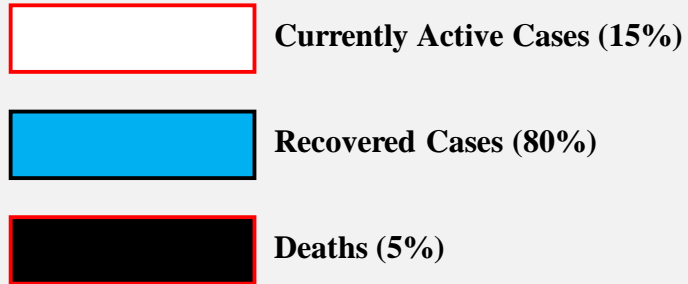
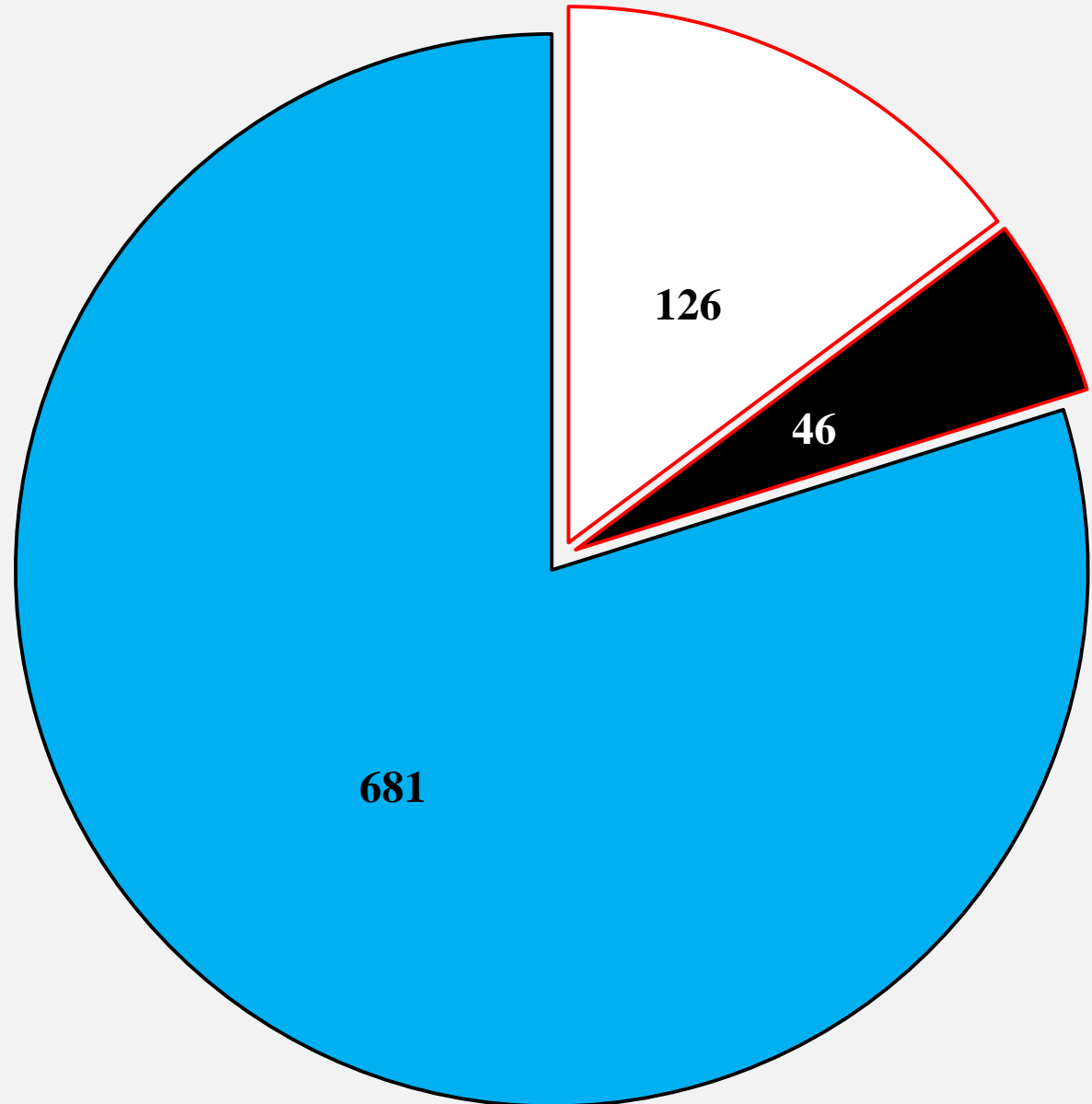

