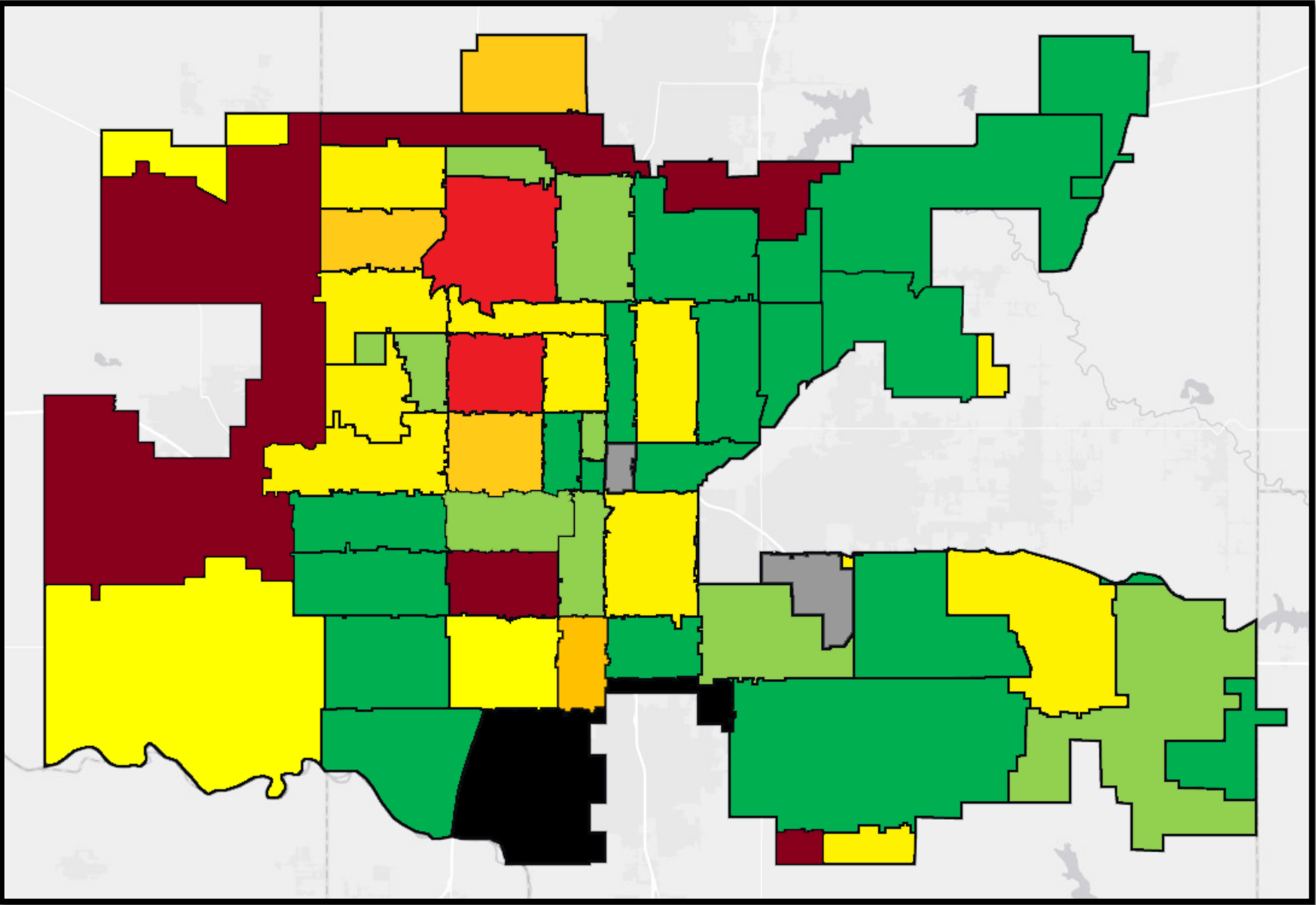

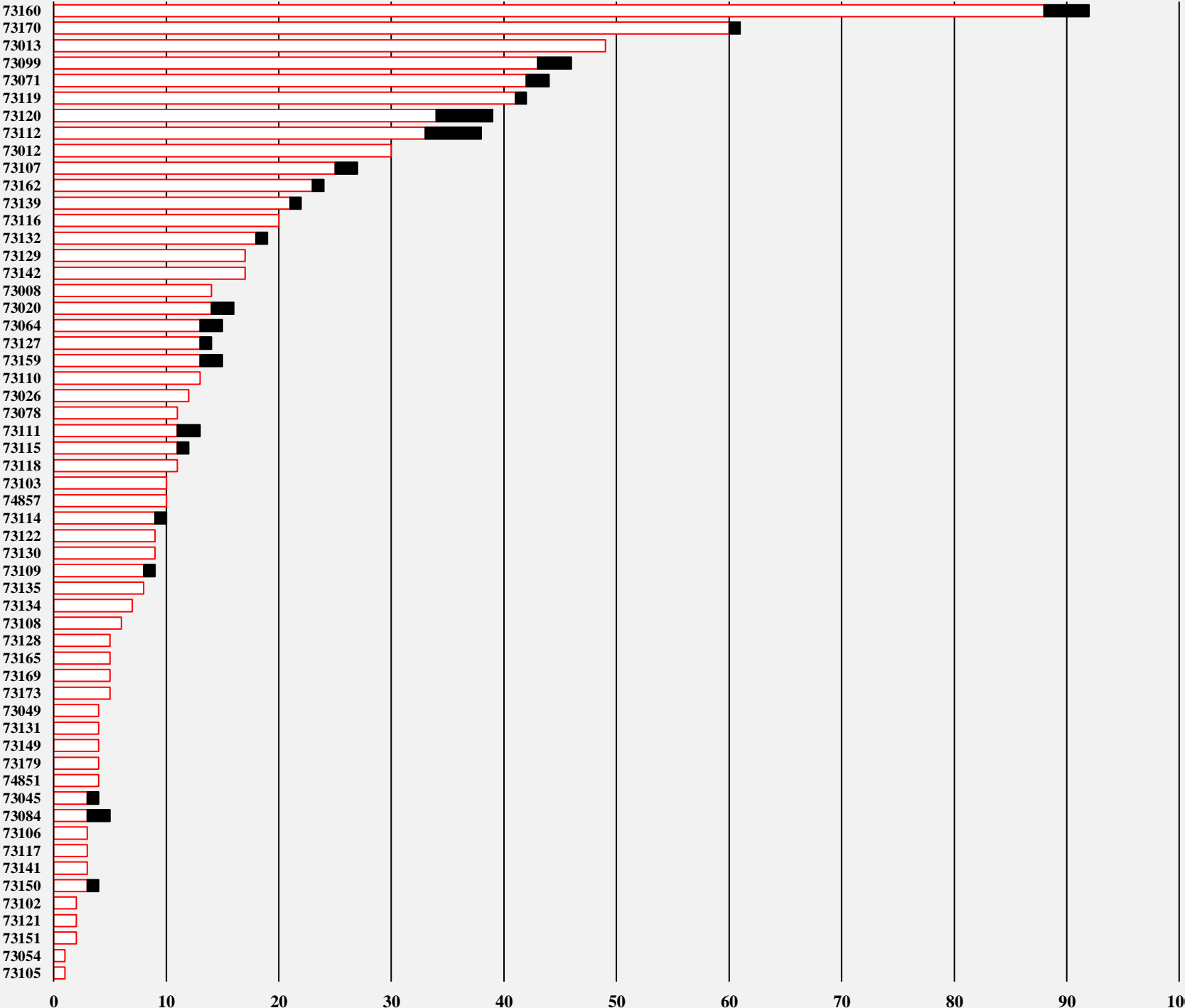

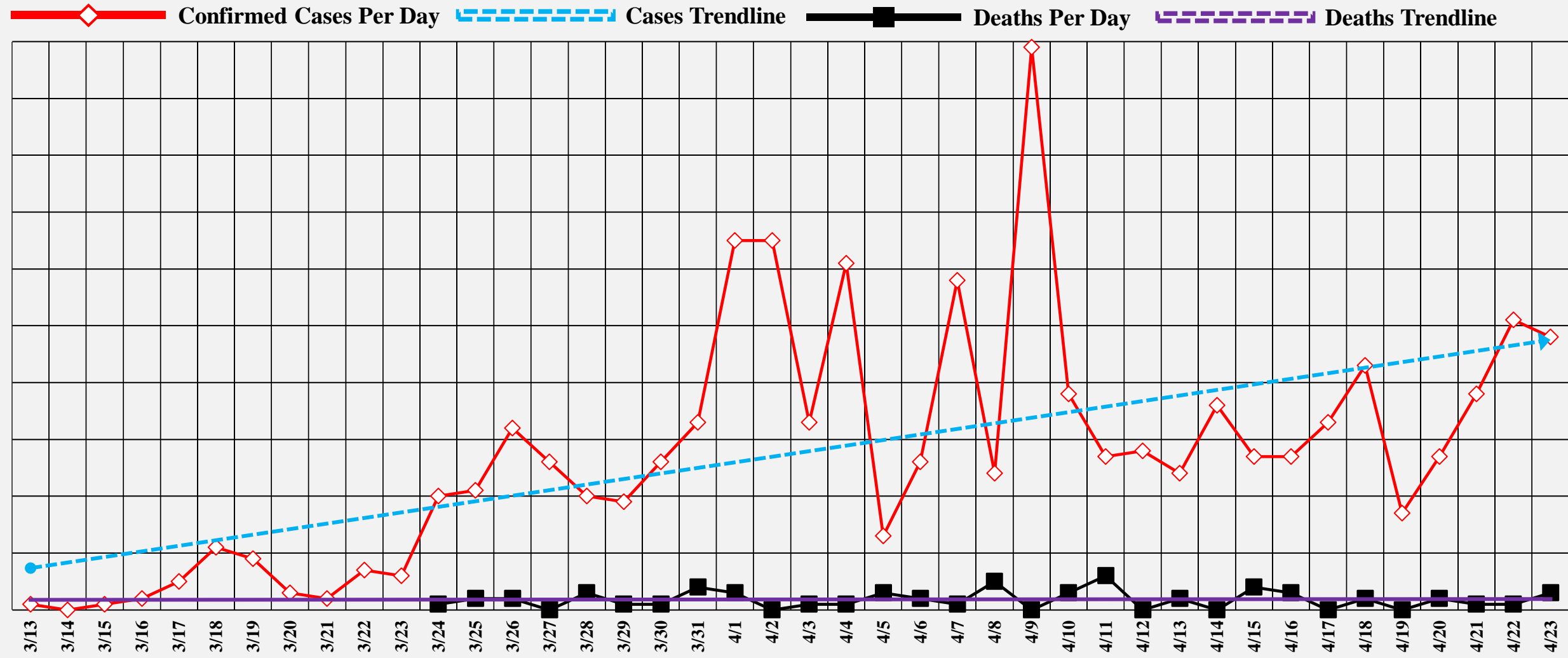


COVID-19 Oklahoma City Metro Counties Cases and Deaths Per Day

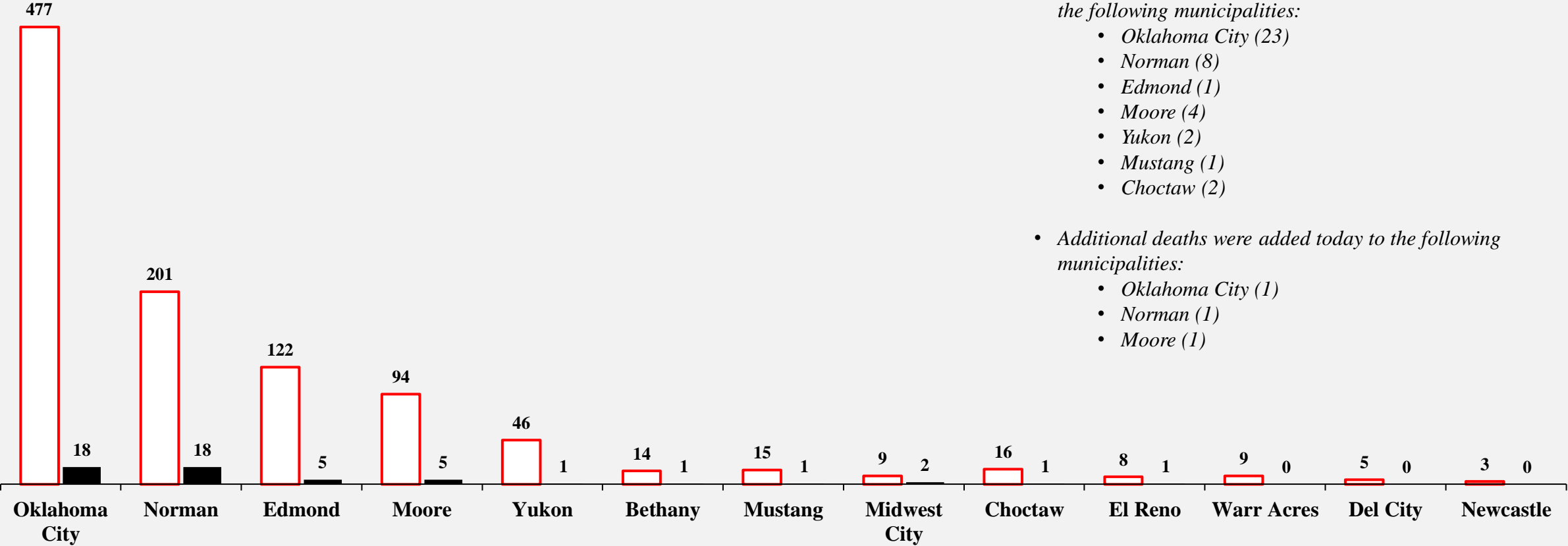
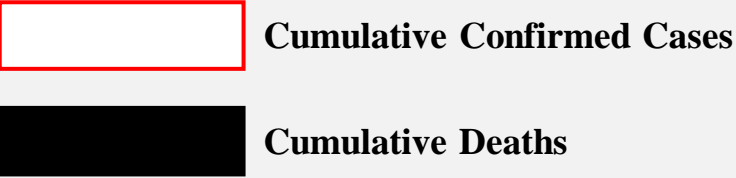

