TERMINATION OF PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, pursuant to Section 15-37 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, I declared a State of Emergency due to the public disaster of the COVID-19 pandemic which affected the life, health, property and public peace within the limits of The City of Oklahoma City and put public safety regulations in place; and

WHEREAS, this Proclamation was amended multiple times as the City's and community's response to the disaster changed; and

WHEREAS, Section 15-37 provides, the state of emergency shall continue until the issuance of a proclamation of the Mayor declaring its termination; and

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2021, a press conference was held providing notice of this termination.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, as the Mayor of The City of Oklahoma City I declare the state of emergency and the Proclamation of State of Emergency revised as of November 20, 2020 to be terminated.

AND I DO FURTHER PROCLAIM, that public notice of this termination of proclamation and state of emergency shall be given to and filed with the City Clerk of The City of Oklahoma City.