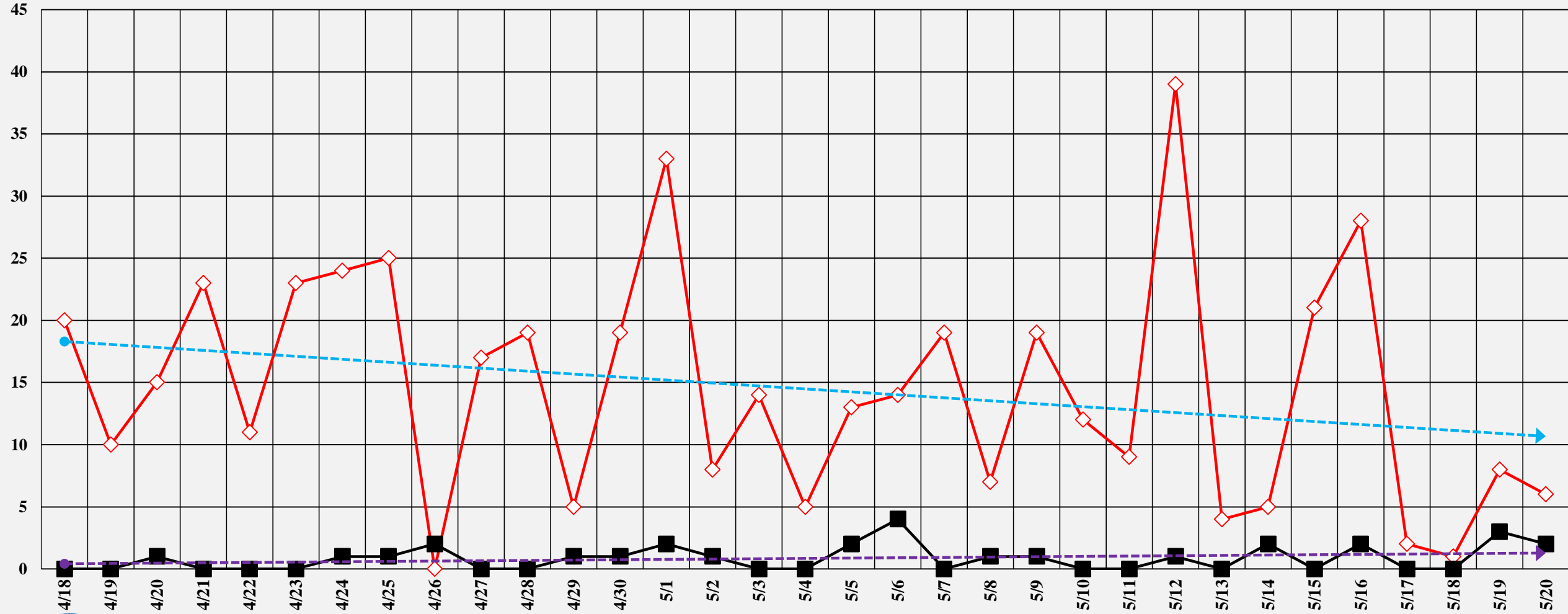

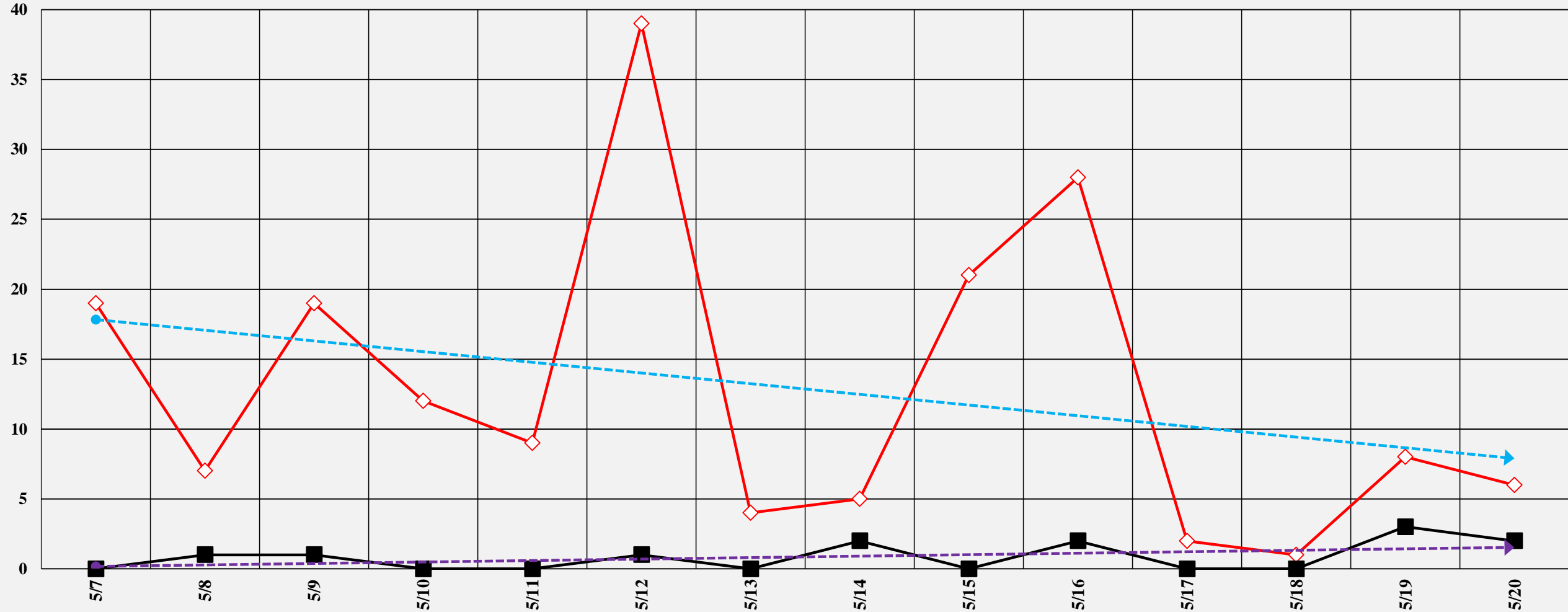

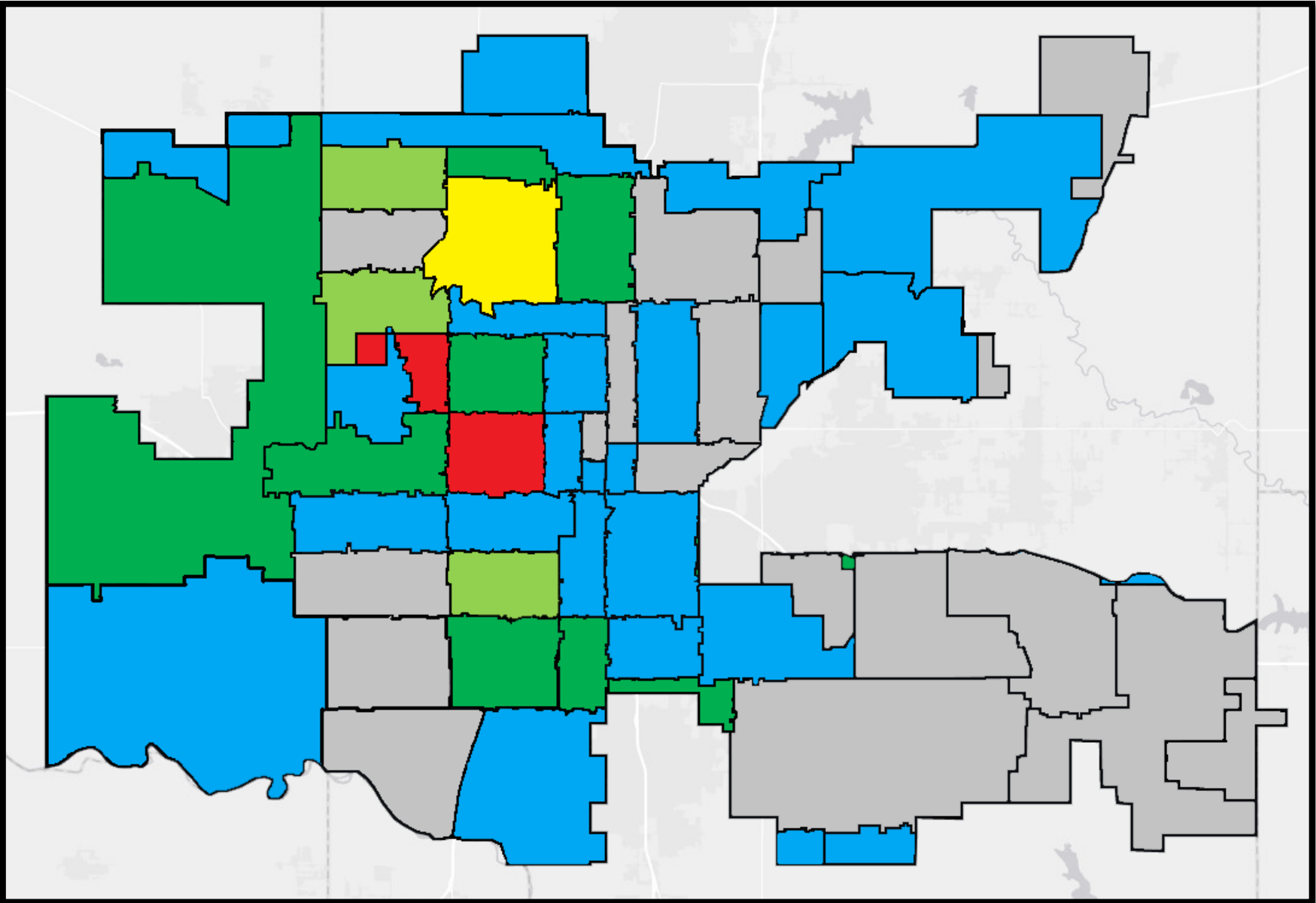
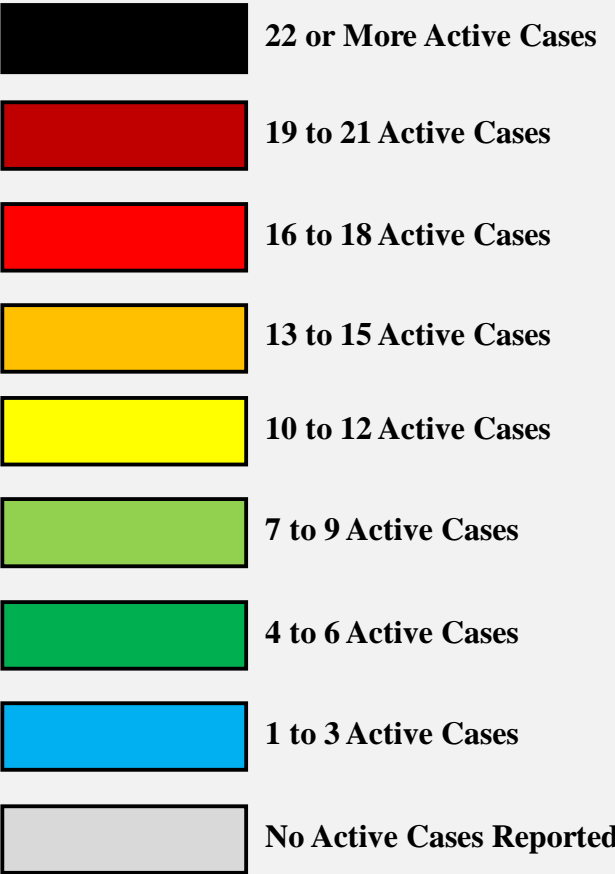