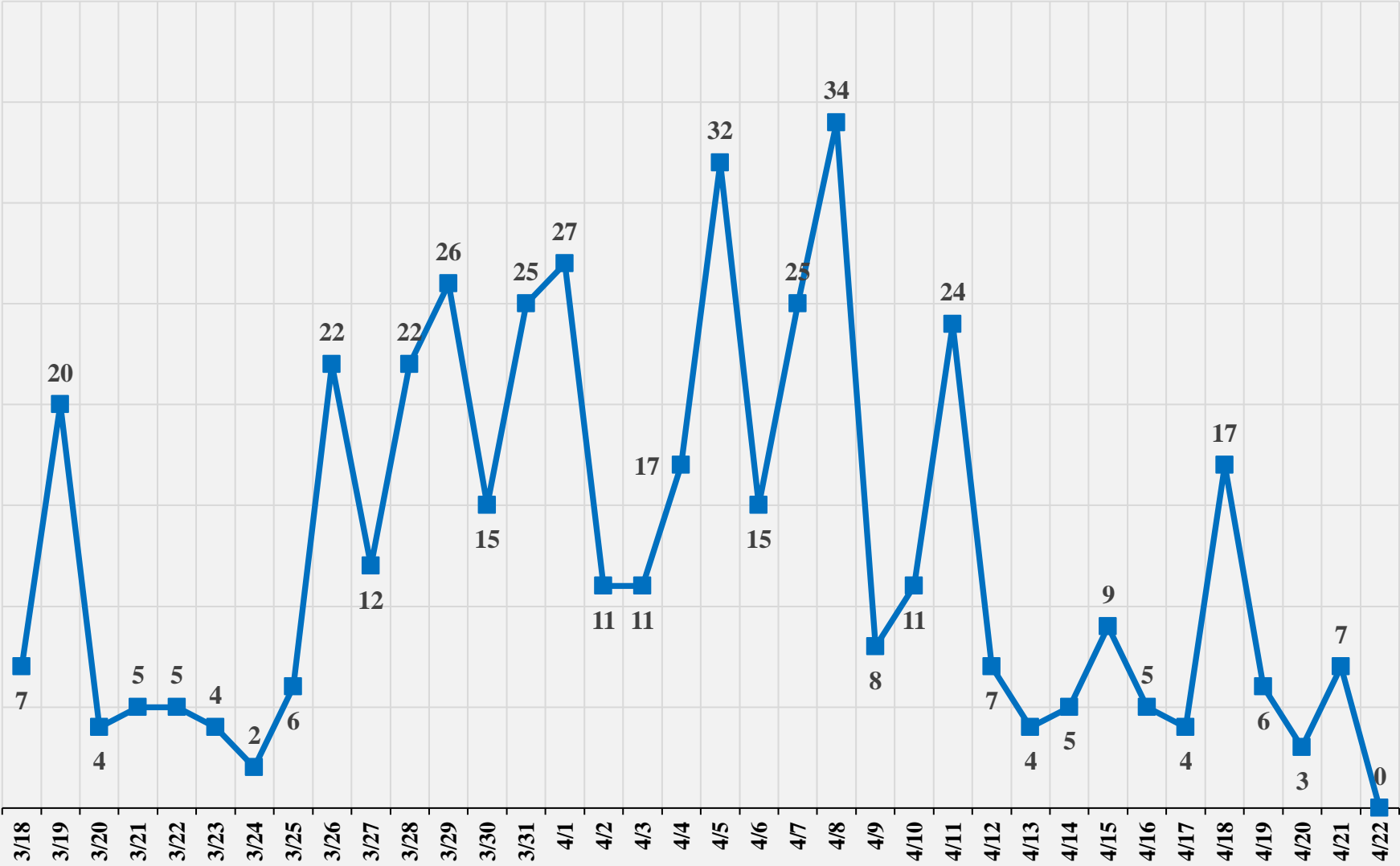

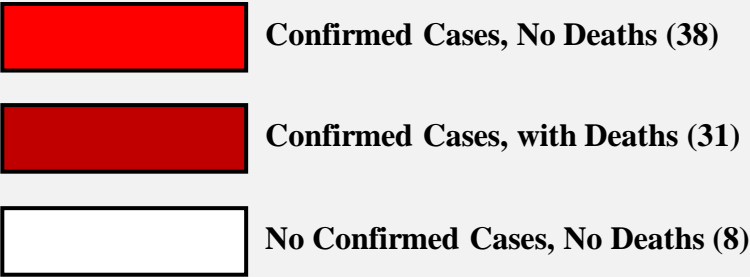

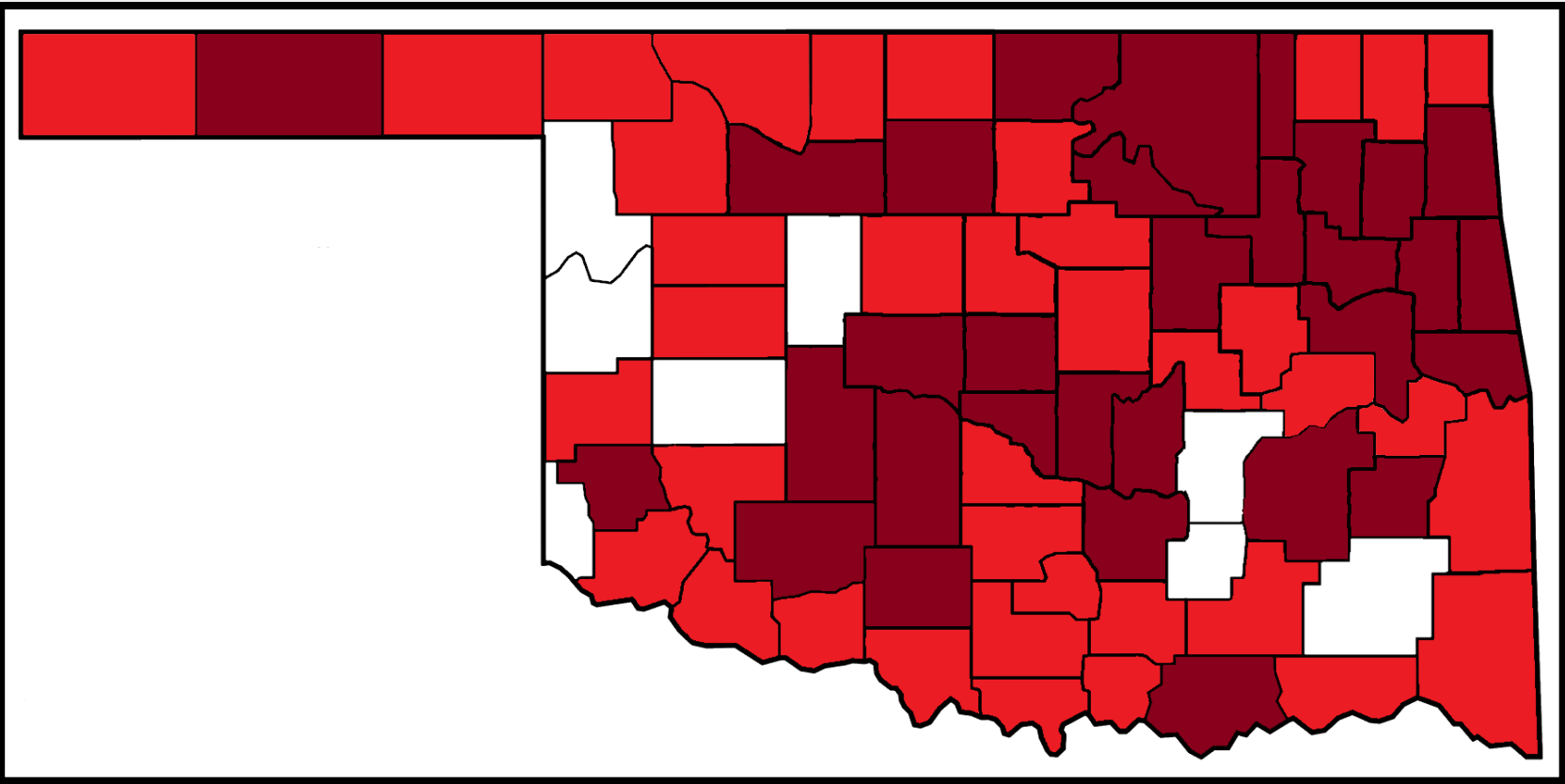
Cases and Deaths By County

