





COVID-19 Oklahoma City Cases and Deaths Per Day



Confirmed Cases Per Day Deaths Per Day



COVID-19 Oklahoma City Metro Counties Cases and Deaths Per Day



Confirmed Cases Per Day Deaths Per Day




COVID-19 Oklahoma City Metro Counties 14-Day Trends


COVID-19-Related Calls for Service Received by OCPD








COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Deaths





COVID-19 Statewide Case Fatality Rate (CFR) Per Day




COVID-19 Statewide Total Confirmed Cases and Hospitalizations

Cumulative Hospitalizations




COVID-19 Statewide Cases, Hospitalizations, and Deaths Per Day







- For Deaths, 4.5% did not report race and 10.2% did not report ethnicity per the 5/8/2020 report




COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender



Cumulative Confirmed Cases




Cumulative Deaths












Pediatric ICU Beds












COVID-19 Major Disaster Declarations by State

 - *State/territory-specific major disaster declaration due to COVID-19; and*
 - *A countrywide national emergency due to COVID-19 declared by the President on 3/13/20*

■ Claims

Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor. New data reported 5/7/2020:

- Reported 68,237 initial claims filed in Oklahoma during the week ending 5/2/2020
- Revised upwards claims filed during the week ending 4/18/2020 by 9,923
- Oklahoma was one of only six states where unemployment claims increased during the week ending 5/7/2020

Each of these numbers represents the number of new unemployment claims filed in Oklahoma each week; they are **not** cumulative.

The weekly data is released, prior week data is subject to revision by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The data used here is not seasonally adjusted.
