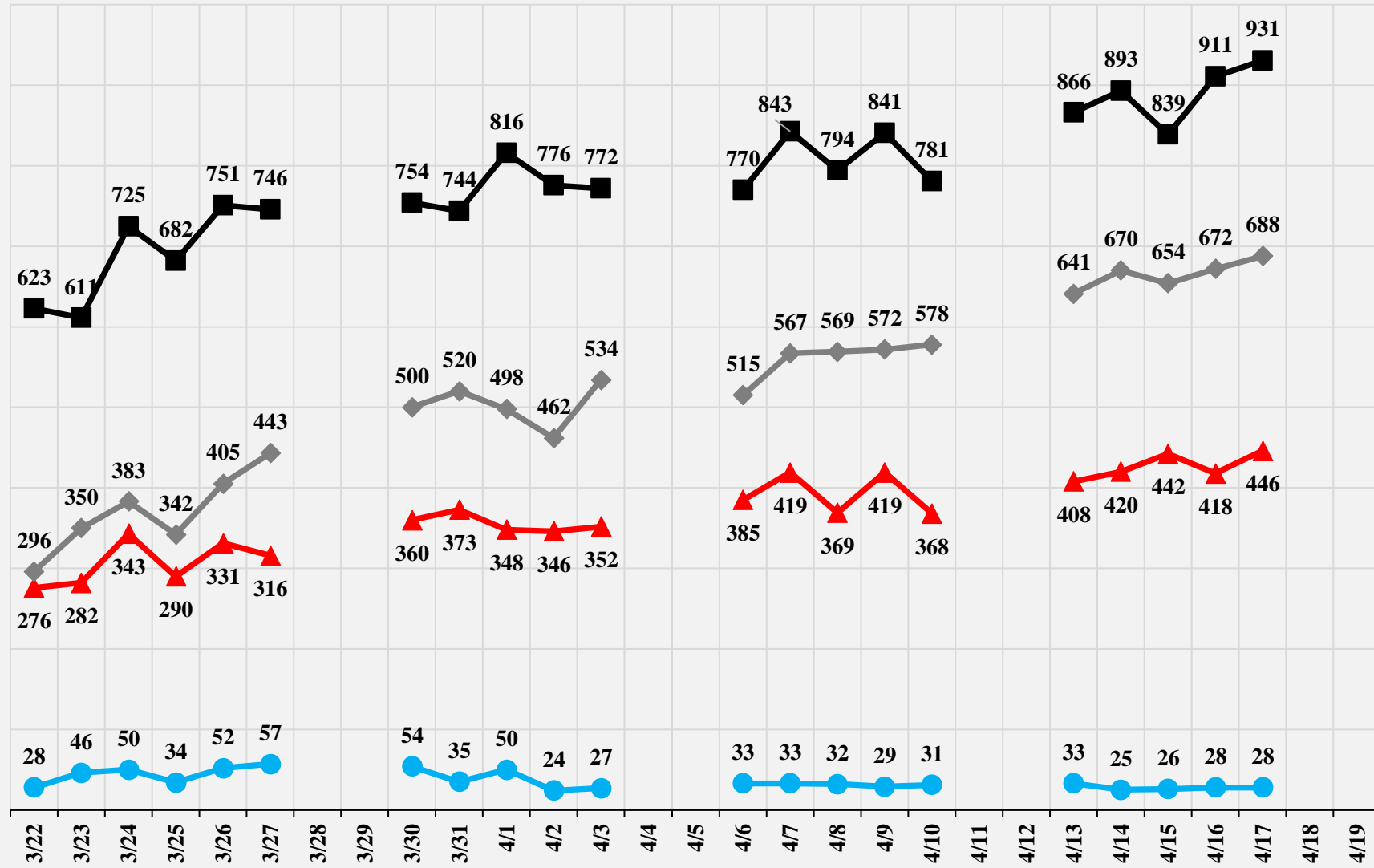