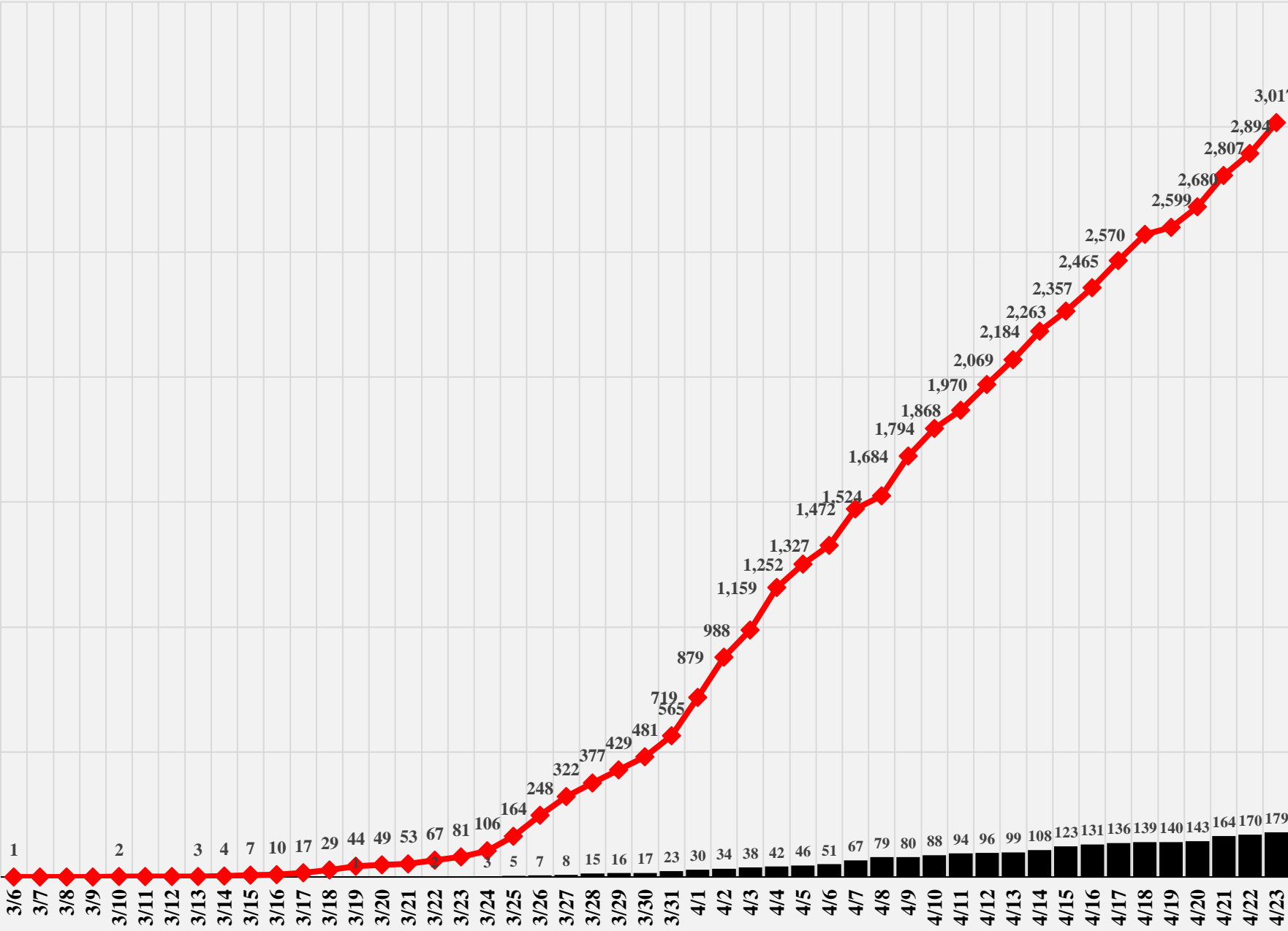

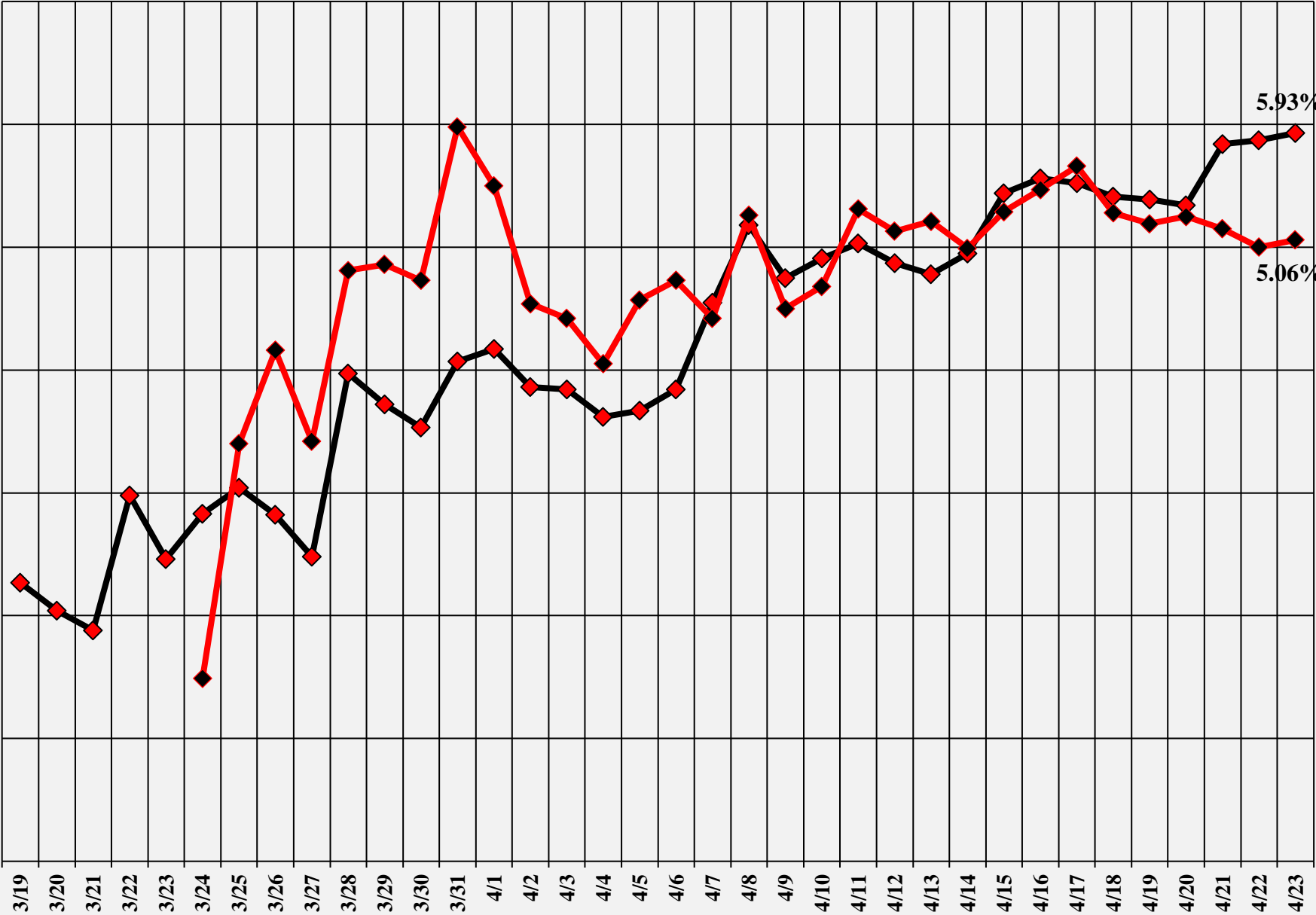
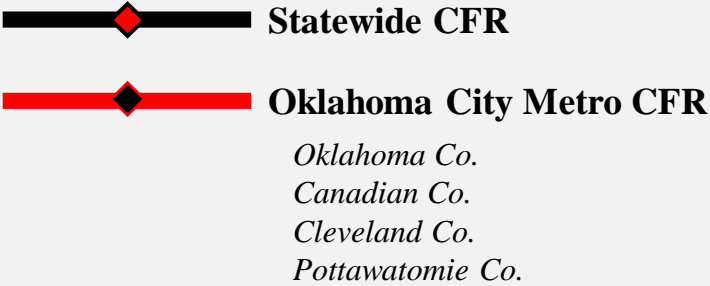


