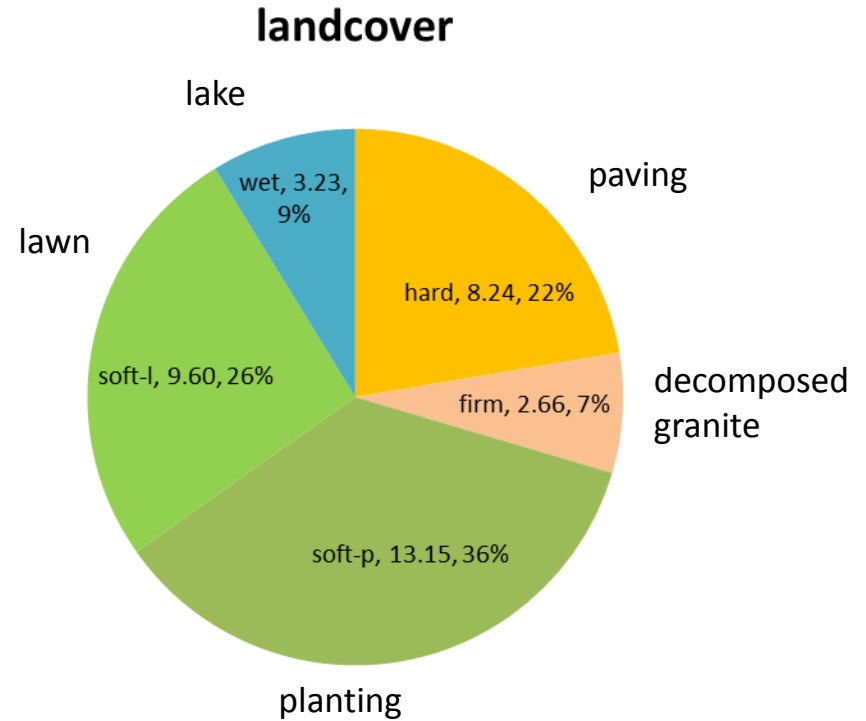

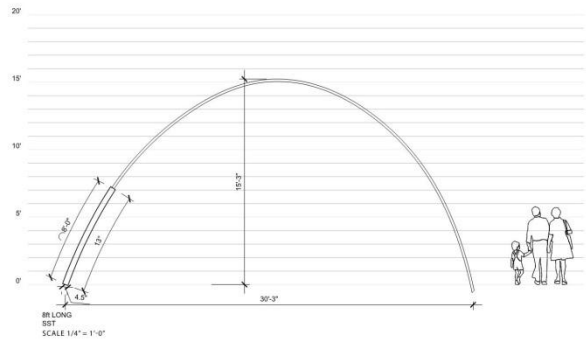

