## NOTICE OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK FOR SECURITY BADGING AND ACCESS TO CERTAIN AREAS ON AIRPORT PROPERTY

Will Rogers World Airport (Airport) intends to submit your fingerprints and certain other personal information to the FBI for a Criminal History Records Check (CHRC). Results of the CHRC will determine your eligibility to be issued a security badge for unescorted access to the Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) or access to the Sterile Area or for the Signatory Authority to request SIDA or Sterile Area access for others. The Airport may also conduct searches of other criminal record databases or sources for the purpose of completing your CHRC. Information obtained during the background check may be used for purposes of complying with 49 CFR Parts 1542.209 and 1544.229 and other Airport badging policies. The Director of Airports reserves the right to deny or to revoke any Airport badge based on any information obtained at any time that disqualifies you pursuant to federal regulation(s) or is deemed, in his sole discretion, to be for the safety and security of the public, personnel, and operations of the Airport.

Submission of your fingerprints or certain personal information is voluntary; however, failure to provide necessary information to conduct the background check will result in the Airport denying you unescorted access to the SIDA, a Sterile Area Identification Badge (permitting Sterile Area access), or from being allowed to authorize others to receive SIDA or Sterile Area access when applicable.

Once the TSA reports your CHRC results, the Airport will notify you before making a final decision if the FBI criminal record, or any other information obtained, reveals information that would disqualify you from receiving or retaining unescorted SIDA access, a Sterile Area Identification Badge, or Signatory Authority for SIDA/Sterile Area access. The Airport Security Coordinator (ASC) is your point of contact if you have questions about the results of the CHRC. You may reach the ASC during normal business hours at (405) 316-3208.

If you desire a copy of the FBI criminal records background check, want to correct information obtained in the criminal history background check, or to contest the denial or revocation of a security badge, you must notify the ASC in writing within thirty (30) calendar days of being advised of the information. Written requests should be submitted to:

If no written notice is received by the ASC within thirty (30) calendar days of advising the applicant of the criminal history records check findings, the Airport will make its final decision.

If the background check contains any outstanding warrant(s) for your arrest for any offense(s), whether disqualifiable or not, your security badge will be denied until such time as documentation is provided to the ASC that said warrant(s) have been cleared from your record and are no longer active.