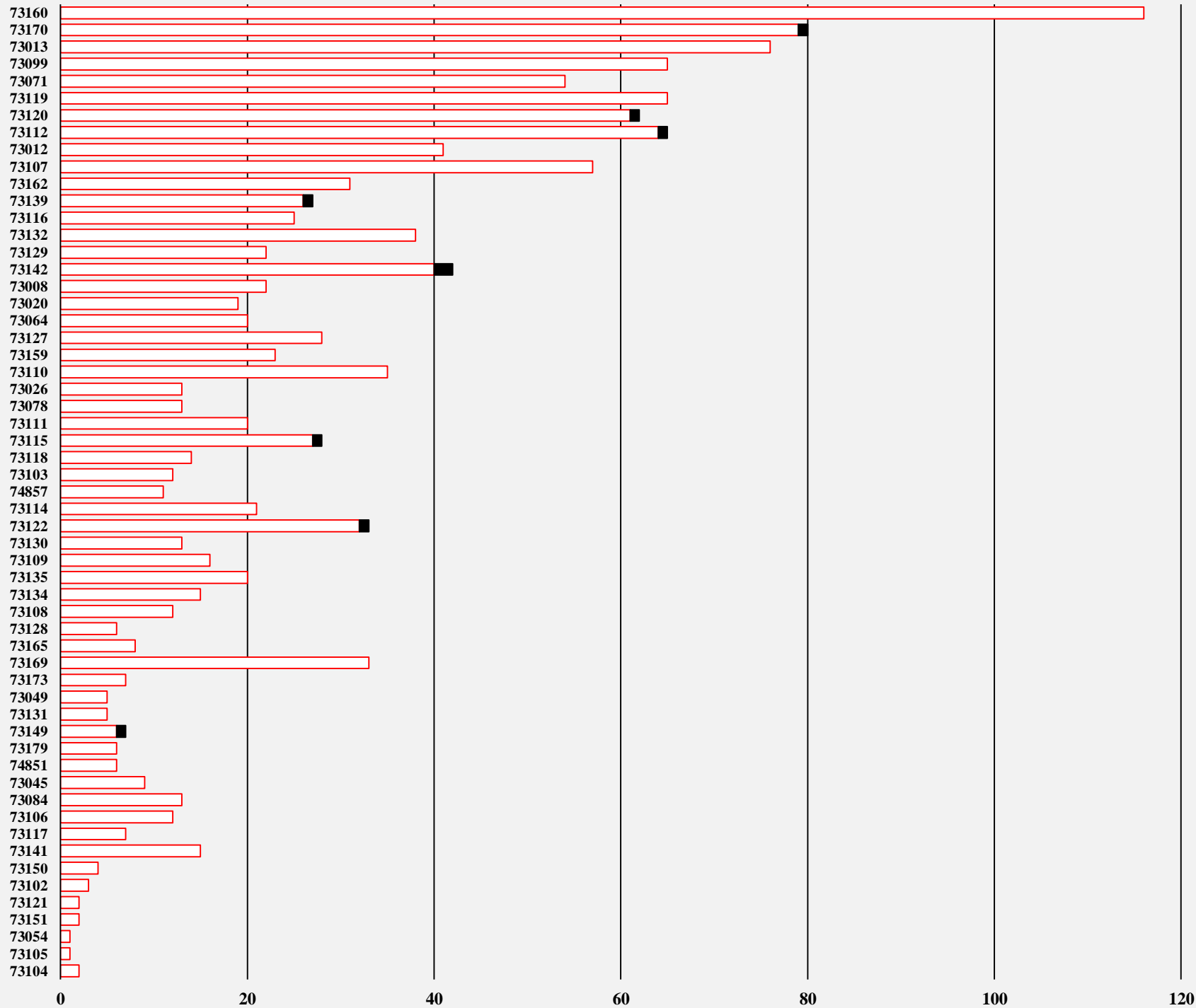

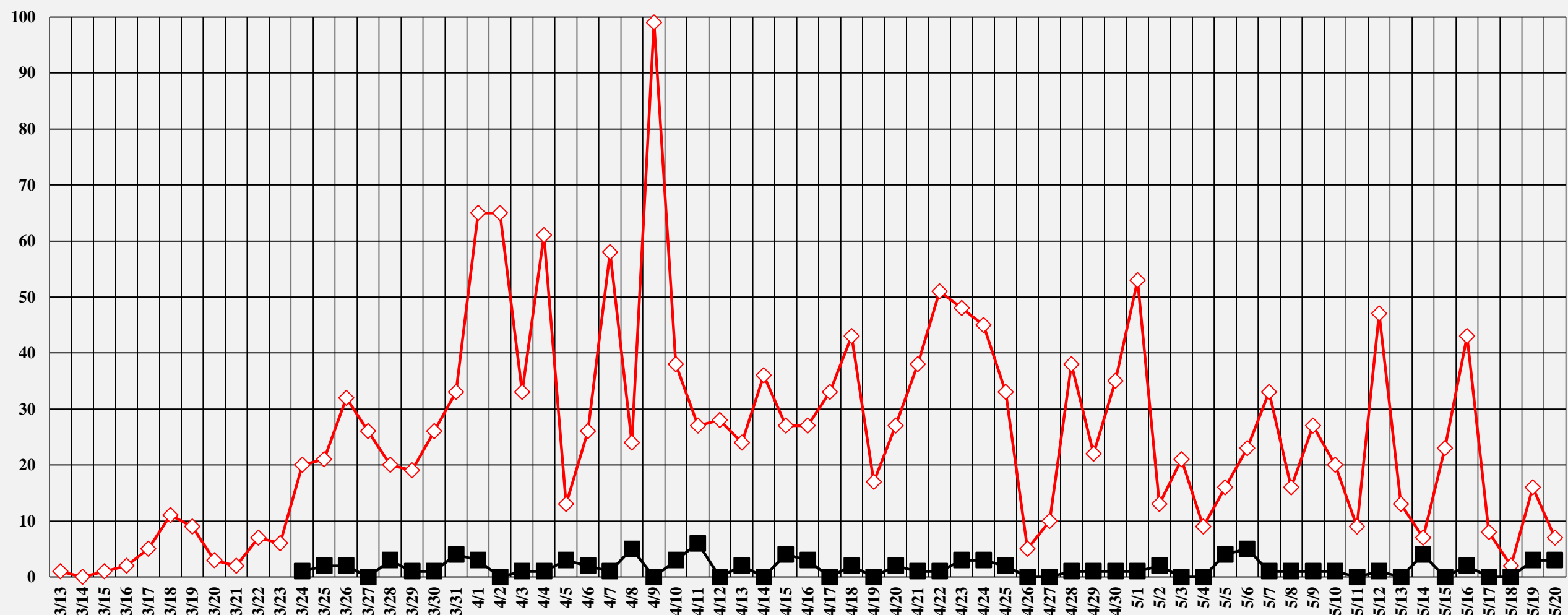

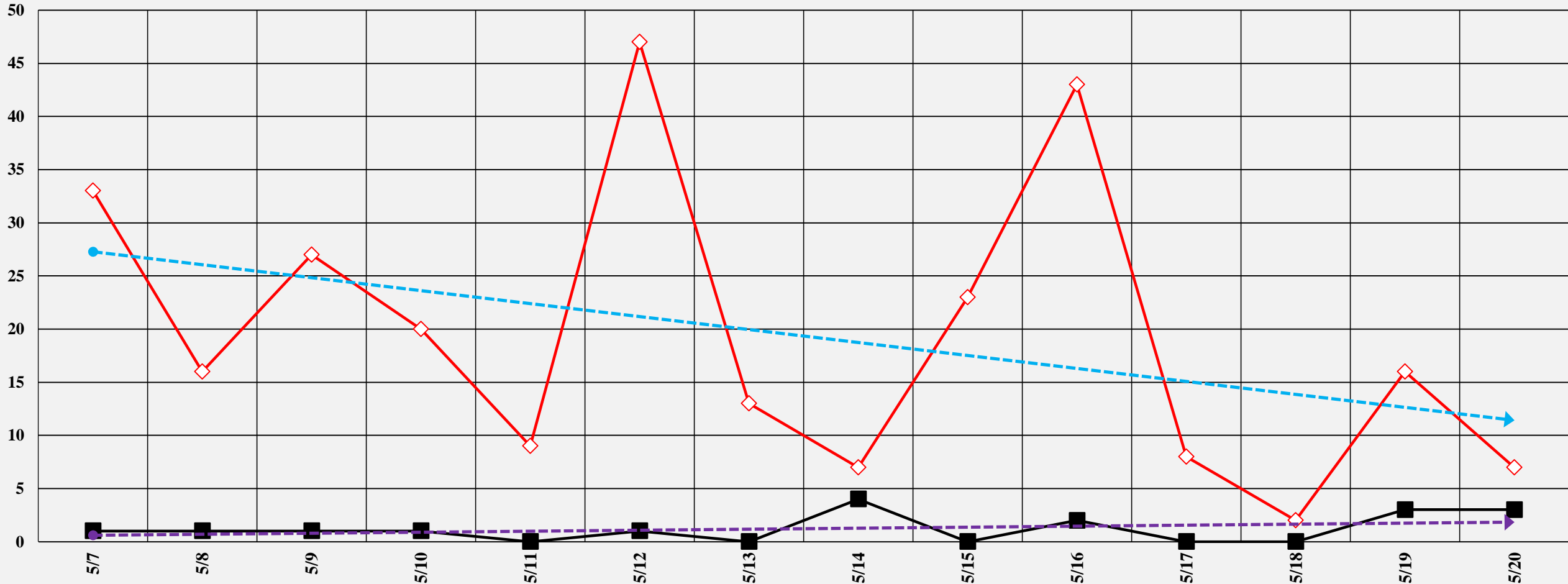

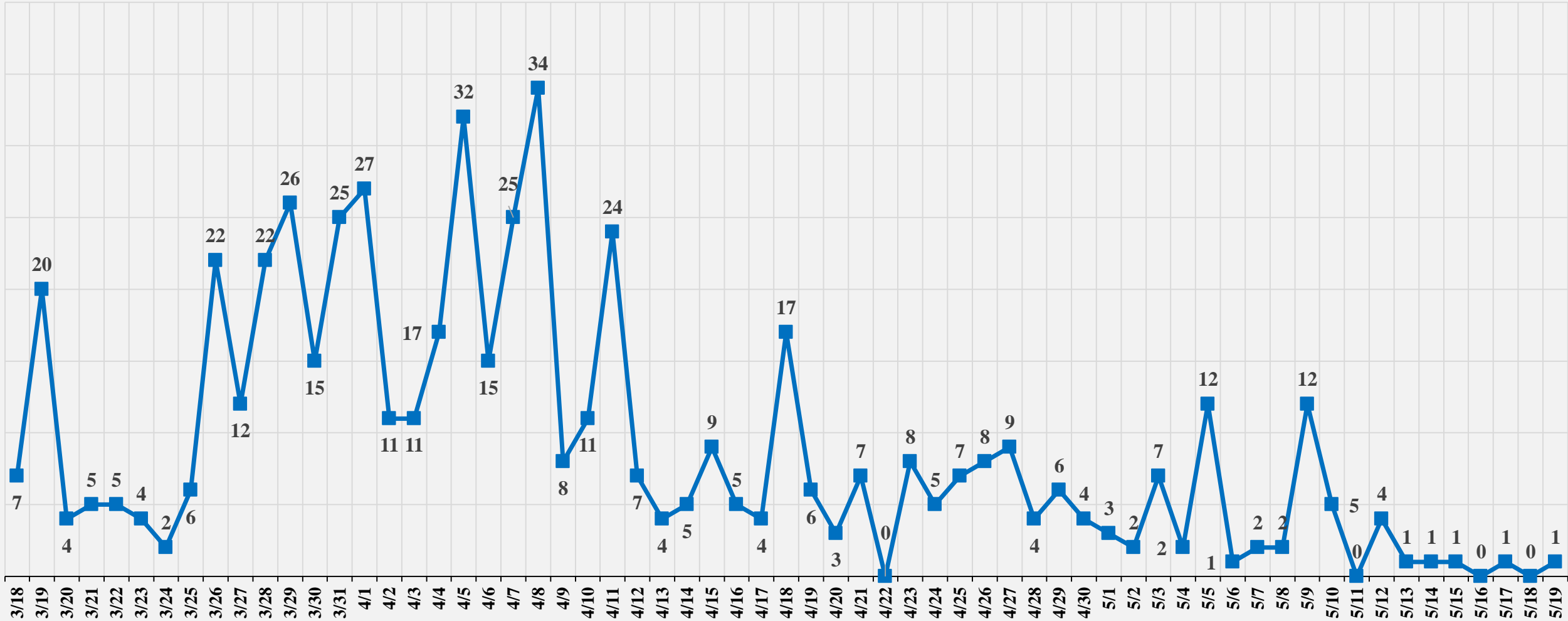
# COVID-19-Related Calls for Service Received by OCPD