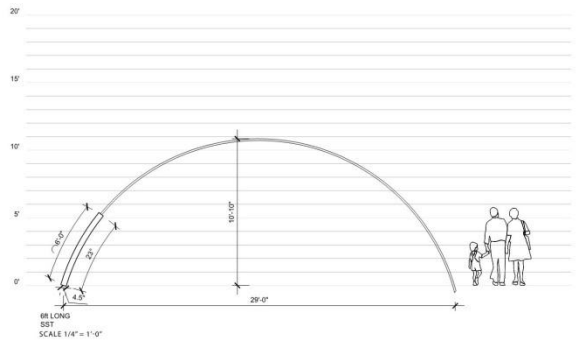

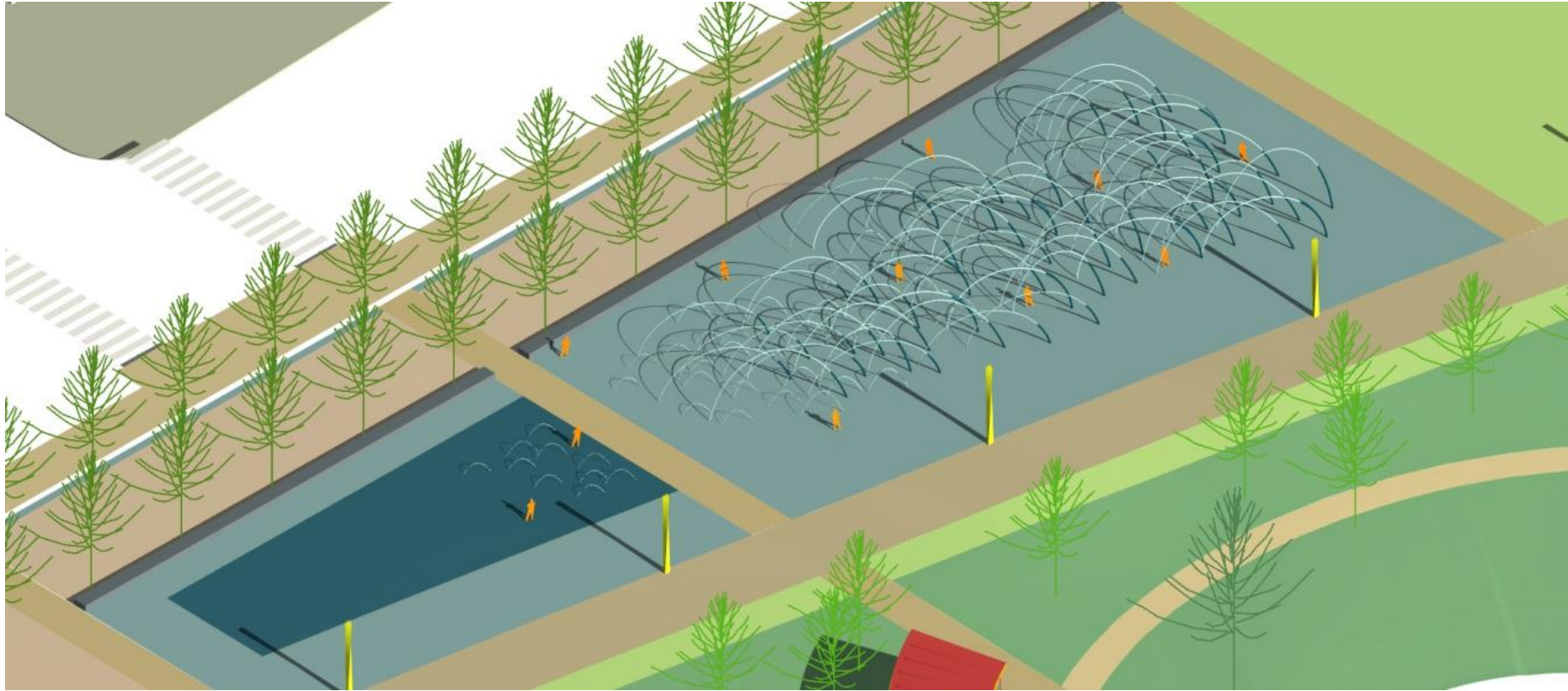

