Fix the Drip

Find and fix those leaky faucets, showerheads, and toilet flappers before they add thousands of gallons to your water bill.

- Walk through your home and check for dripping faucets, showerheads, and leaks from other water using appliances, like hot water tanks.
- Put a few drops of food coloring in your toilet tank. If the color shows up in the bowl without flushing, you have a leak. Usually, a new flapper will fix the leak.
- Don't forget your sprinkler system. Run through each zone and flag leaking or misaligned heads. Turn the system off and make repairs before turning it back on.
