




# **COVID-19 Confirmed Cases** by Oklahoma City ZIP








### **COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Oklahoma City Metro City, Town**




# **COVID-19-Related Calls for Service Received by OCPD**

These calls for service are logged by the Oklahoma City Police Department related to the Mayor's emergency proclamation.















## COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Hospitalizations






### **COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Exponential Growth Estimate**



















### **Statewide Average Days of PPE**












### **COVID-19 Confirmed U.S. Cases**



  - A countrywide national emergency due to COVID-19 declared by the President on 3/13/20




Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor.
