




#### **COVID-19 Oklahoma City Cases and Deaths Per Day**










#### **COVID-19** Active Cases, Deaths, and Recoveries by Oklahoma City Metro City, Town
















## **COVID-19** Cases and Deaths by Race and Ethnicity









## **COVID-19** Cases and Deaths by Gender




## **COVID-19 Case Status Statewide**













1/22/2020 through 5/10/2020, as of 5/11/2020 Source: CDC




**Cumulative Confirmed Cases**

Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor. New data reported 5/7/2020:


- *Reported 68,237 initial claims filed in Oklahoma during the week ending 5/2/2020*
- *Revised upwards claims filed during the week ending 4/18/2020 by 9,923*
- Oklahoma was one of only six states where unemployment claims increased during the week ending 5/7/2020

Each of these numbers represents the number of new unemployment claims filed in Oklahoma each week; they are **not** cumulative.

The weekly data is released, prior week data is subject to revision by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The data used here is not seasonally adjusted.
