










COVID-19 Oklahoma City Metro Counties Cases and Deaths Per Day











COVID-19 Statewide Case Fatality Rate (CFR) Per Day As of 5/3/2020







This chart demonstrates cases, hospitalizations, and deaths reported daily rather than cumulative based on the Oklahoma State Health Department's daily reports.














COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender

















Cumulative Confirmed Cases






COVID-19 Major Disaster Declarations by State


- With approval of the major disaster declaration for America Samoa announced by the White House on 4/18/20, for the first time in the history of the country every state and territory is under both a
 - State/territory-specific major disaster declaration due to COVID-19; and
 - A countrywide national emergency due to COVID-19 declared by the President on 3/13/20


Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor. New data reported 4/30/2020:

- *Reported 42,577 initial claims filed in Oklahoma during the week ending 4/25/2020*
- Revised upwards claims filed during the week ending 4/18/2020 by 6,399

Each of these numbers represents the number of new unemployment claims filed in Oklahoma each week; they are not cumulative.

The weekly data is released, prior week data is subject to revision by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The data used here is not seasonally adjusted.