COVID-19 Statewide Case Fatality Rate (CFR) Per Day

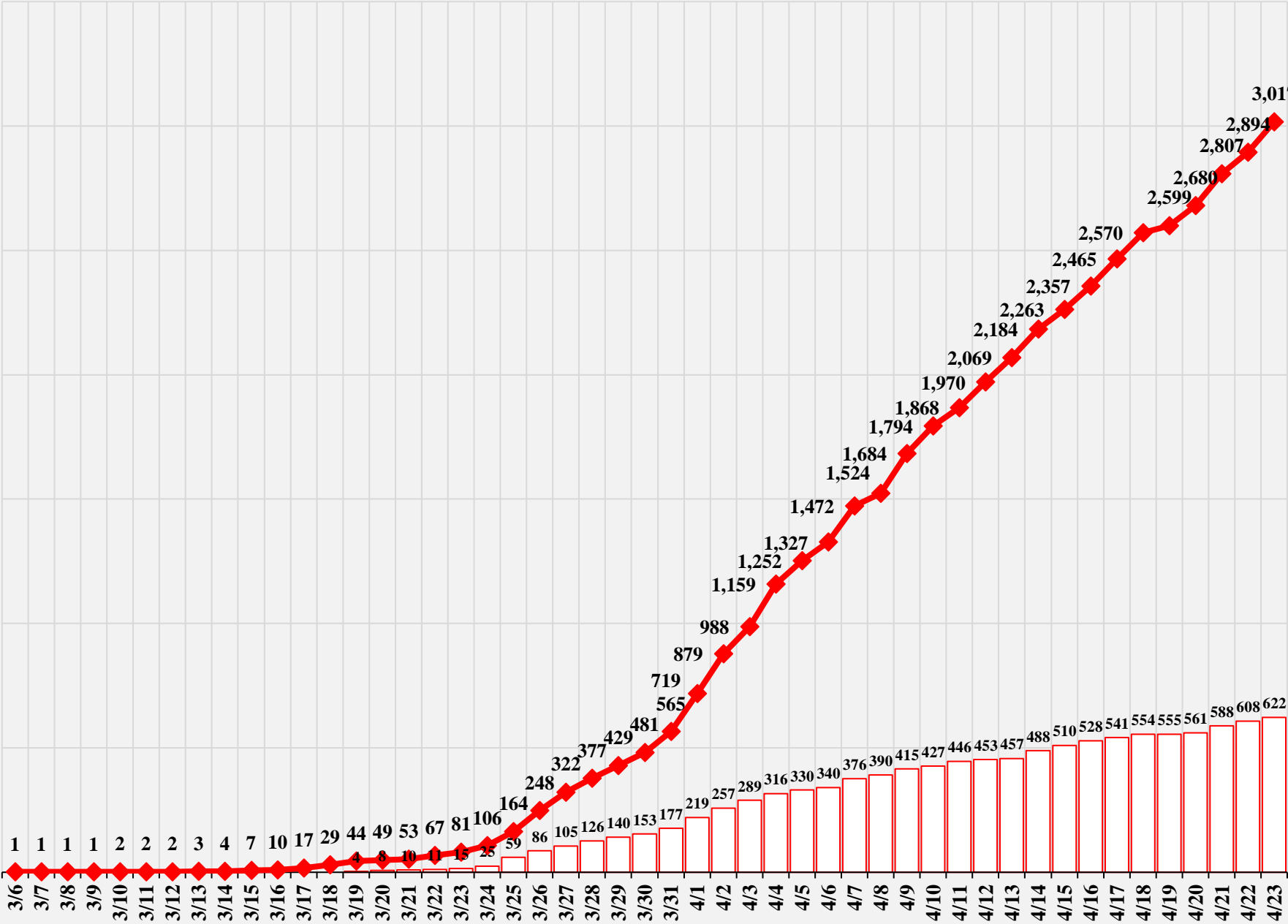
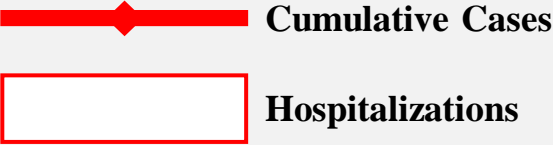

