- Natural Grows Requires a Fire Inspection. This is created automatically from the MMCC that you will apply for. The inspector will call to set up the inspection. Be sure all related construction has been completed so we can do this inspection.
- CO2 Enhanced Grows Requires an Operational Permit and a Fire Inspection

Extraction/Processing/Testing — Requires an Operational Permit and a Fire Inspection

Submitting for an Operational Permit – Go to okc.gov website:

Select the appropriate application/s. Fill out the application completely do not leave spaces blank, if the answer is N/A or zero, fill that in. For example, if you are a processor and do not extract or use hazardous materials then you would write N/A in the spaces associated with extraction or hazardous materials. A detailed floor plan labeling rooms, equipment and hazardous materials (if any) used in the operation, gas detection, audible/visual alarm device locations, and a detailed description of the operation should be submitted with the application. Submit a paper and electronic copy of the application, plans, and description of operation to Fire Prevention, 2300 General Pershing Blvd, OKC.
