Area Planning: West Tenth

planokc recommends the creation of small area plans for neighborhoods or districts with special strategic importance. Area planning is part of a broader effort to revitalize urban neighborhoods and commercial districts throughout the city by combining public resources with ongoing private investment. Area Planning will serve as an implementation tool for planokc's four Big Ideas:

- Develop great places that attract people and catalyze new development and innovation.
- Develop a transportation system that works for everyone.
- Ensure stable, safe, attractive and vibrant neighborhoods.
- Build an urban environment that facilitates a culture of health and wellness.