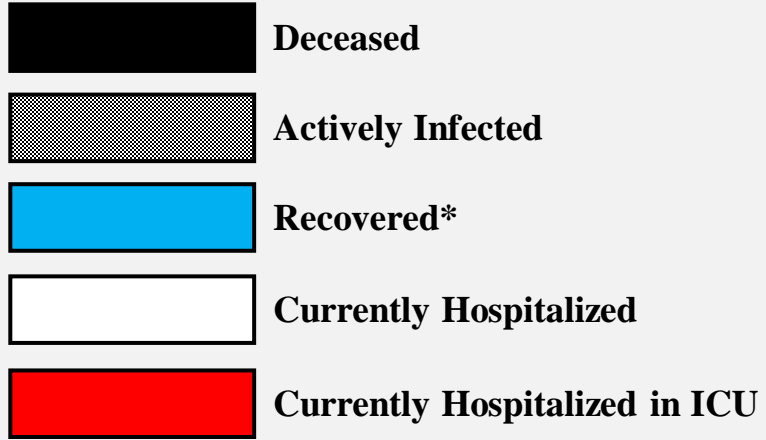

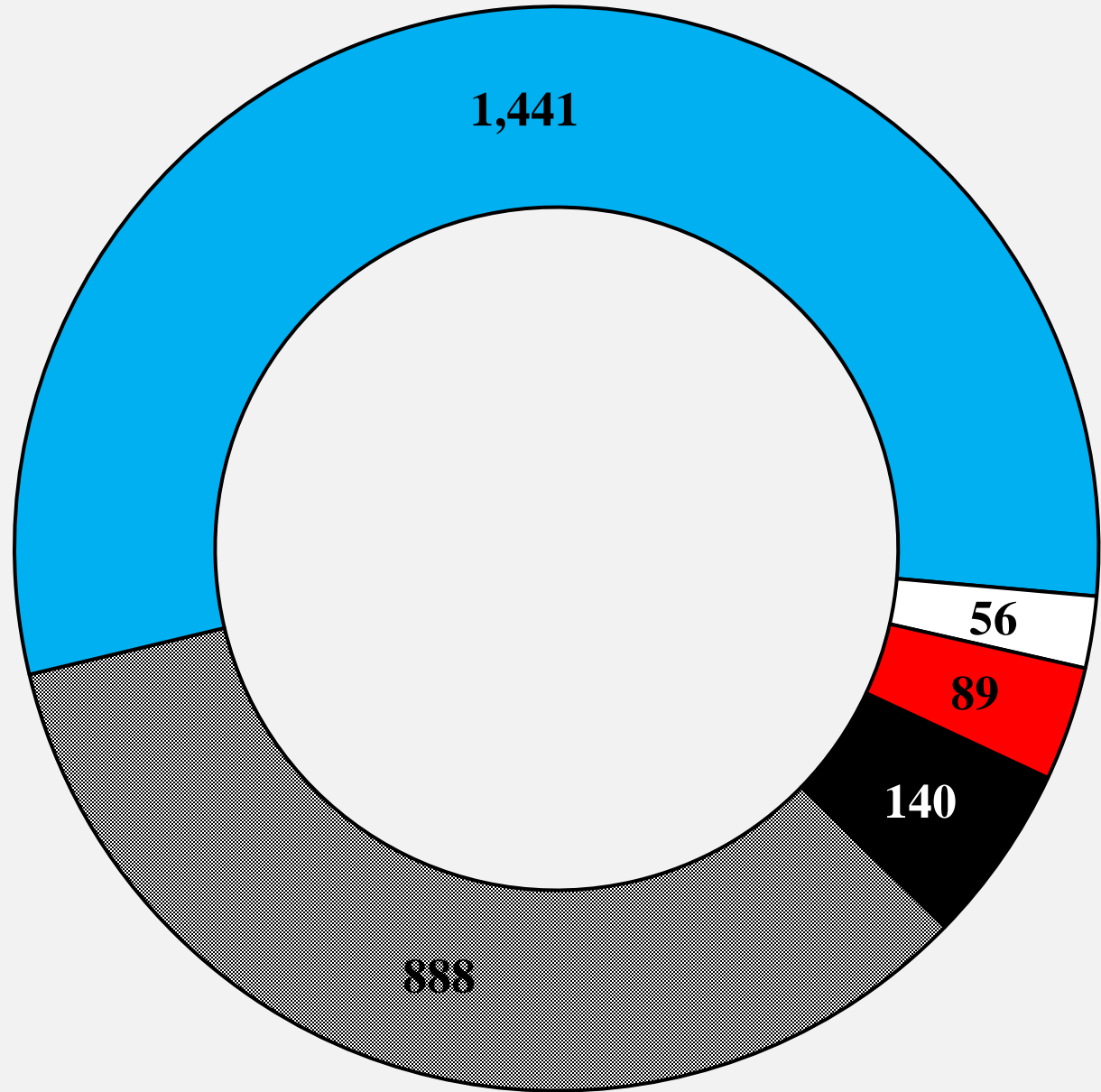