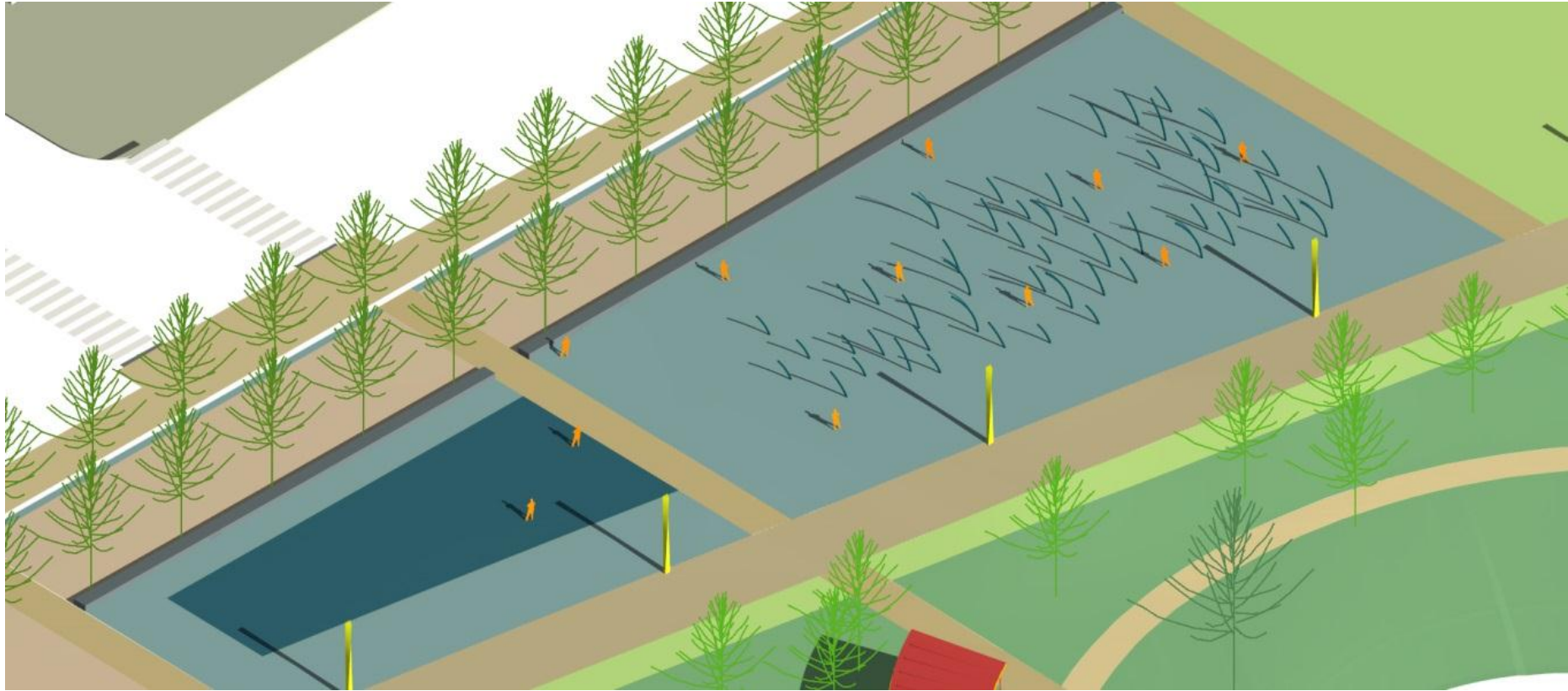


FOUNTAIN : Informal Layout (water on)