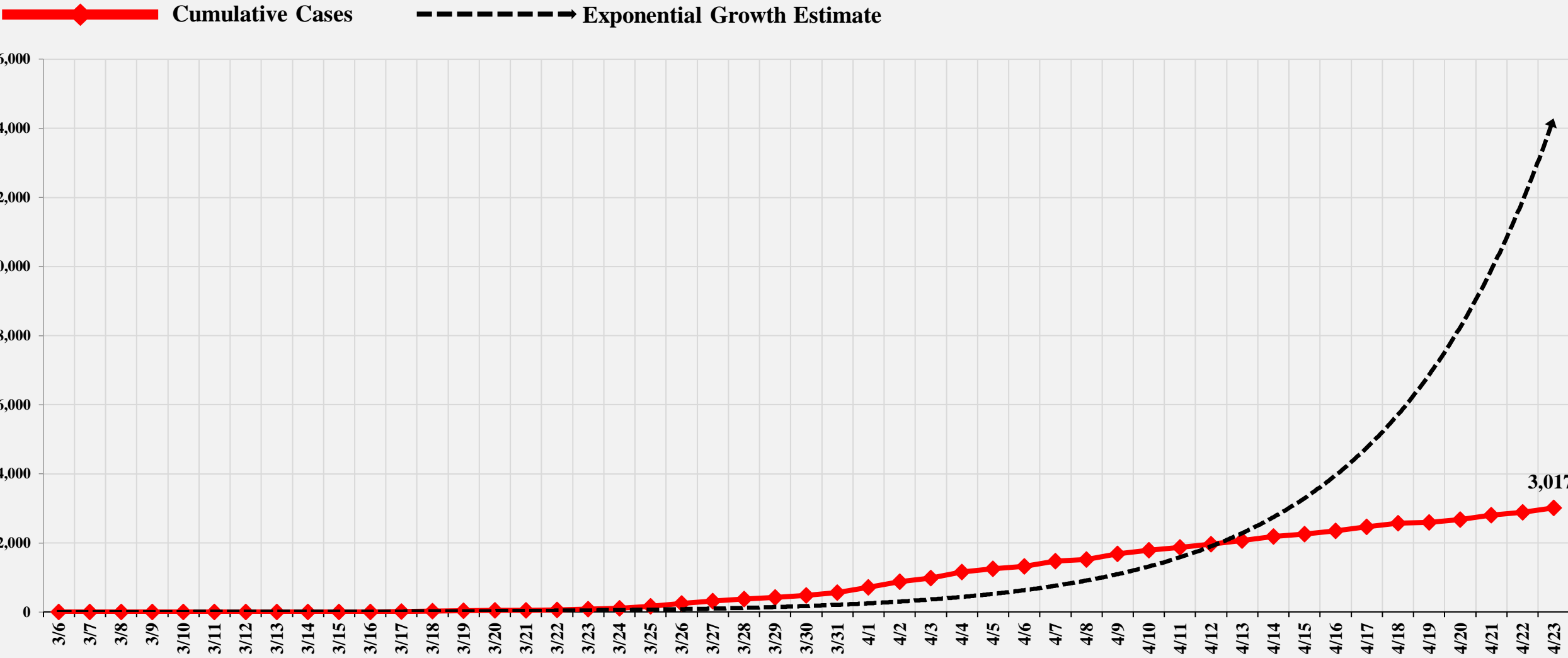

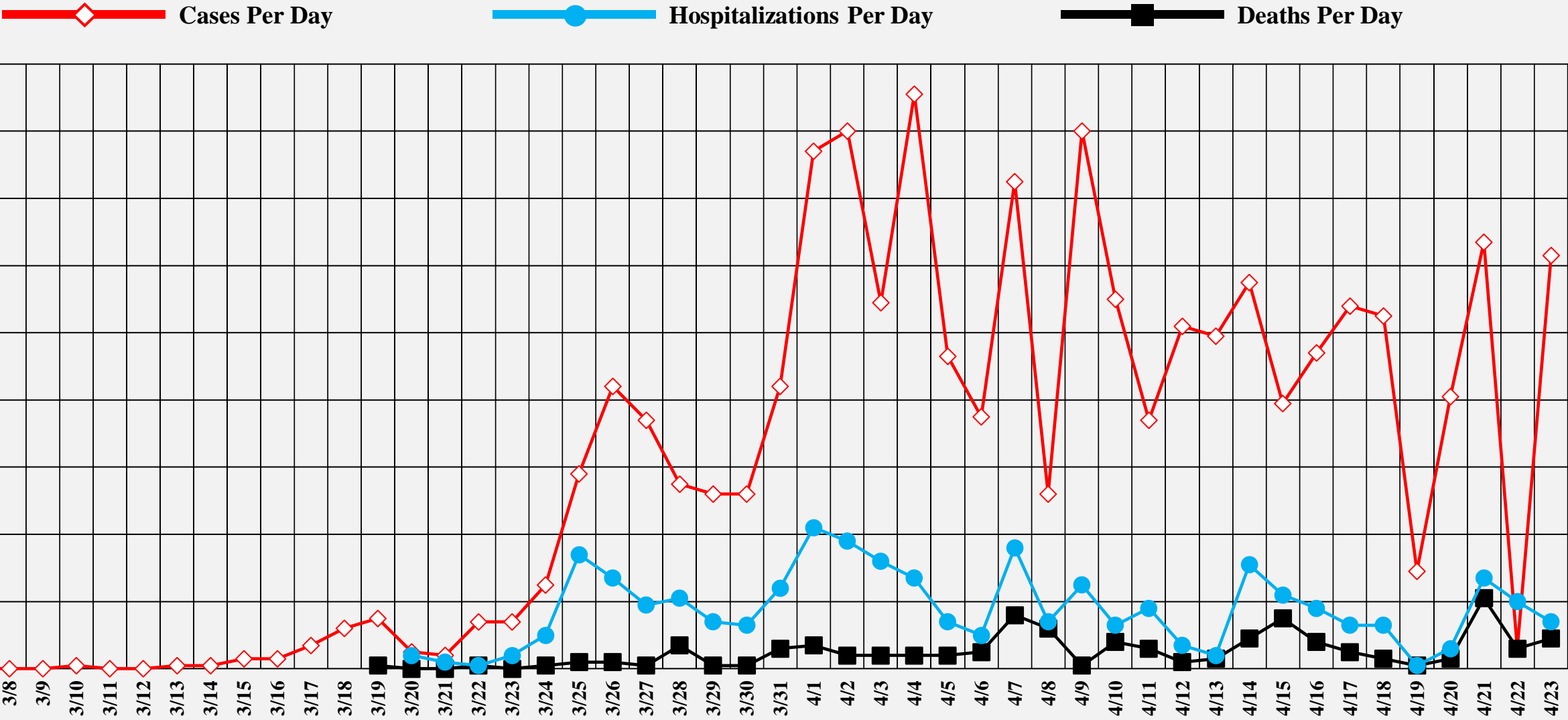


COVID-19 Statewide Cases, Hospitalizations, and Deaths Per Day

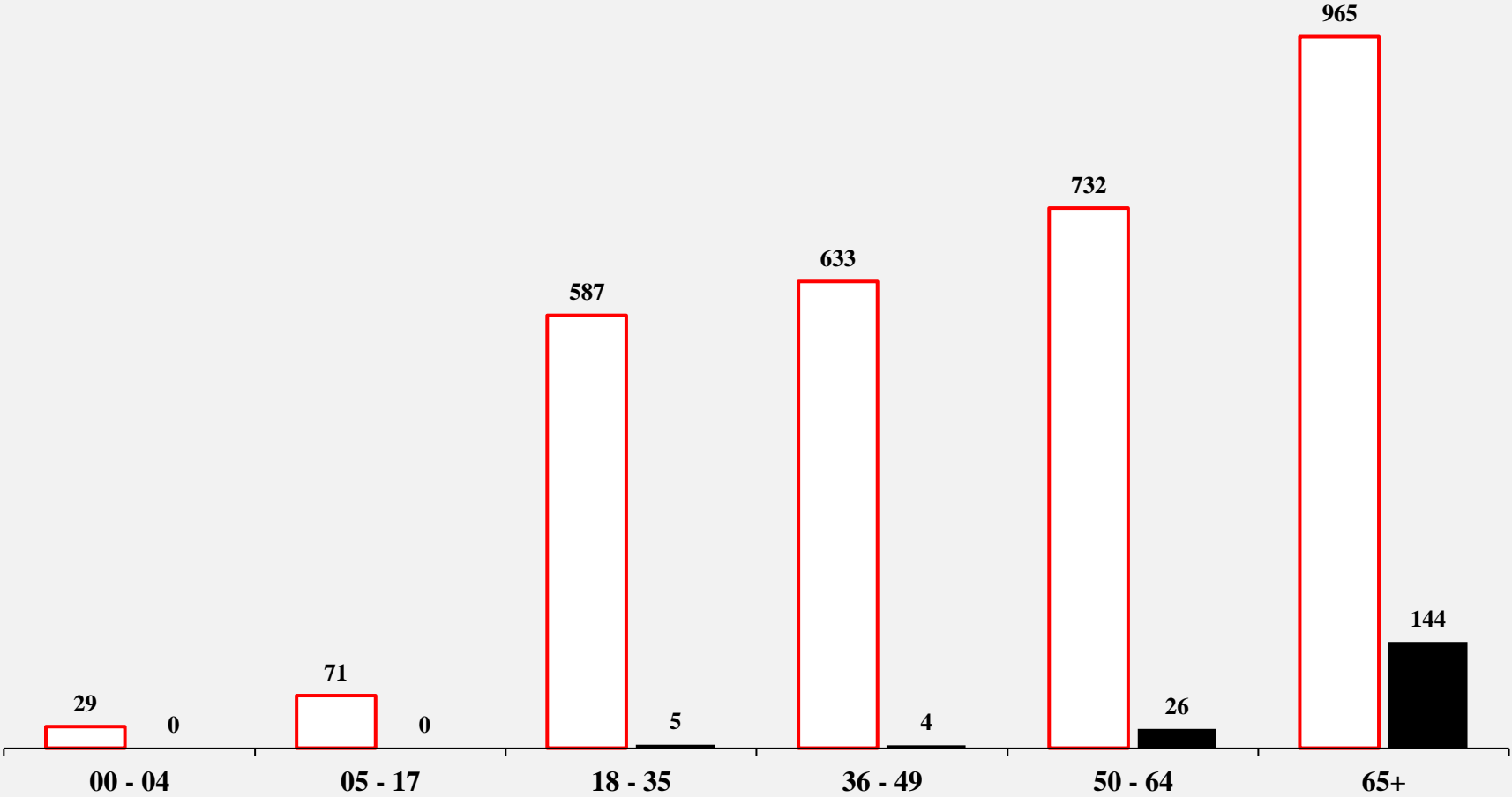

Cumulative Confirmed Cases



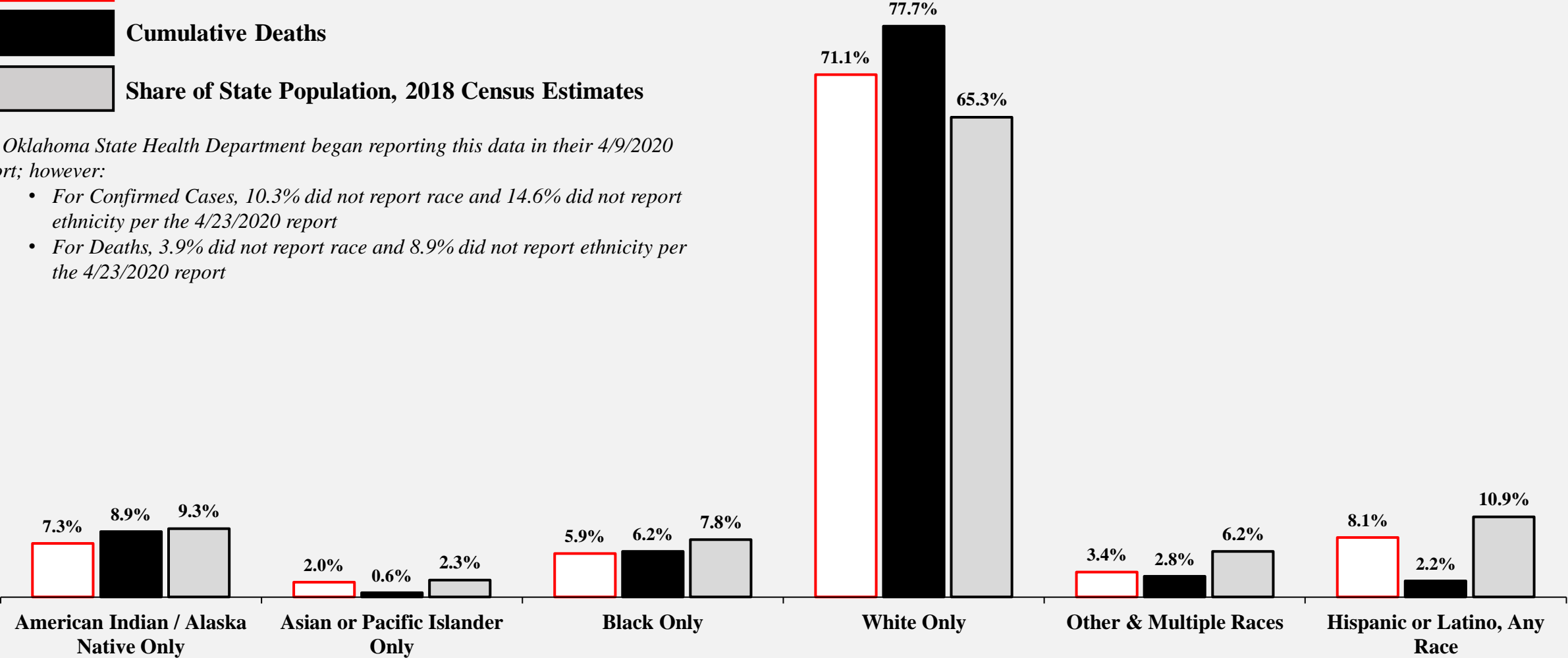
Cumulative Deaths

- For Deaths, 3.9% did not report race and 8.9% did not report ethnicity per the 4/23/2020 report



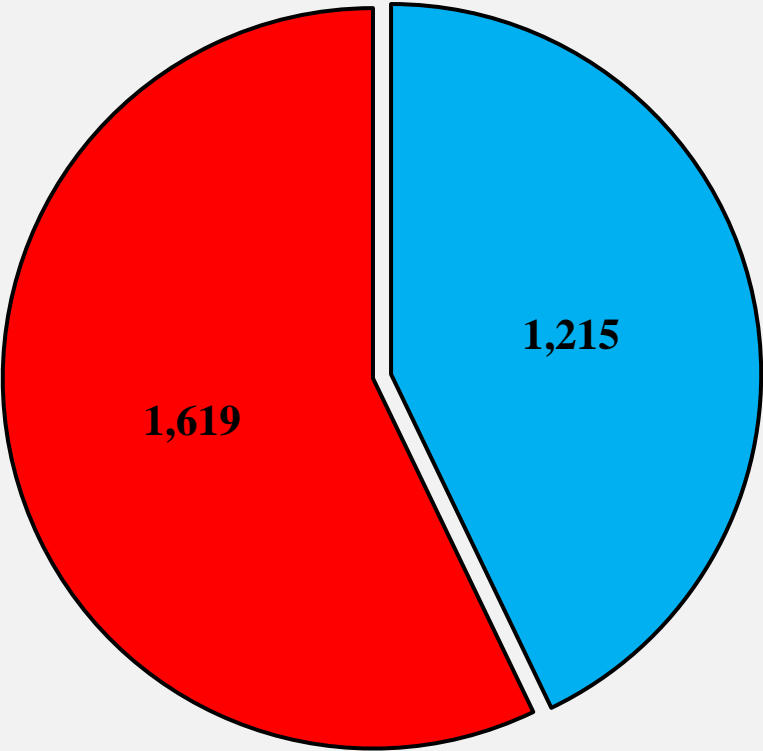
COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender