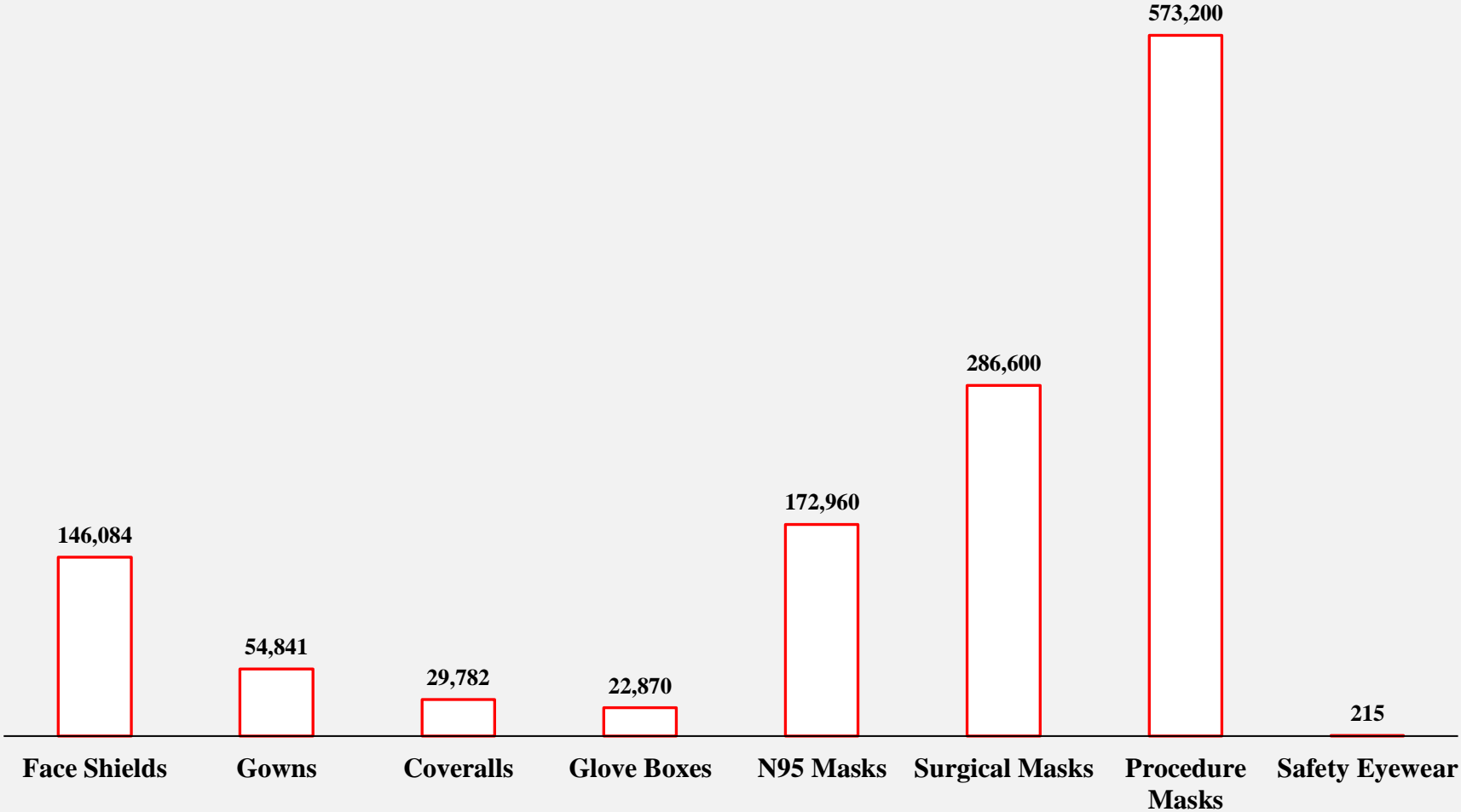

