**GENERAL INFORMATION ON
PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN OKLAHOMA CITY**

1. Restricted parking on City streets is allowed under certain conditions. Some of the reasons for restricting parking are to help keep streets clear for the free movement of ordinary traffic and emergency vehicles and to improve safety by removing site-specific hazards associated with on-street parking.
2. Except under a few circumstances, all parking restriction requests must be presented to the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission. The public hearing process and criteria for having a considered is outlined in the commission's Operating Policies and Procedures document as amended on January 20, 2012.
3. A petition circulated to all parties affected by the proposed restriction is required. Information on the necessary petition requirements is included in the Operating Policies and Procedures document. All information regarding *how* to submit a parking restriction request is included in that document.
4. The Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, allows for different types of parking restrictions, each of which serves differing needs:
 - A. **No Parking Anytime.** This type of parking restriction prohibits parking under all circumstances at all times and is in effect on a full-time basis.
 - B. **No Parking Certain Times.** This type of restriction limits parking either by time-of-day or by day-of-week and in some cases, both. It restricts parking on a limited basis, which is typically dependent on unique circumstances, such as the presence of a park or school. This restriction is also useful where, to meet periodic heavy traffic demand, it is necessary to make additional traffic lanes available by temporarily eliminating parking.
 - C. **Time-Limited Parking.** This restriction limits the amount of time that a vehicle may be parked at a certain location and can also include a time-of-day and/or day-of-week limitation. It is typically used in the downtown area and in some heavily commercialized areas. This type of parking control may allow for free parking or may be associated with the use of parking meters.