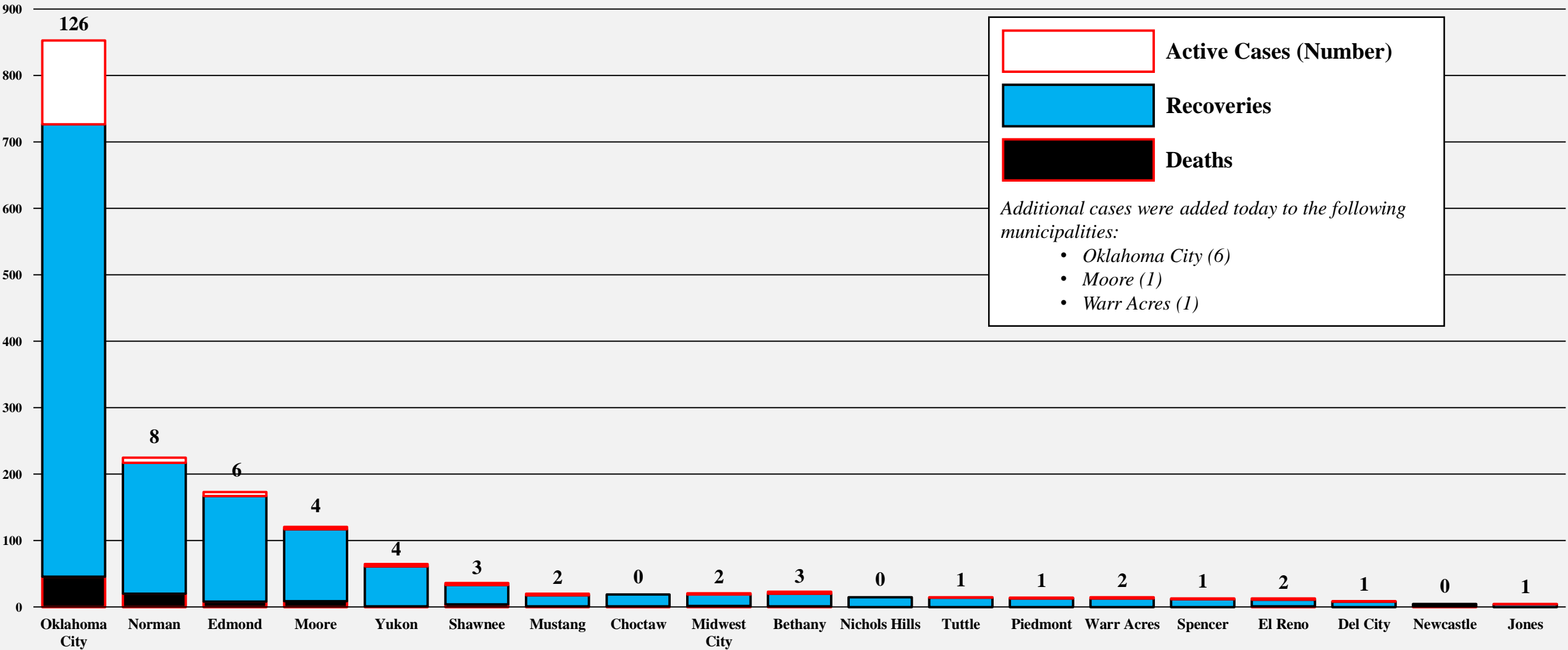

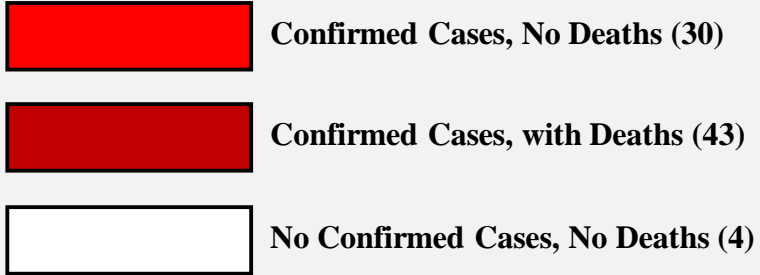

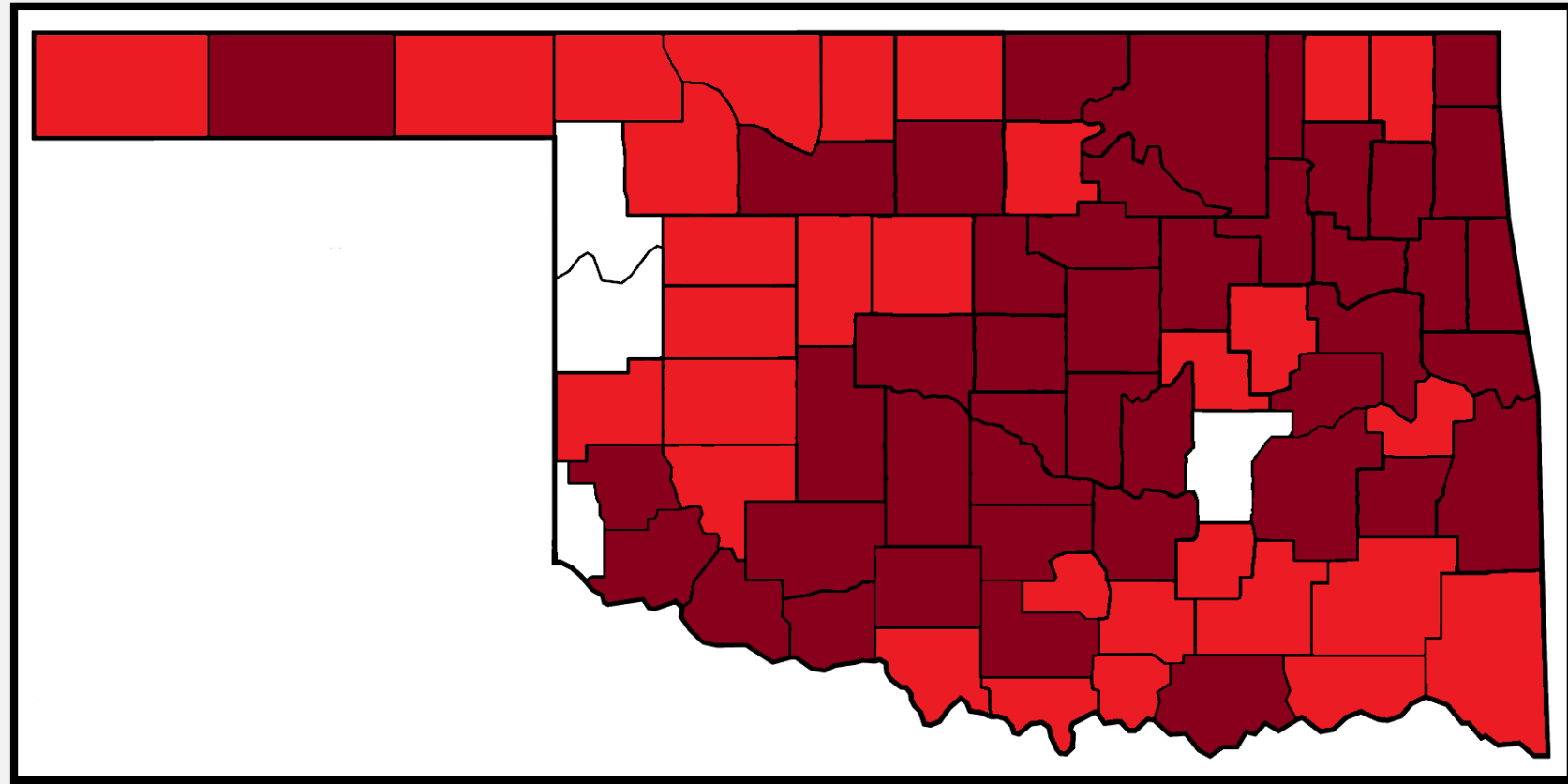

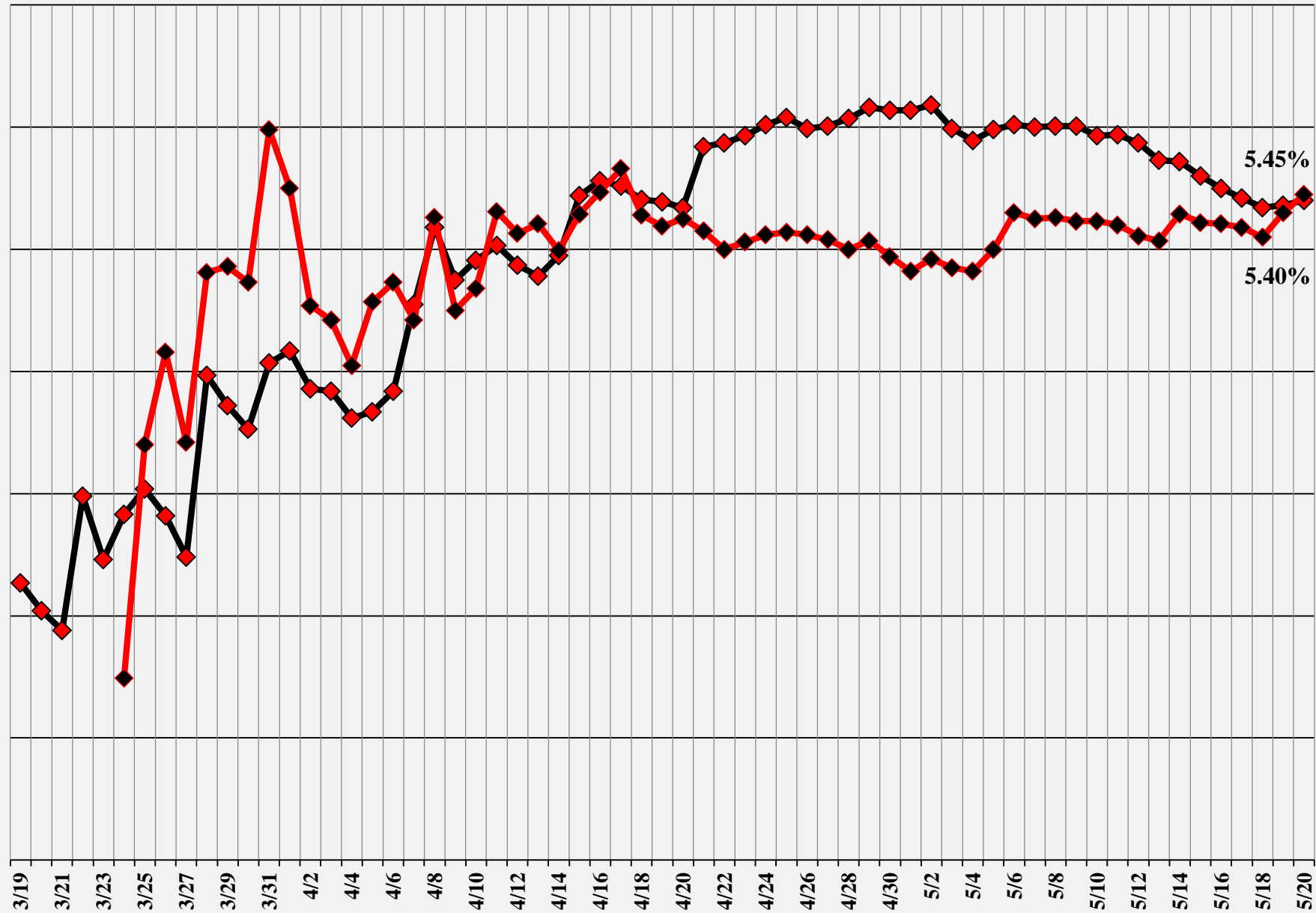