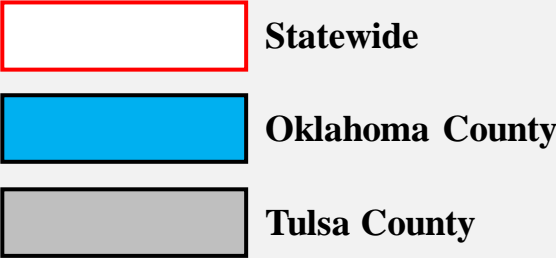

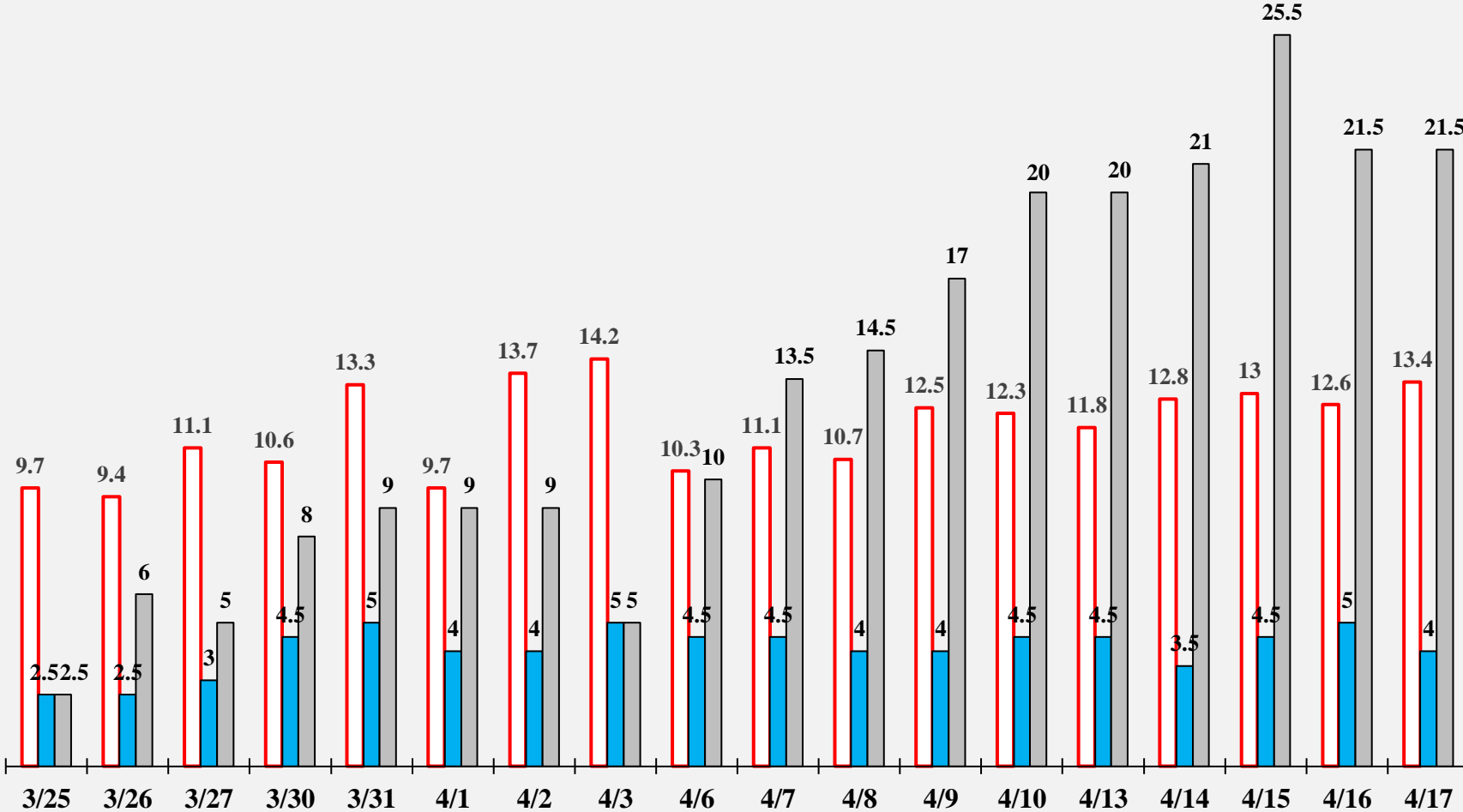
# Statewide Average Days of PPE

