Ordinance on final hearing (emergency) recommended for approval (CE-900) closing a portion of NE 52nd Street and the platted streets and alleys located within Blocks 4 and 5 of Castle Hill, an Addition to Oklahoma City, east of Martin Luther King Avenue and south of Remington Place. Ward 7.

Applicant The City of Oklahoma City on behalf of the Science Museum of Oklahoma

Purpose The Science Museum of Oklahoma wishes to relocate a driveway from Martin Luther King Avenue to Remington Place, expand parking, and create pedestrian walkways to serve the museum.

Background On January 29, 2015, the Planning Commission recommended approval for this request, determining that with the relocation of any affected utilities or satisfactory rights to access the utilities through an easement that will be determined at the time of vacation in District Court, closing streets and alleys should not adversely affect the public.

Protest None.

Previous Action The Ordinance closing the above described streets and alleys was introduced February 17, 2015, set for final hearing March 24, 2015, and appropriate notice was published and mailed.
