## Common Causes of High Water Bills

-  Just one broken sprinkler head can waste 25,000 gallons of water over the summer. Detect and correct issues with a free sprinkler checkup guide on [SqueezeEveryDrop.com](https://www.squeezeeverydrop.com).
-  Sprinkler systems typically use 15 to 35 gallons per minute. Check your sprinkler system controller schedule for long runtimes or hidden start times. Most lawns only need about 1 inch of water a week during summer months.
-  Toilet and household leaks can add thousands of gallons to your bill. Put a few drops of food coloring in your toilet tank - if the color shows up in the bowl without flushing, you have a leak! Usually, replacing a worn out toilet flapper will keep money from going down the drain.