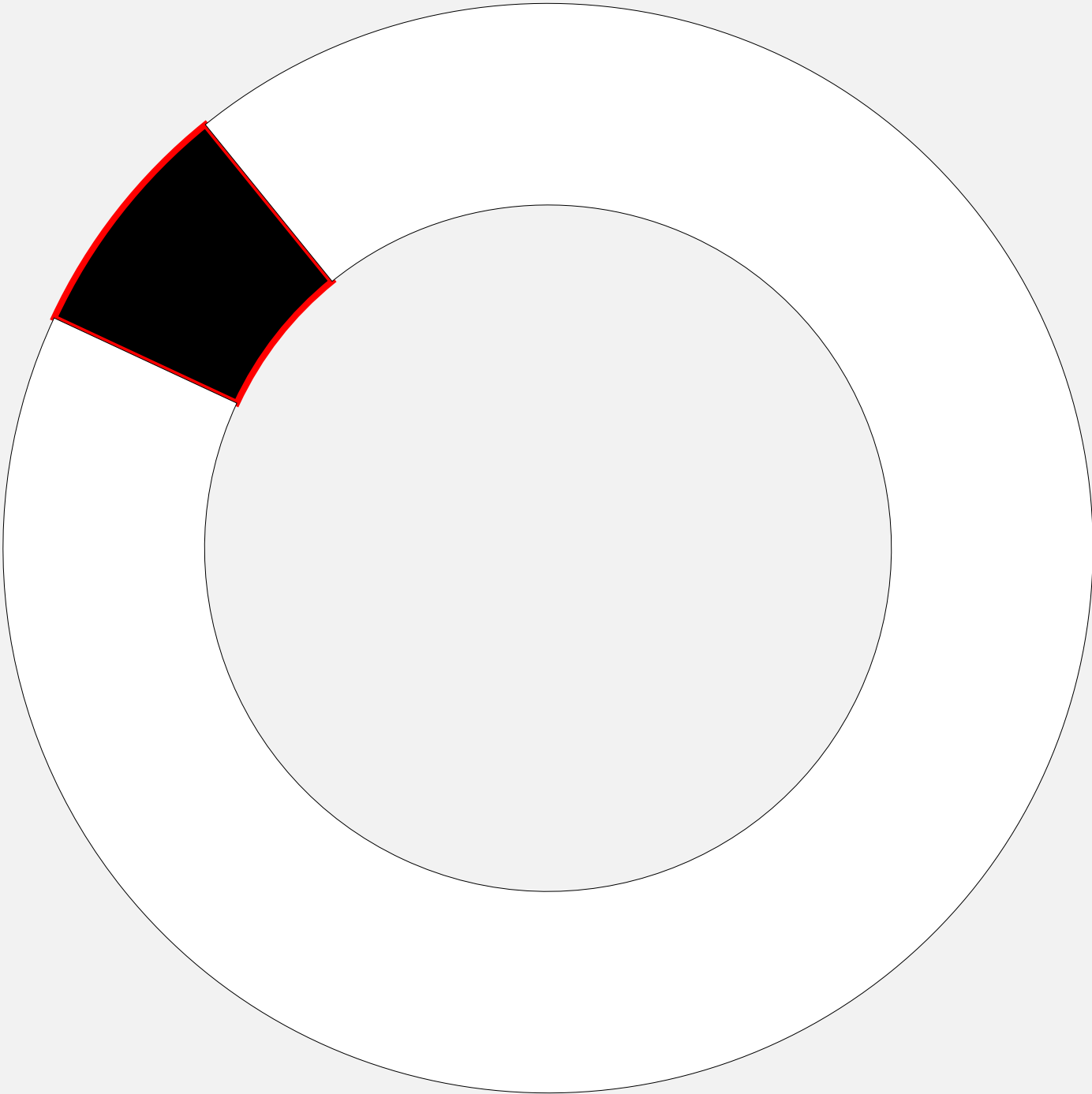