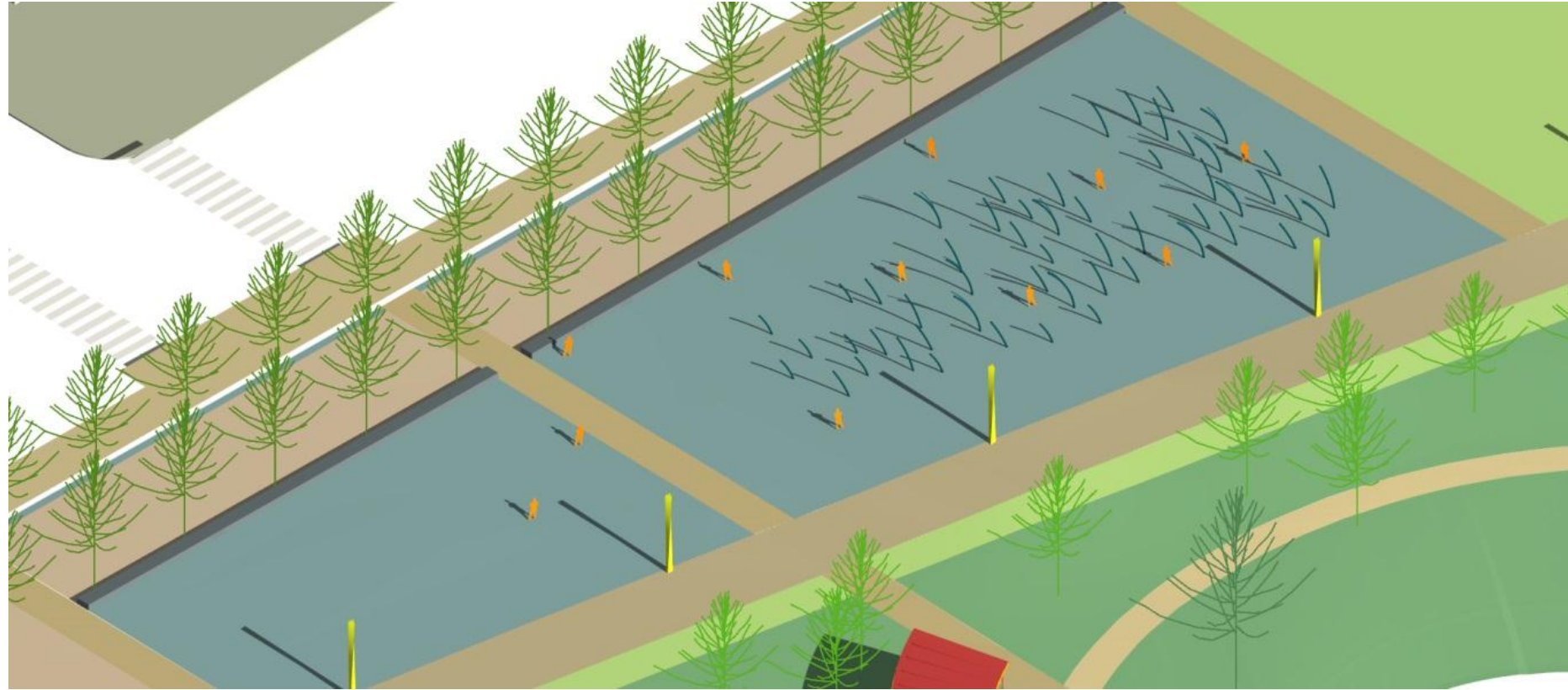

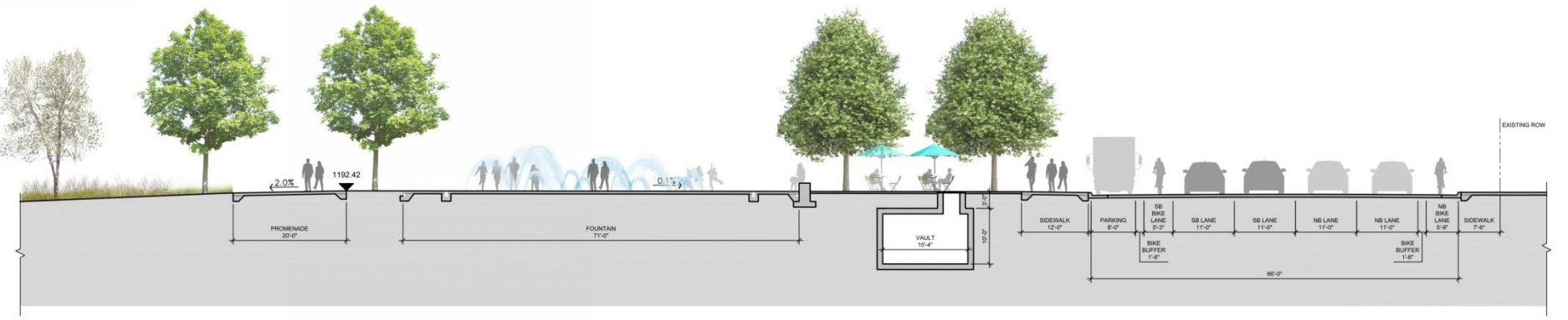

ROBINSON @ FOUNTAIN

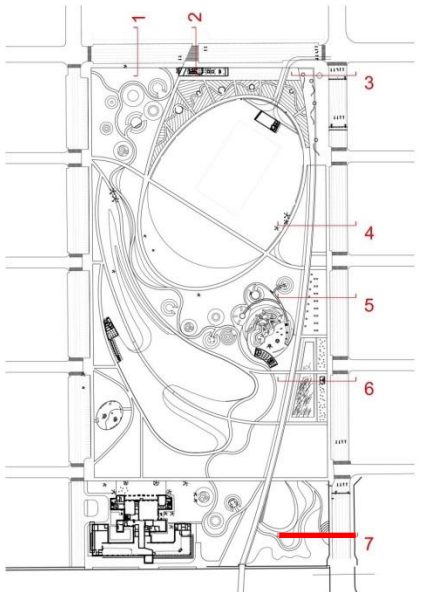