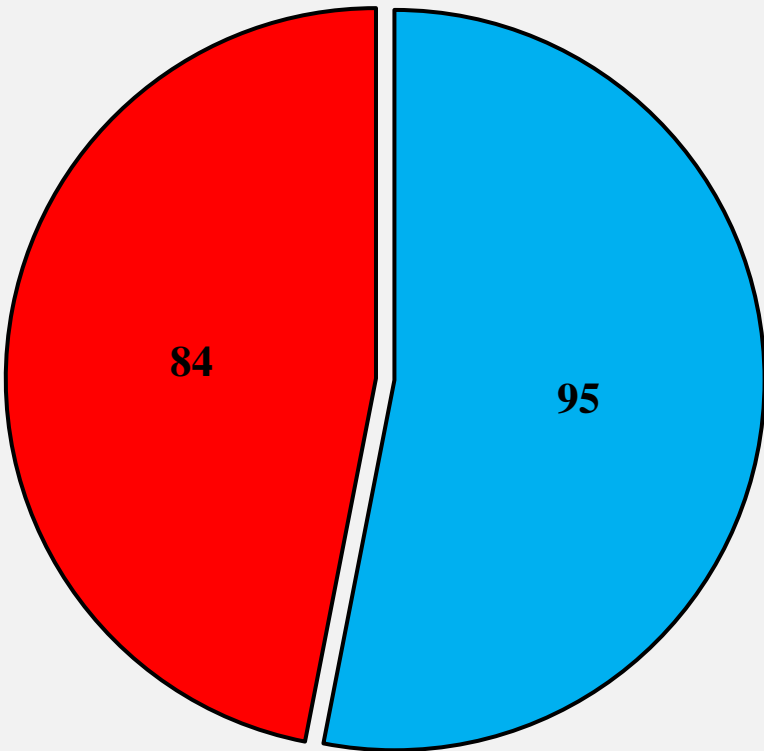

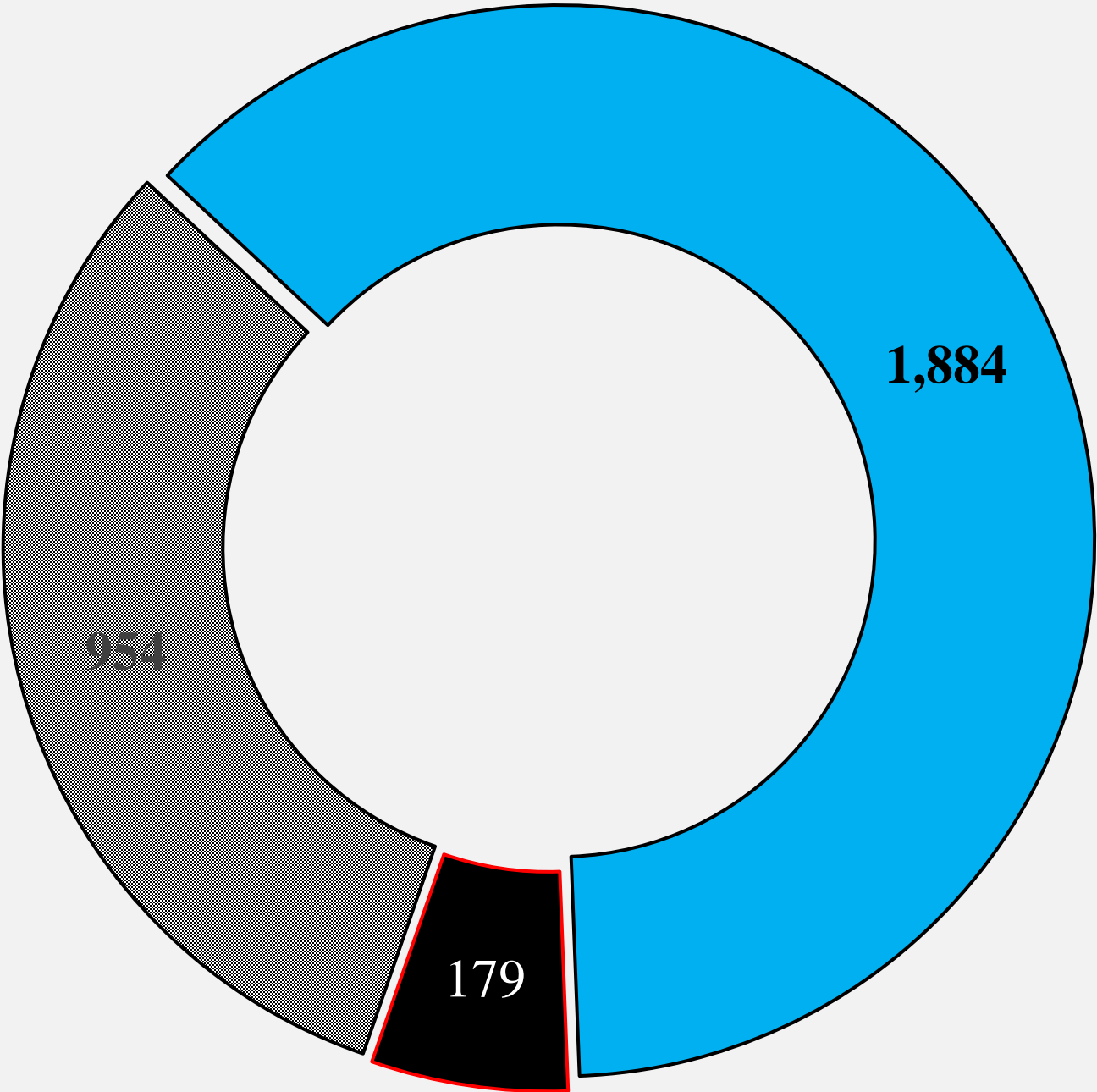

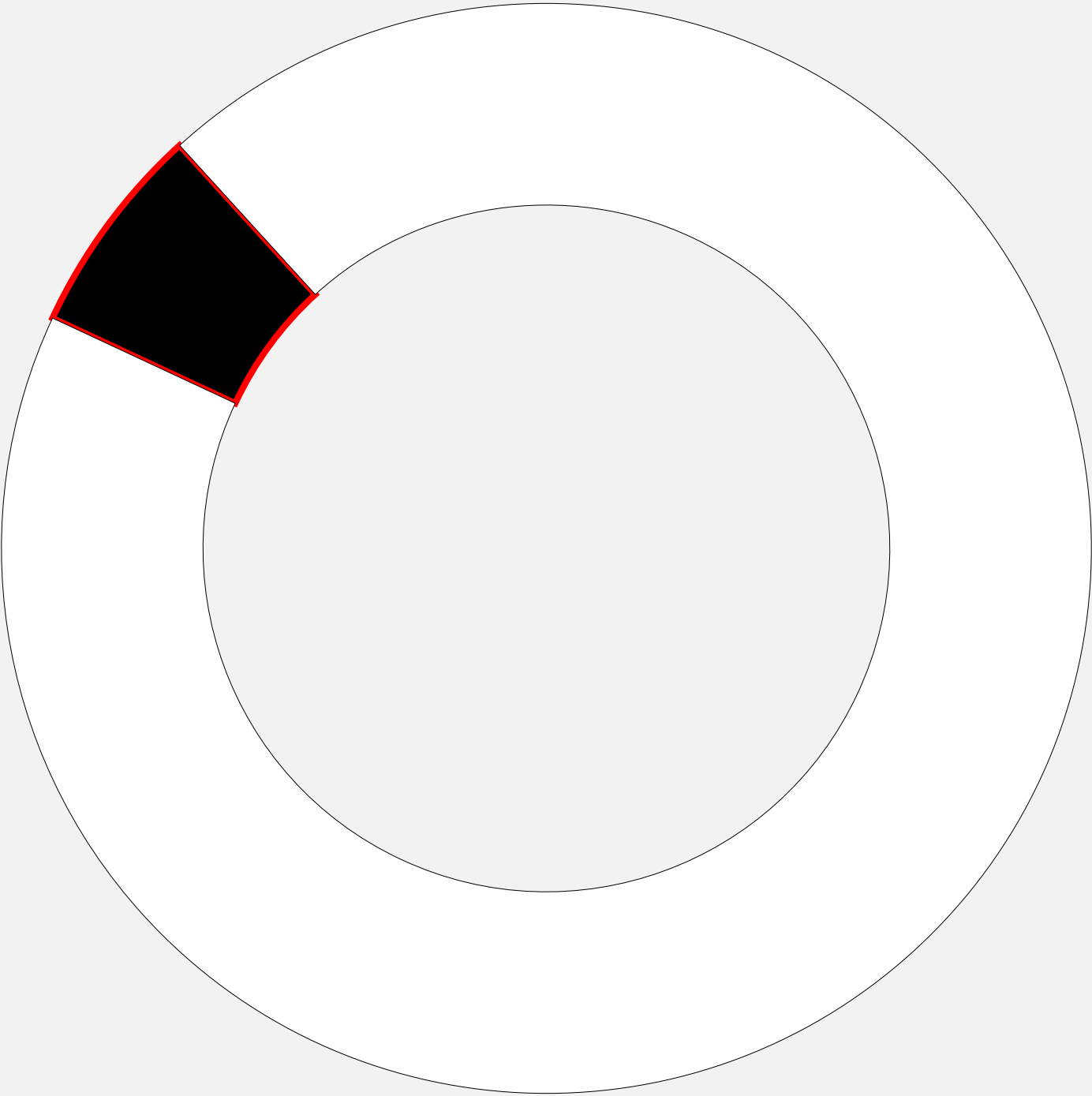

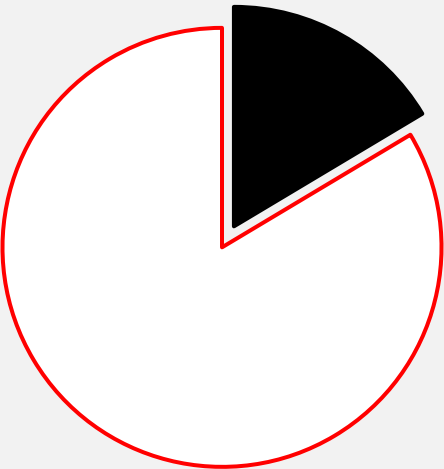

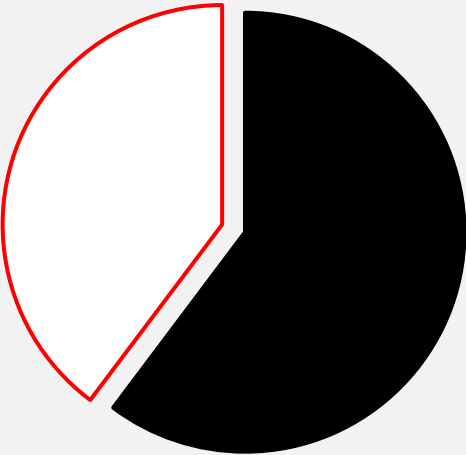
ICU Beds

Pediatric ICU Beds



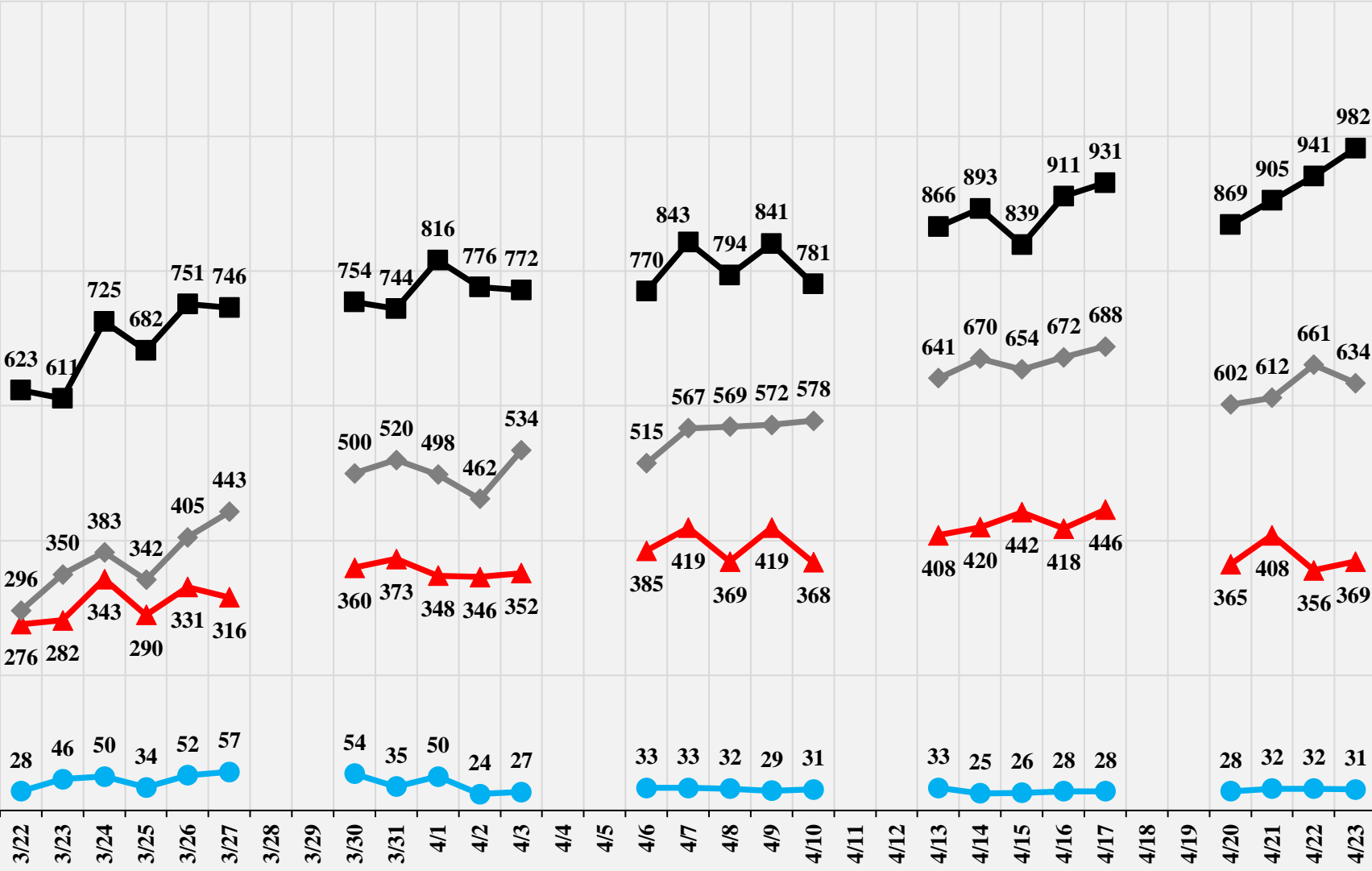

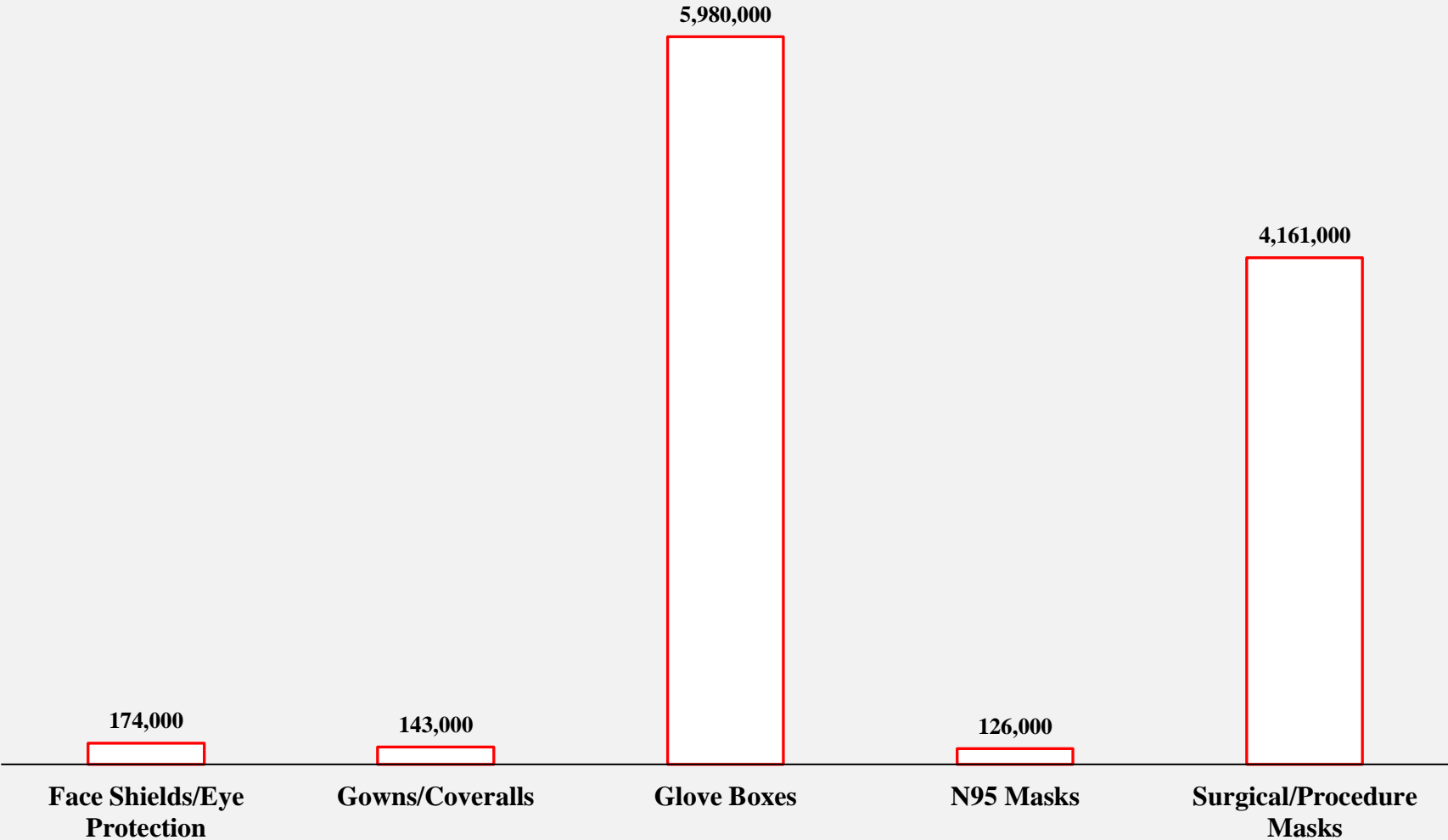

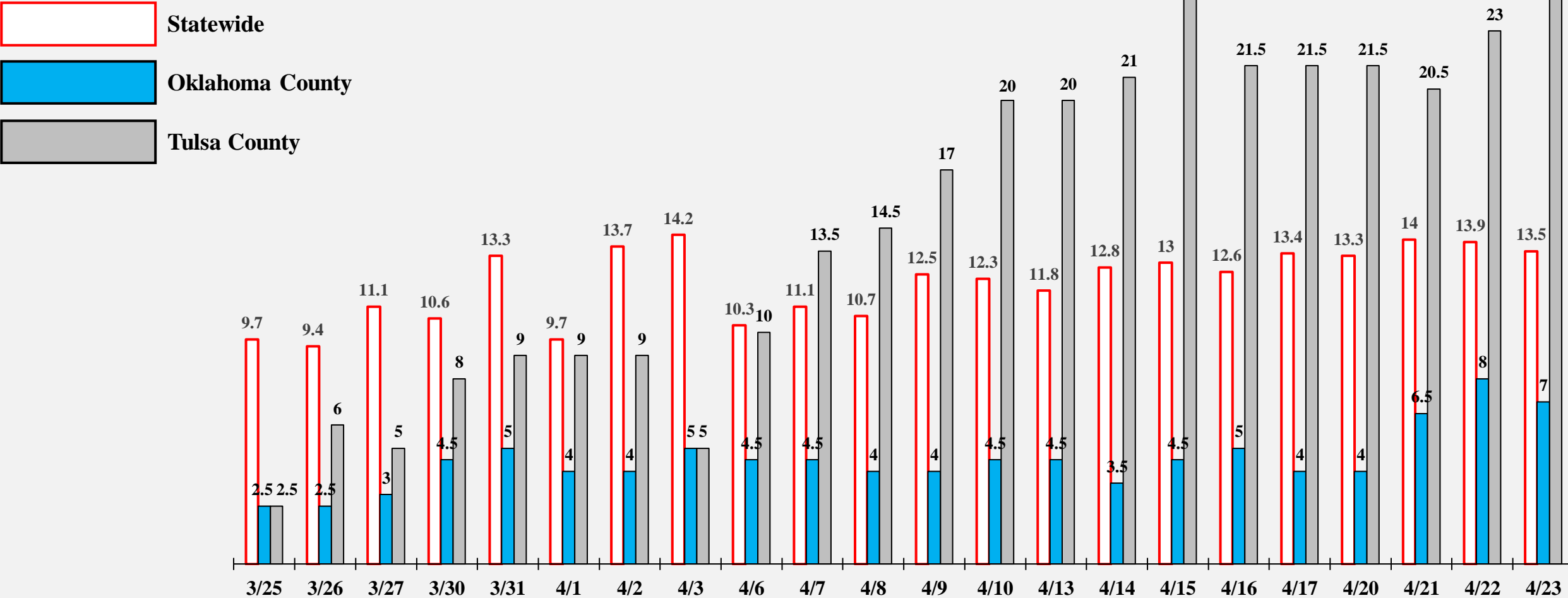

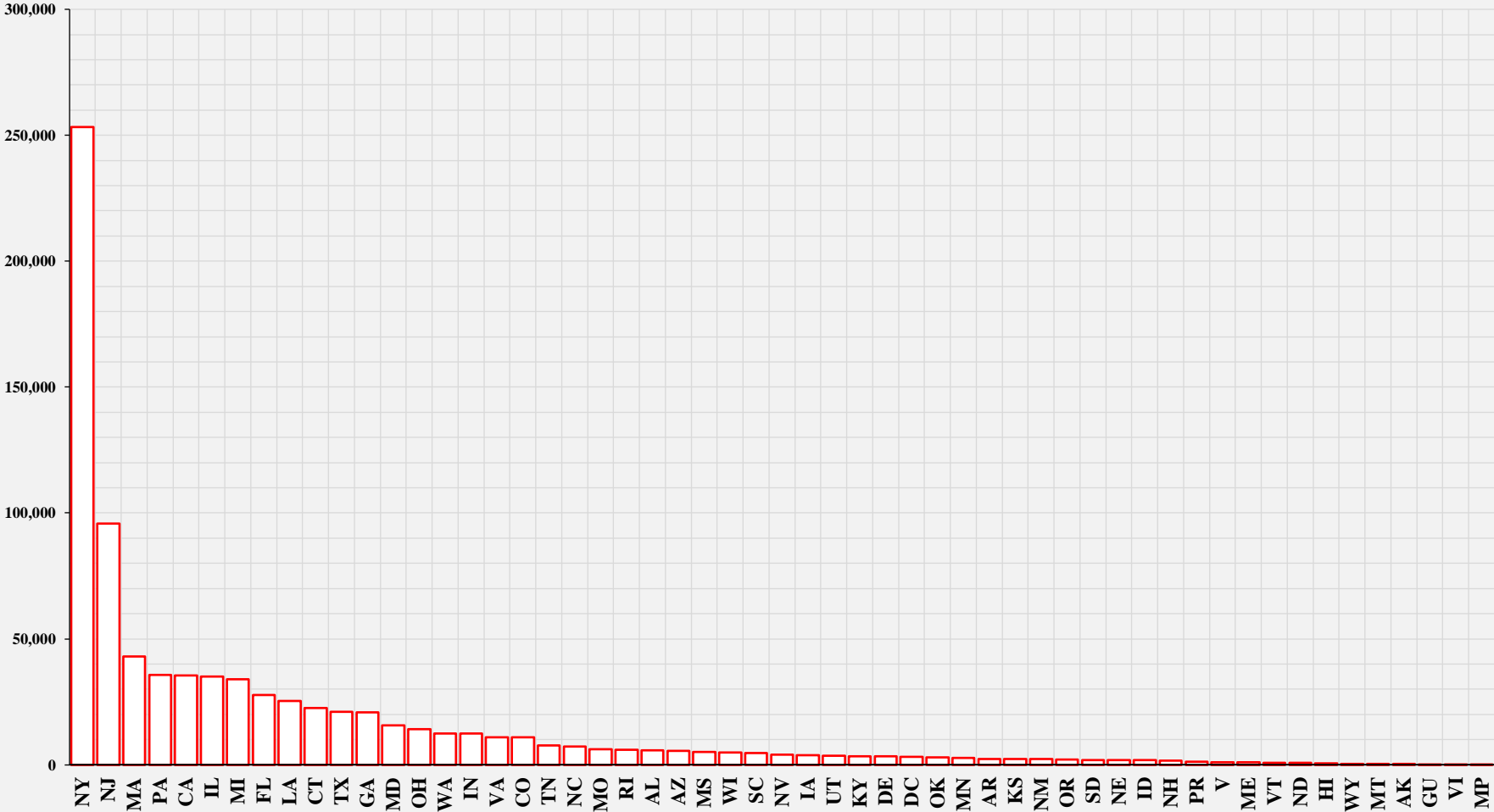

