






This chart demonstrates cases, hospitalizations, and deaths reported daily rather than cumulative based on the Oklahoma State Health Department's daily reports.



COVID-19 Statewide Cases, Hospitalizations, and Deaths 14-Day Trends



COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Age Cohort As of 6/4/2020











COVID-19 Cases and Deaths by Gender




COVID-19 Case Status Statewide








Unemployment claims are reported on a weekly basis every Thursday by the U.S. Department of Labor. New data published 6/4/2020:

- *Reported 37,986 initial claims filed in Oklahoma during the week ending 5/30/2020*
- *Revised upwards by 11,587 claims filed during the week ending 5/23/2020*

Each of these numbers represents the number of new unemployment claims filed in Oklahoma each week; they are **not** cumulative.

The weekly data is released, prior week data is subject to revision by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The data used here is not seasonally adjusted.
