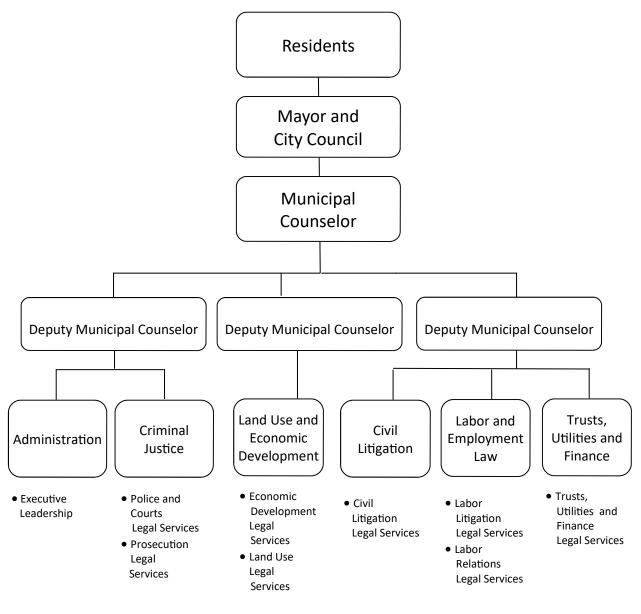

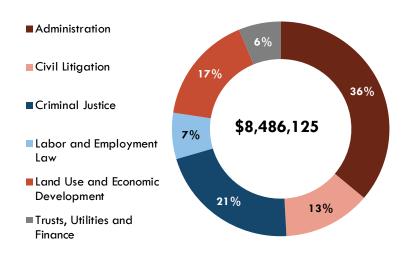

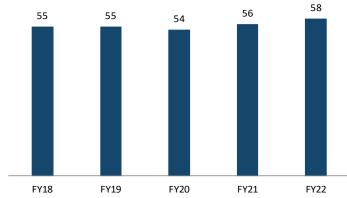
DEPARTMENT BUDGET

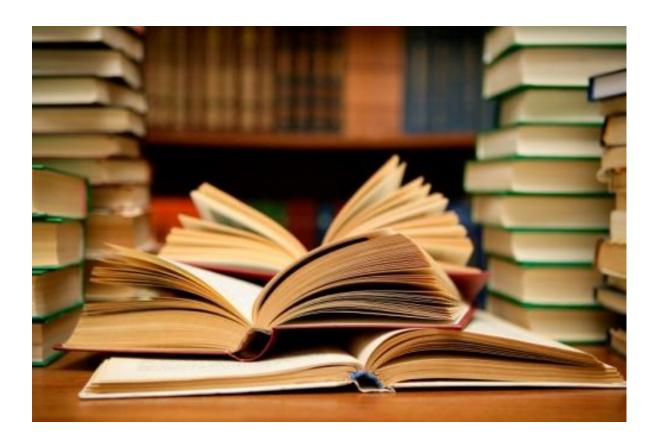

Department Facts

- The Municipal Counselor's Office serves as legal counsel to all departments and trusts in the City and consistently maintains positive satisfaction responses on the annual client survey.
- In addition to existing matters, in 2021 the Municipal Counselor's Office handled 577 new civil cases, approximately 150,000 new criminal citations, 540 new claims, 464 new expungements, opened 197 collections, collected over \$790,000, and responded to multiple client-requested projects, such as drafting ordinances, contracts and legal opinions.