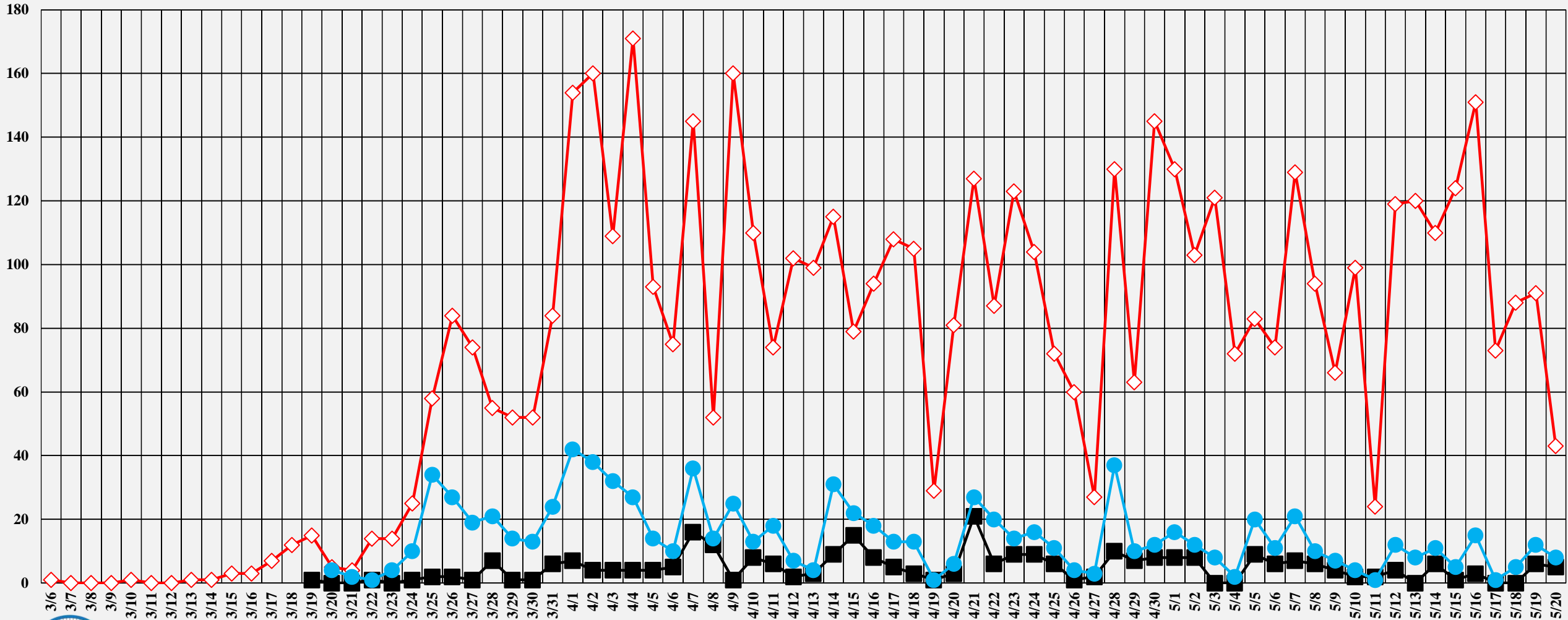

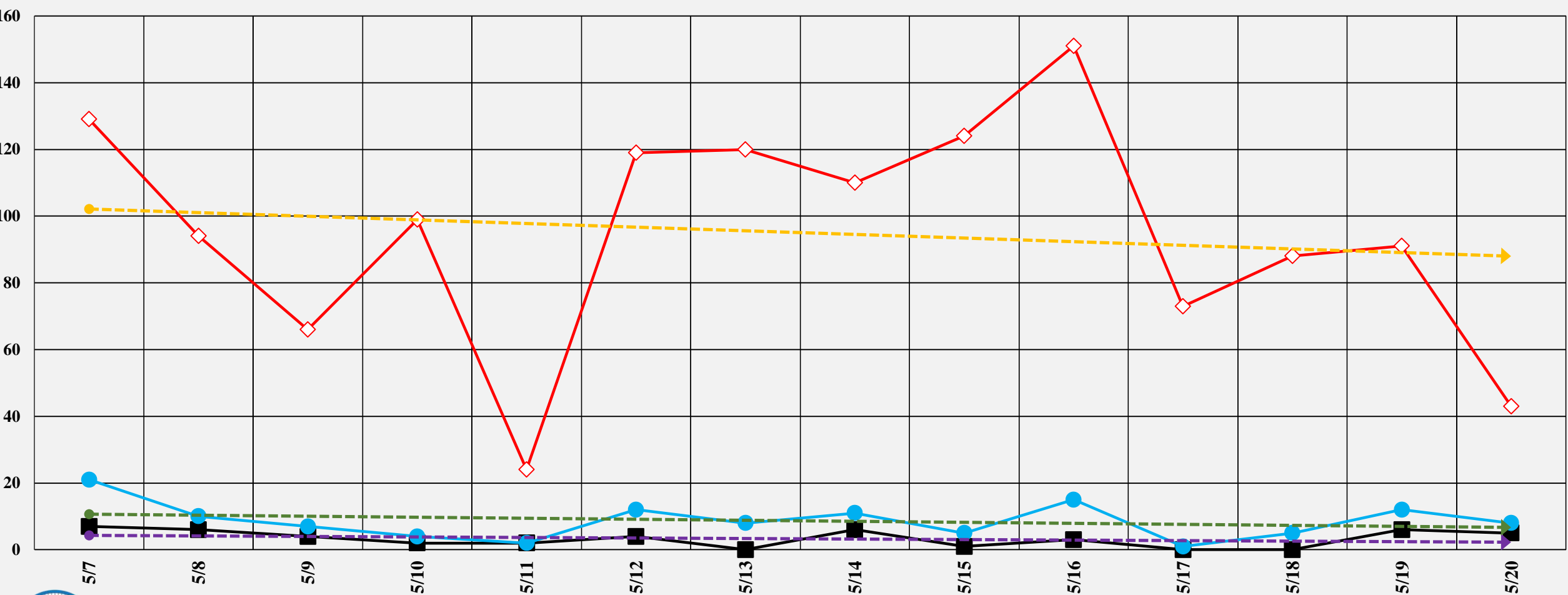

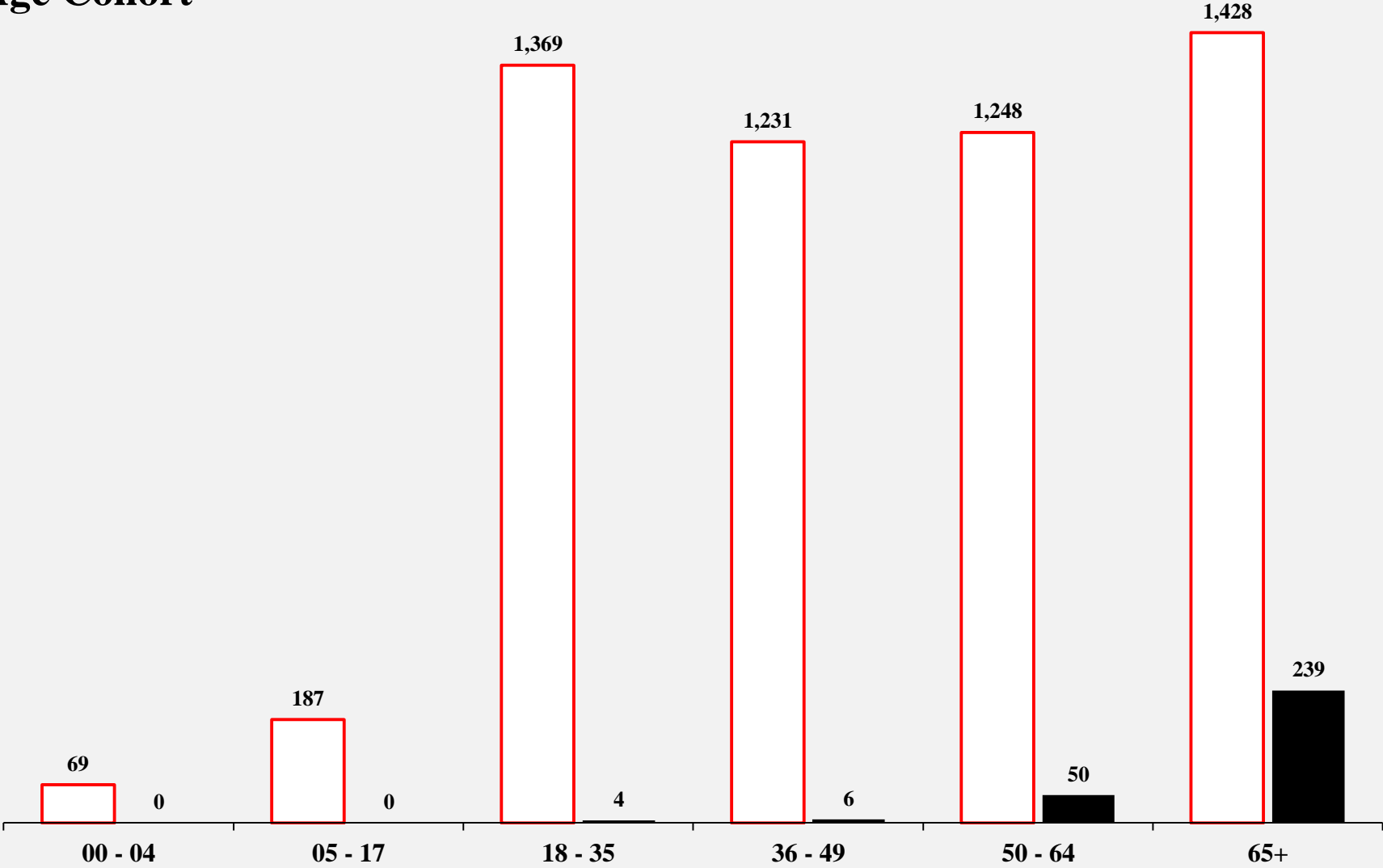

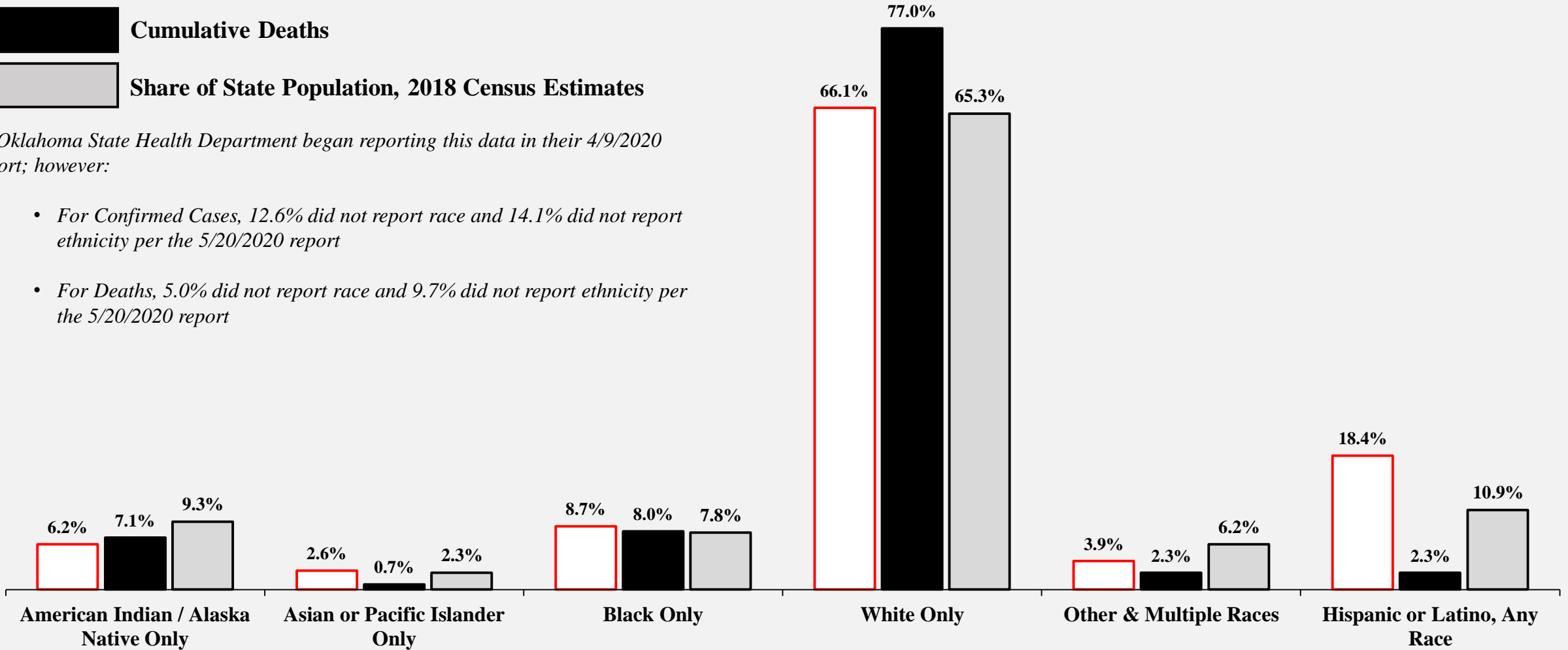
Cumulative Deaths