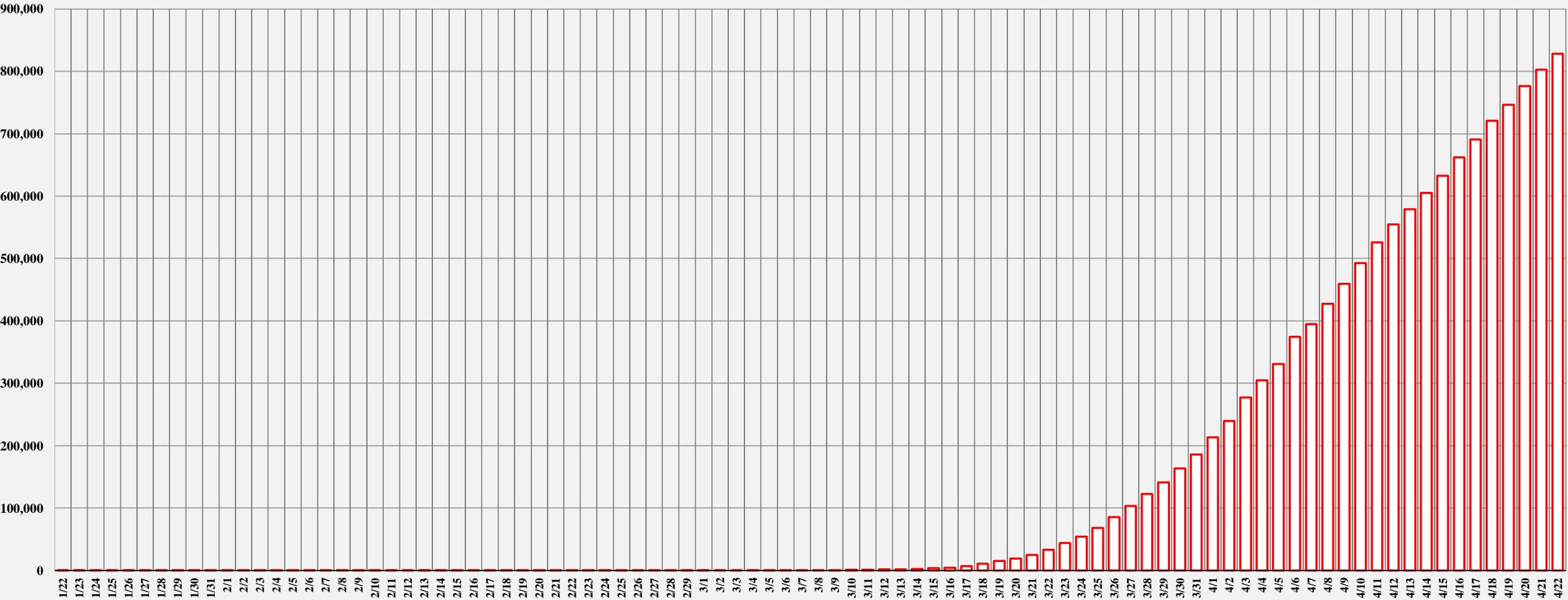


COVID-19 Confirmed U.S. Cases

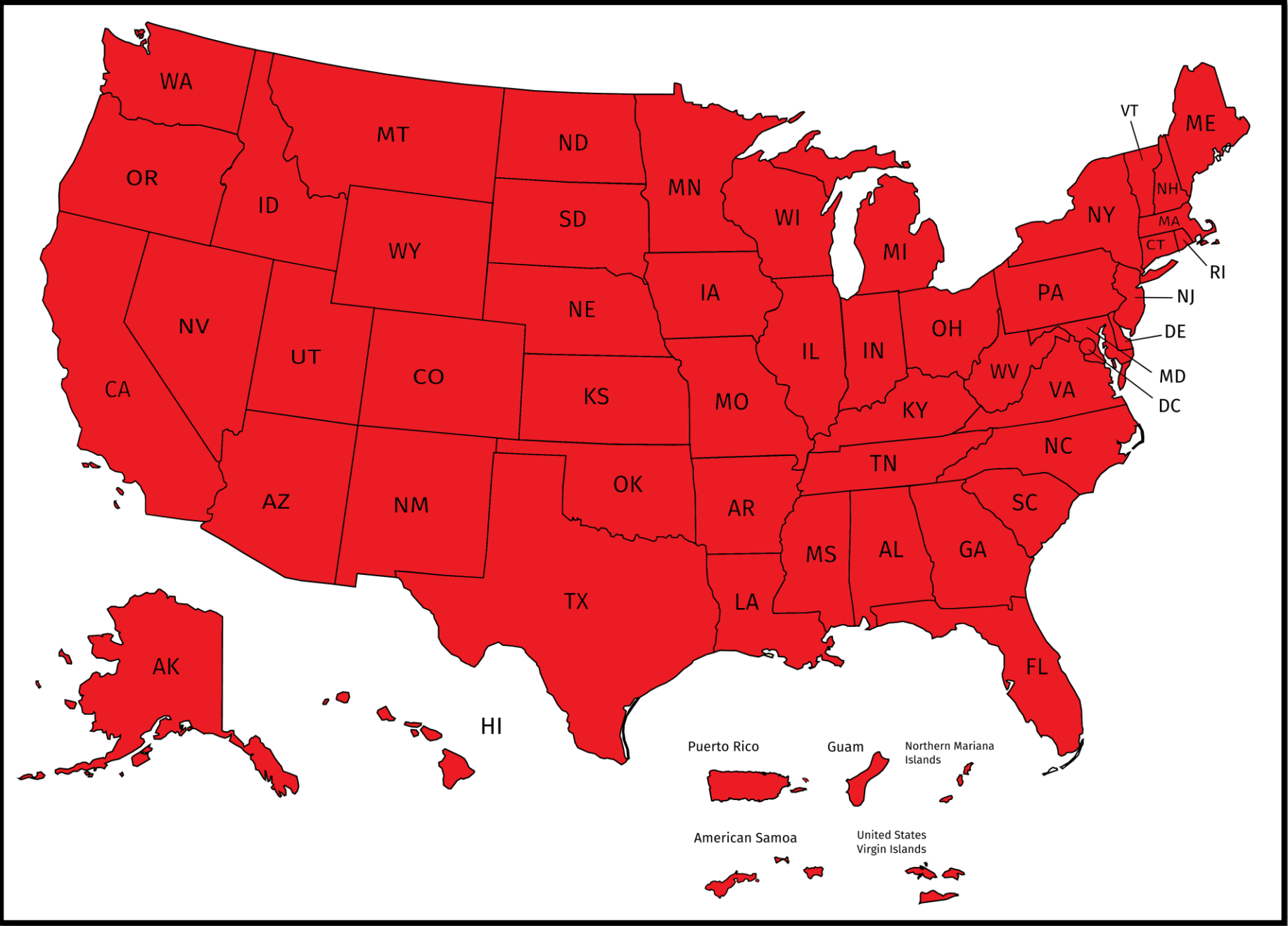
COVID-19 Major Disaster Declarations by State

 **Claims**

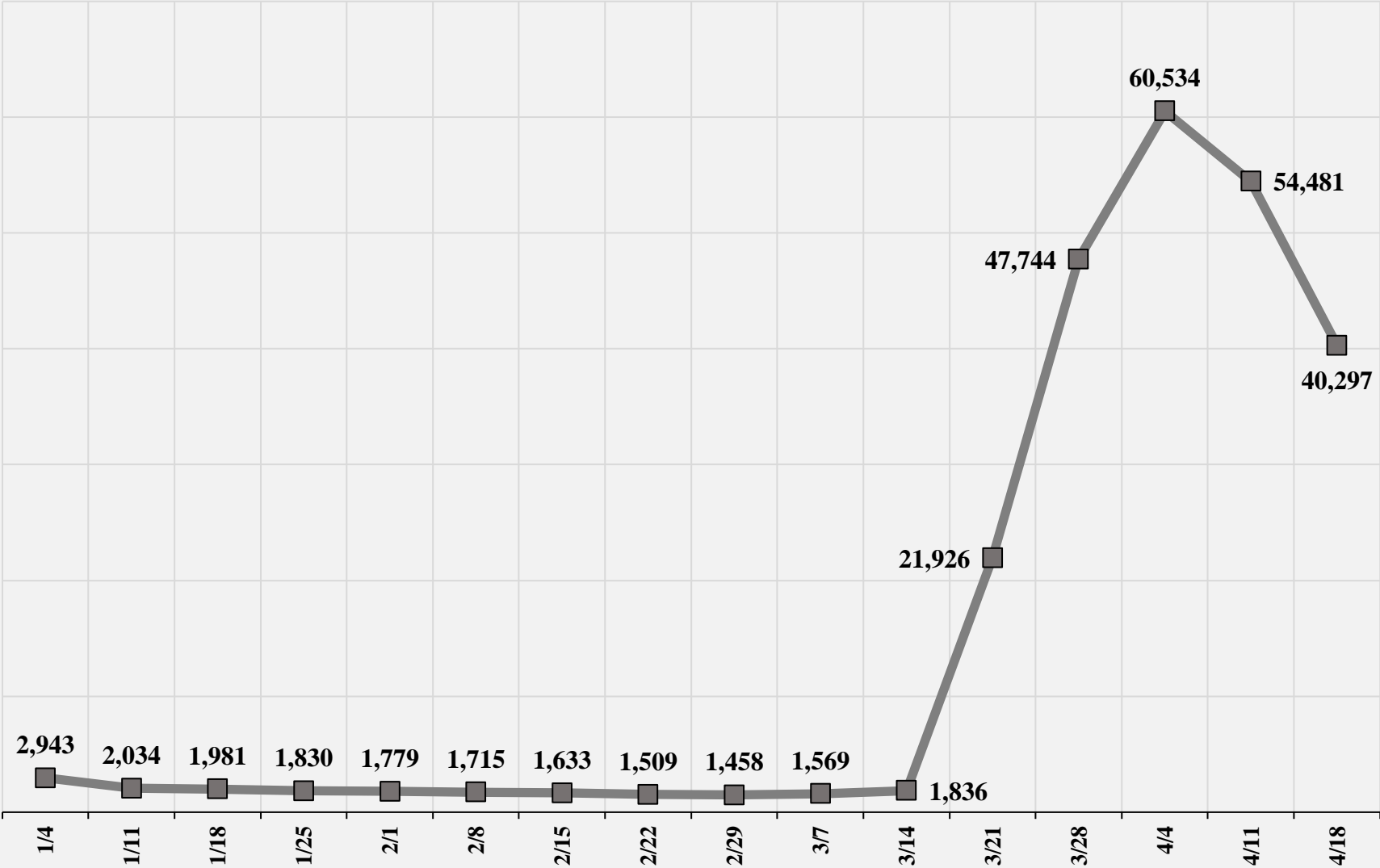
Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor. New data reported today, 4/23/2020:

- Reported 40,297 initial claims filed in Oklahoma during the week ending 4/18/2020*
- Revised upwards claims filed during the week ending 4/11/2020 by 4,604*

Each of these numbers represents the number of new unemployment claims filed in Oklahoma each week; they are not cumulative.

The weekly data is released, prior week data is subject to revision by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The data used here is not seasonally adjusted.
