

#### **CoC Funding by Program Type**




## Continuum of Care Performance and Strategic Planning Objectives

- Joined the 100,000 Homes Campaign (now called Zero:2016) at end of 2012.
- Local name: Journey Home OKC
- Campaign emphasis = House most medically vulnerable chronically homeless using a housing first approach. – (Goal: House all by end of 2016)
- 2014: Increased focus on veterans (Goal: House All by end of 2015)

# Continuum of Care Performance and Strategic Planning Objectives

#### FEBRUARY 2012 - SEPTEMBER 2015

- 750 chronically homeless individuals and veterans placed in permanent supportive housing.
- Maintained 98% retention rate.
- CoC Funding is crucial to maintaining momentum.