- For Deaths, 5.0% did not report race and 9.7% did not report ethnicity per the 5/20/2020 report



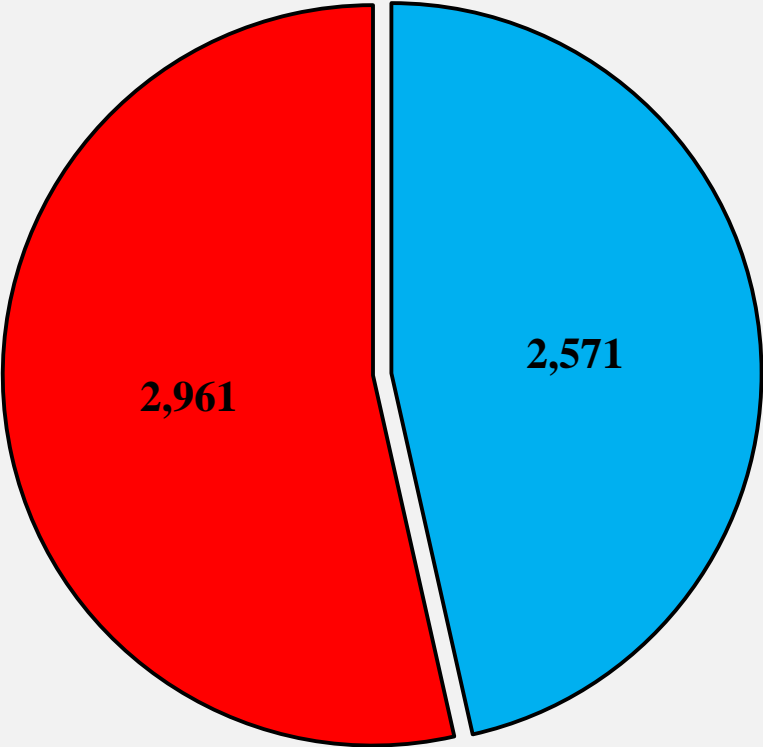
# COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender