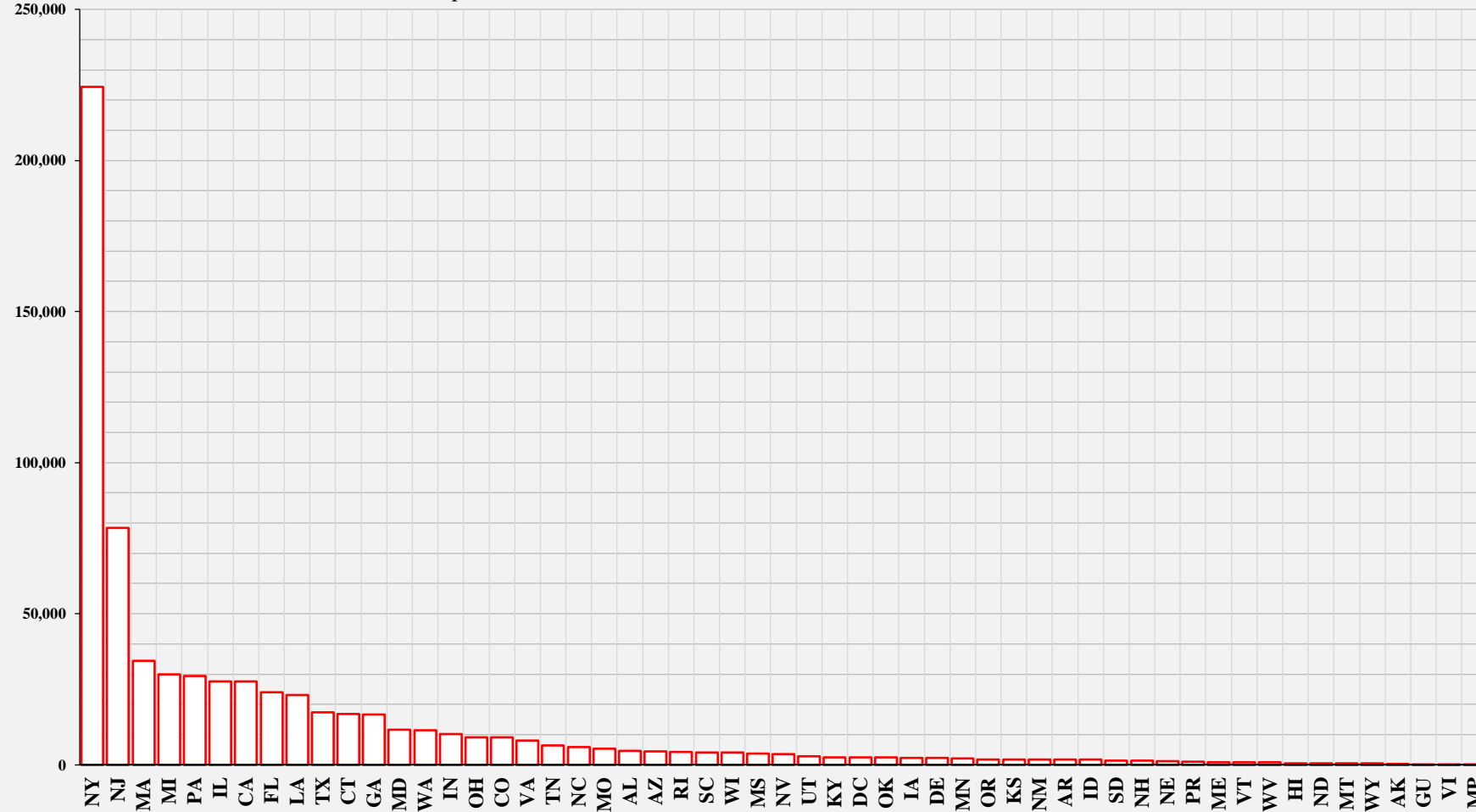

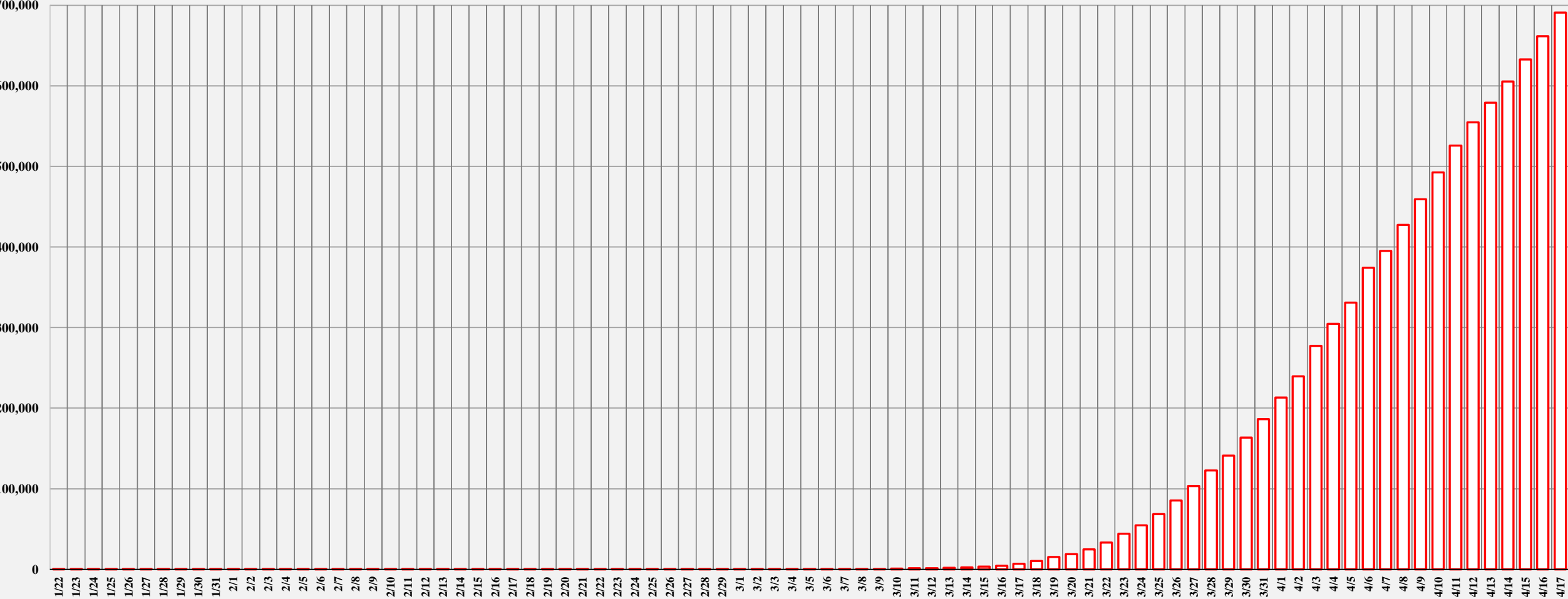

