Grant Agreement with the United States of America, through the Federal Aviation Administration, accepting \$7,100,000 in Airport Improvement Program grant funds, Project No. 3-40-0072-067-2015, Rehabilitate Taxiway H, Will Rogers World Airport. Ward 3.

Location Will Rogers World Airport

Purpose Approve a Grant Agreement for Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant funds in the amount of \$7,100,000 offered by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to replace asphalt portions of north and south ends of Taxiway H with concrete.

Background The center portion of Taxiway H was realigned and paved with concrete in 2011-2012 as part of AIP Project No. 3-40-0072-060-2011. This concrete portion of Taxiway H has a higher Pavement Classification Number (PCN) than the asphalt ends, and is more structurally capable of supporting the aircraft mix desired for this taxiway. As the Airport Trust develops the east side of the Airport, it is desired that Taxiway H be uniform and fully capable of supporting the aircraft likely to utilize it. Grant funding from the FAA is anticipated to help defray approximately 90% of the cost of this project.

On February 26 and March 10, 2015, Trust and Council, respectively, jointly resolved to apply for FAA AIP funds and to accept the grant when offered. The Trust submitted the grant application on June 26, 2015, and received a Grant Agreement from the FAA in the amount of \$7,100,000 for the project.

Previous Action Airport Trust approved the Grant Agreement on August 27, 2015.