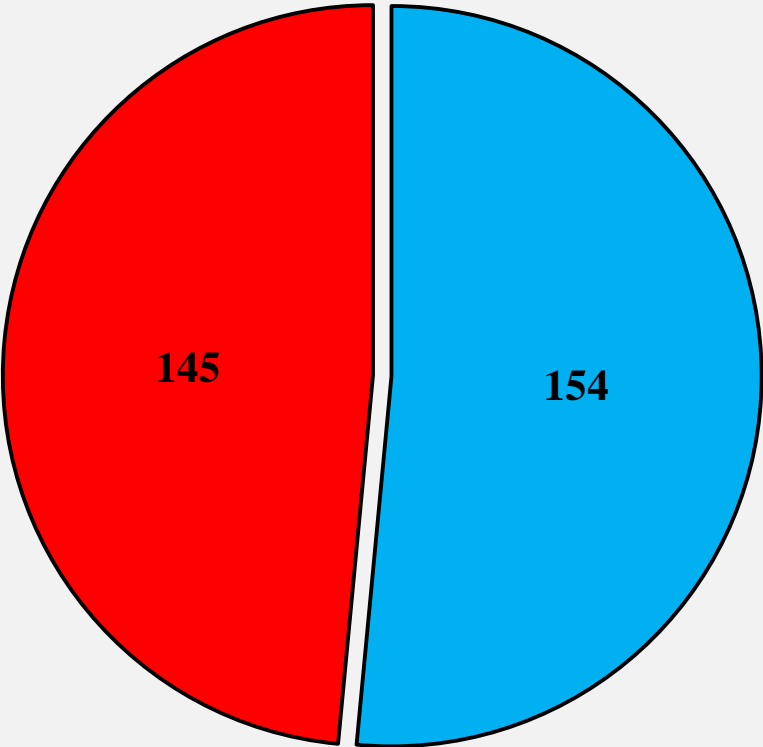

### Cumulative Deaths



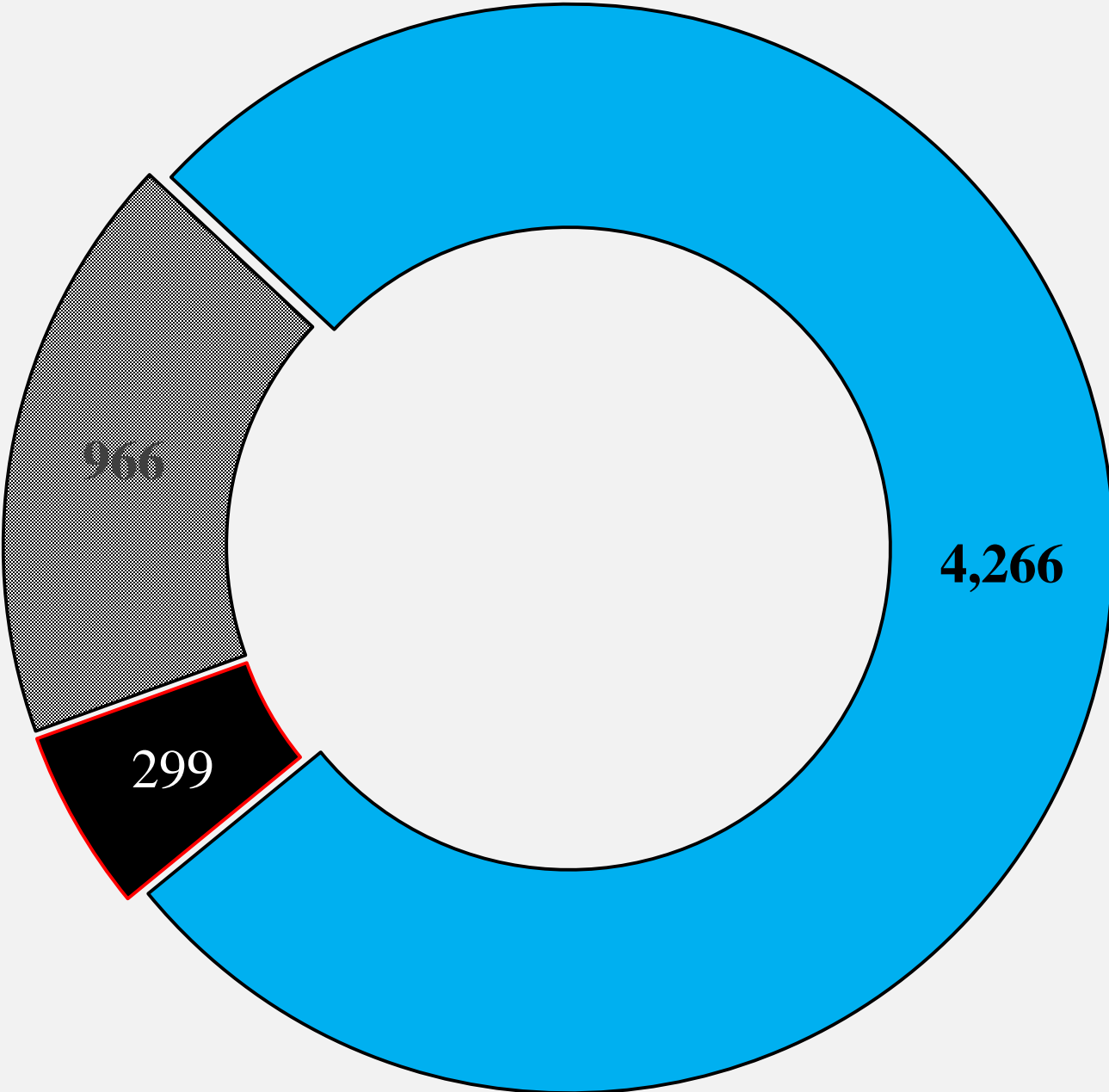

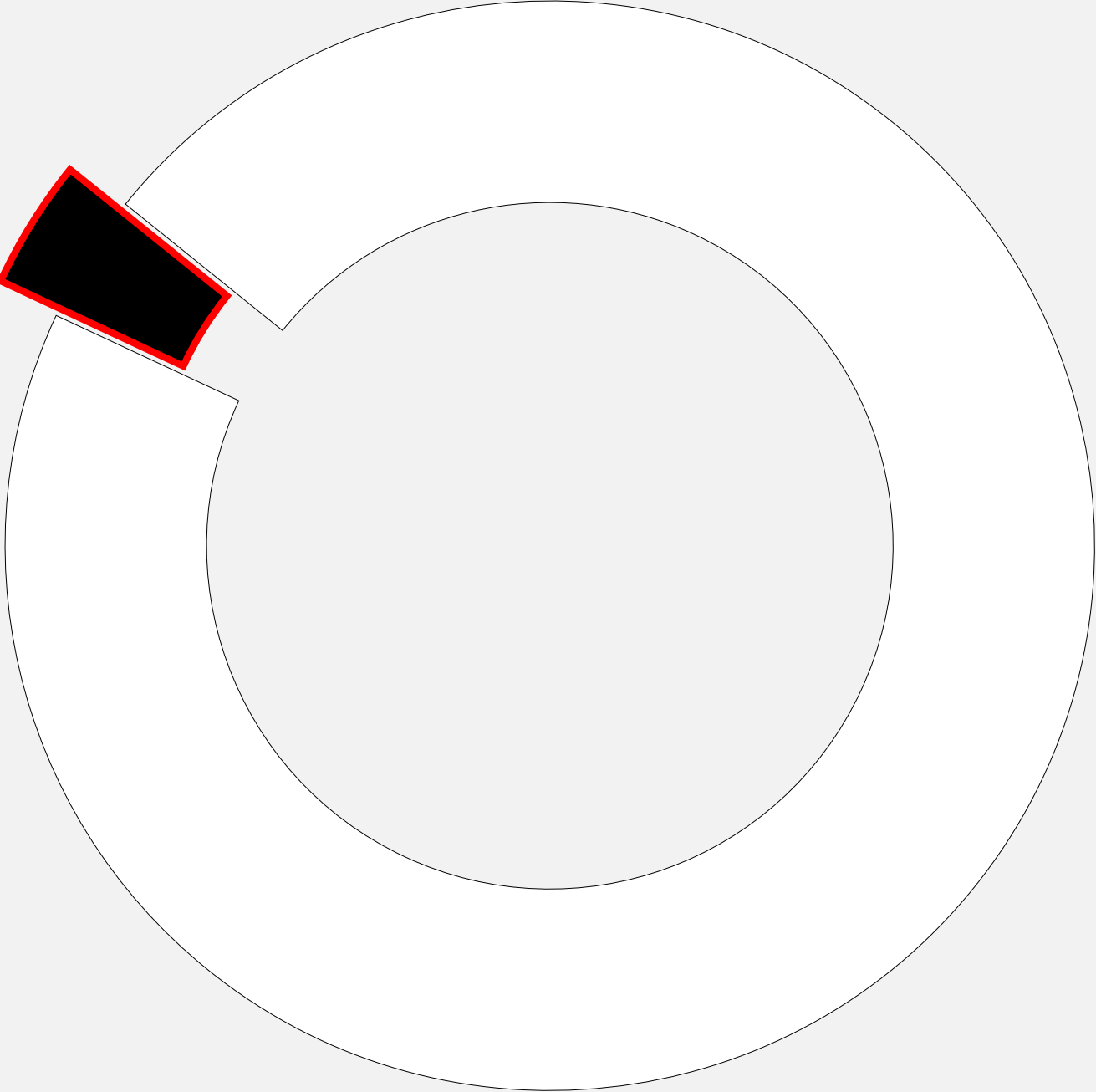

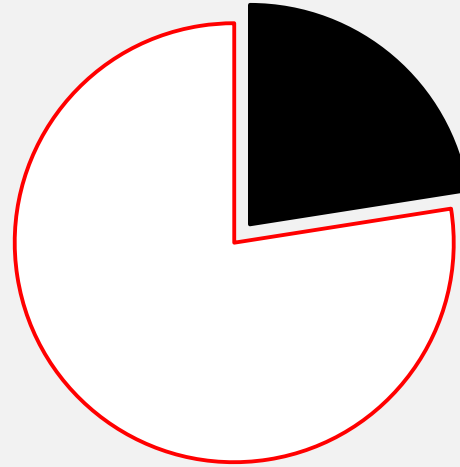

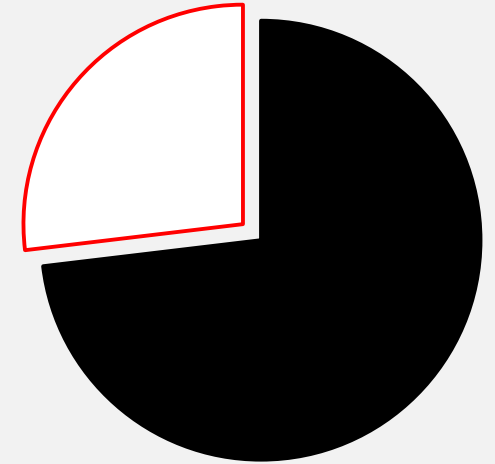

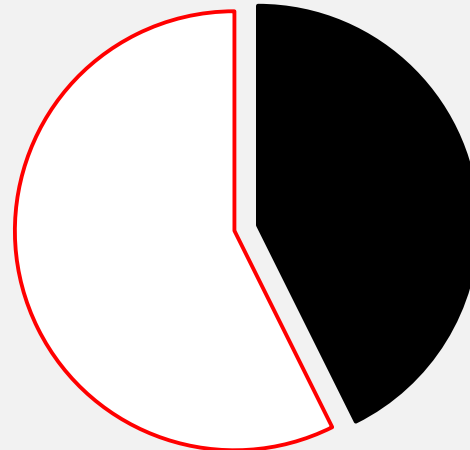

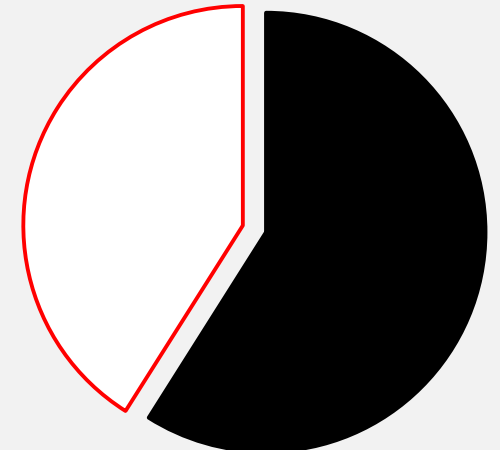

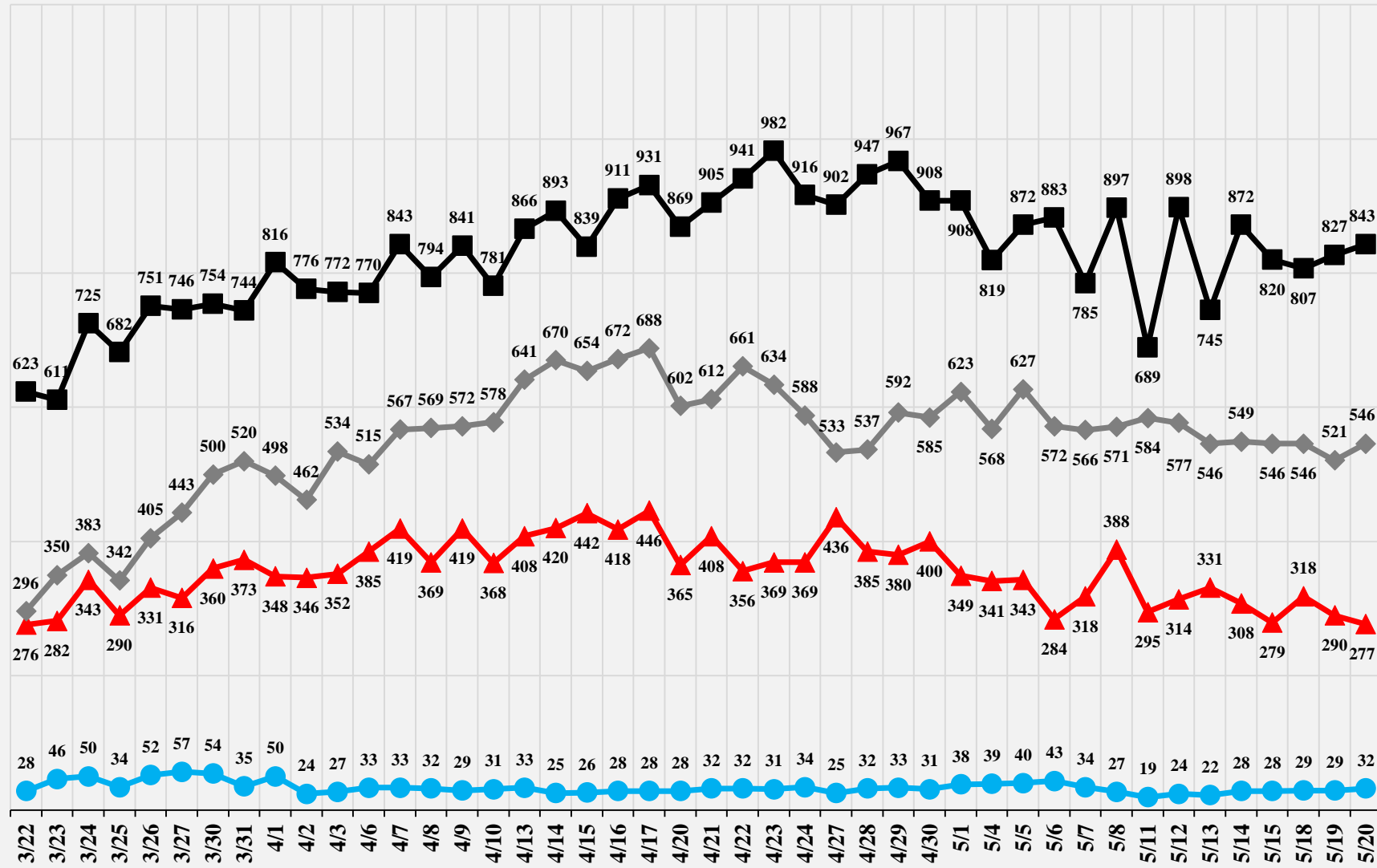

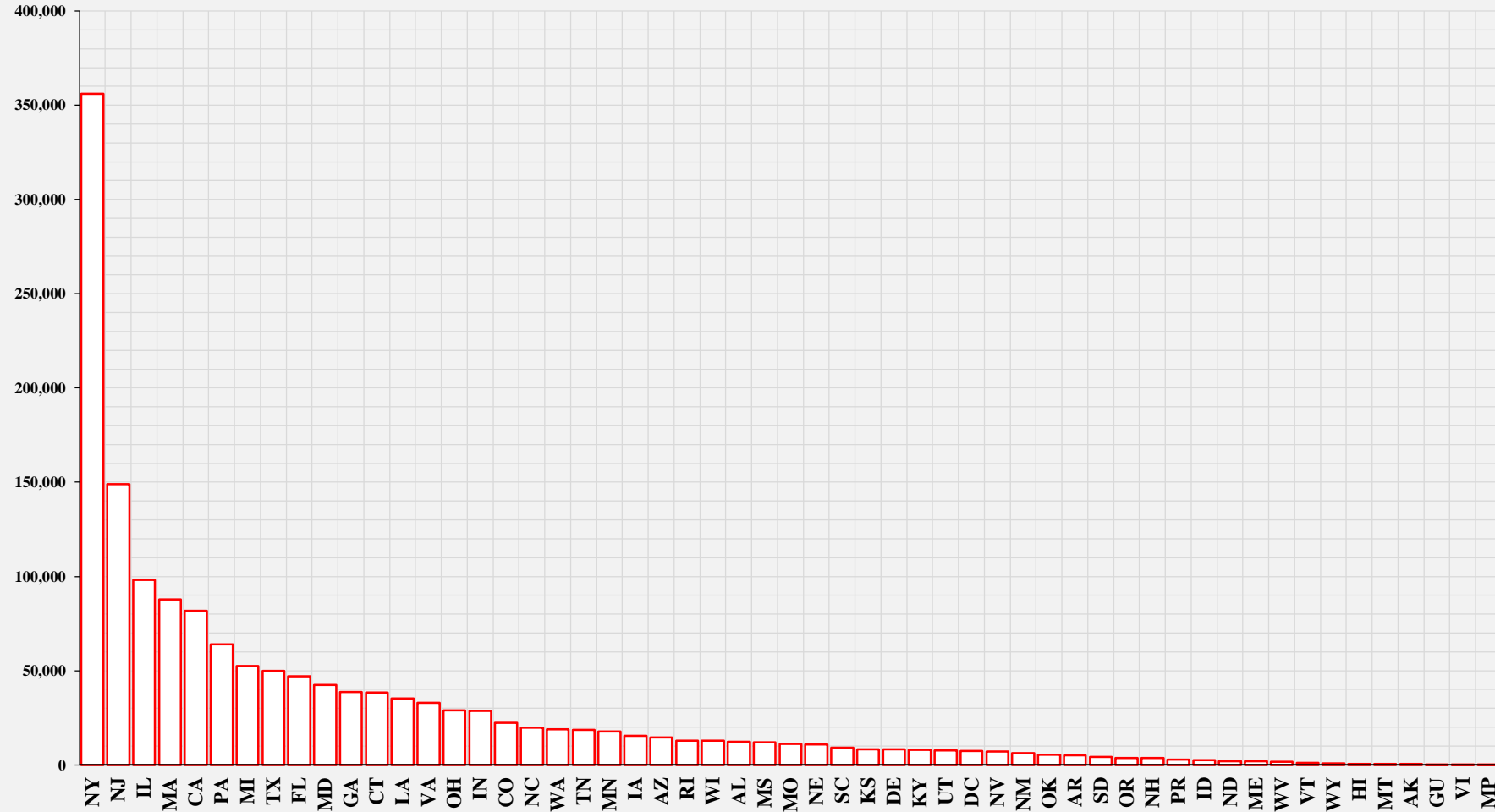
# COVID-19 Cumulative Confirmed Cases by U.S. State, Territory

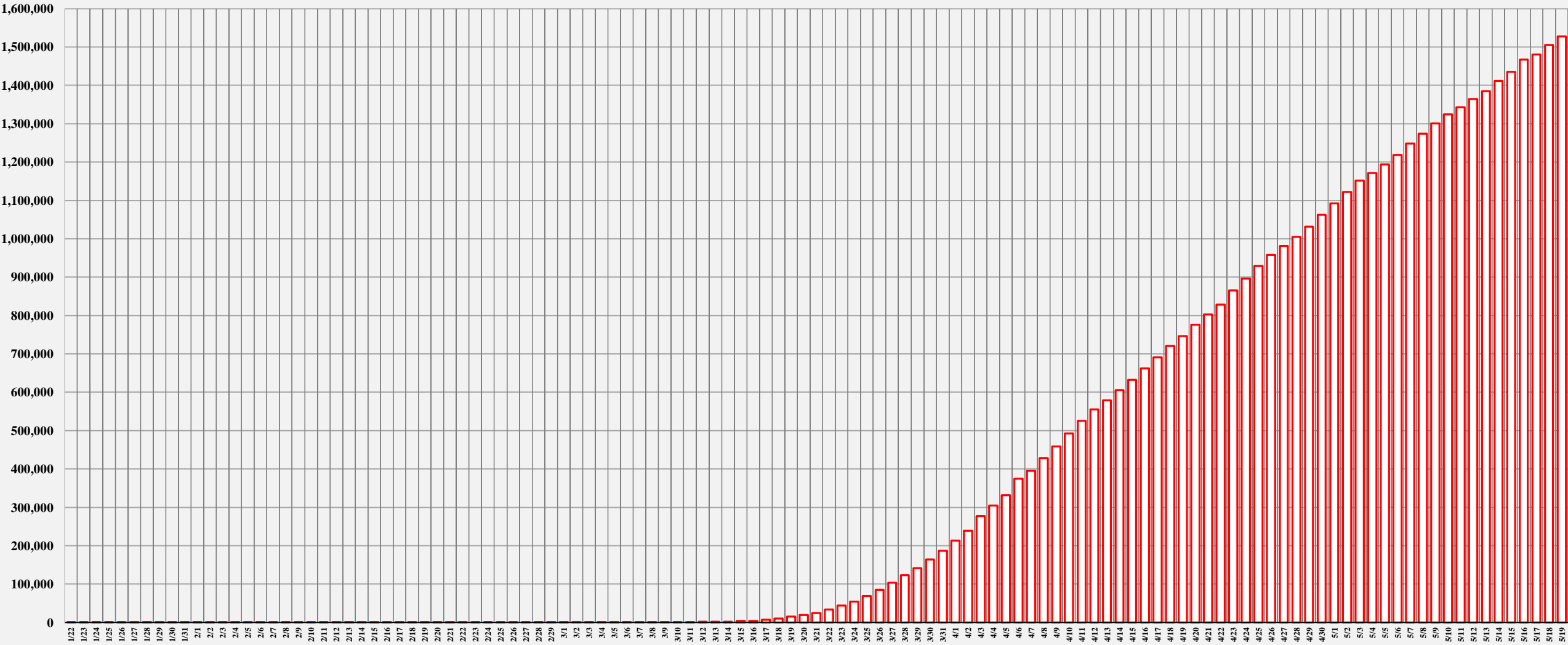
# COVID-19 Cumulative Confirmed U.S. Cases

■ Claims

*Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor. New data reported 5/14/2020:*

- Reported 32,794 initial claims filed in Oklahoma during the week ending 5/9/2020
- Revised upwards claims filed during the week ending 5/2/2020 by 25,648

*Each of these numbers represents the number of new unemployment claims filed in Oklahoma each week; they are **not** cumulative.*

*The weekly data is released, prior week data is subject to revision by the U.S. Department of Labor.*

*The data used here is not seasonally adjusted.*
