## QUALIFYING FOR ASSISTANCE

**Assistance may be available for Oklahoma City metro residents who:**

- Have experienced a loss of income directly related to COVID-19
- Have lost your job or were placed on furlough on or after March 1, 2020
- Have received an eviction notice, notice of foreclosure, or cutoff notice for utilities
- Are struggling to pay your bills as a result of income loss from COVID-19
- Need training in a new career field due to a job loss
