# **STRATEGIES TO** RELIEVE HOMELESSNESS



A strategic plan to reduce and prevent homelessness in Oklahoma City was presented to City Council in October by Oklahoma City Homeless Services, Inasmuch Foundation and the Arnall Family Foundation. The 102-page plan details eight focus areas and 24 strategies to enhance homeless service delivery and help residents experiencing homelessness move into permanent housing. Implementation teams made up of two to eight people will be assigned to tackle each of the strategies. The success of the plan involves help from the entire community. Read the plan at okc.gov.

## Flood information

Contact the Public Works Department for flood information from our community's Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), including whether a property is in a special flood hazard area or floodway, historical flood information, flood depth data, special flood-related hazards, natural floodplain functions, problems not shown on the FIRM and more. Copies of FEMA elevation certificates of structures built in the floodplain after April 2013 are also available upon request. Call (405) 297-2581 for details.

# Winter Averaging

For most residential customers the flat monthly sewer charge, or winter average, is based on the average amount of water billed Dec-Feb. The Utilities Department uses your winter average to set a cap on your monthly sewer charge for the year, starting in April. Your winter average is re-calculated each year, so using less water during winter months by turning off your sprinkler systems and watching for leaks can help you save on your water bill all year. Fried turkeys look beautiful on the holiday table, but don't pour the used oil down your drain or on the ground. Fats, oils and grease clog your sewer lines and contaminate rivers and lakes. # Clear your warrant

If you or someone you know has a warrant for unpaid tickets for a class "a" offense dated on or before Dec. 31, we have good news.