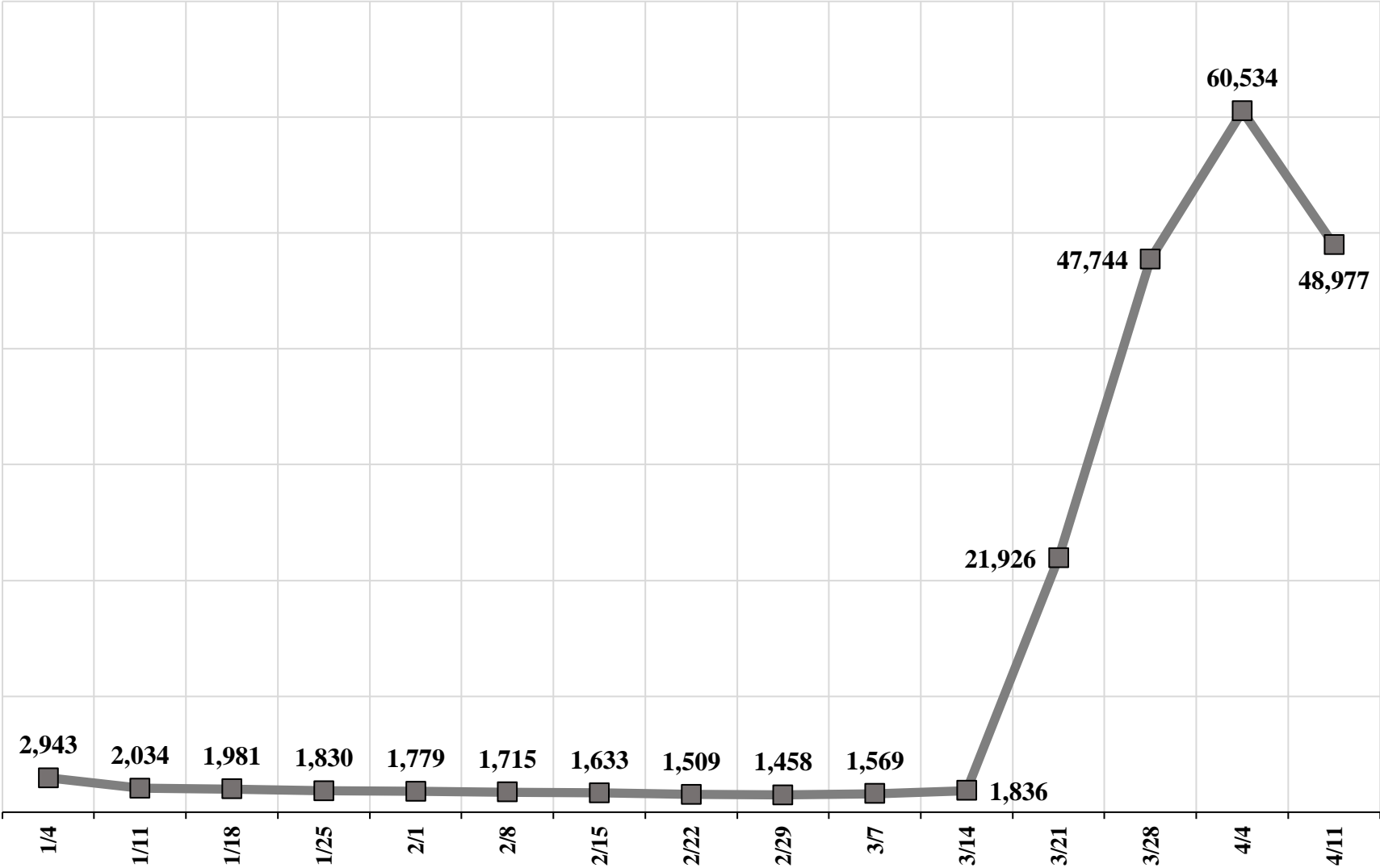
■ Claims
