

CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY INSURANCE INFORMATION

Parks Ordinance reference

§ 38-708. Insurance.

All permittees shall be required to carry and maintain at all times the permit is in effect general public liability insurance against claims for bodily injury, personal injury, death or property damage occurring or arising out of the conduct of the permitted business or activity. The limits of liability insurance shall be not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit personal injury and property damage insurance. The City of Oklahoma City shall be named as additional insured on all such policies. Proof of such insurance shall be provided prior to the issuance of the permit.

Outdoor Special Events Ordinance reference

§ 50-264. Permit Regulations.

- (k) For Major Events occupying all or a portion of public rights-of-way, Organizer shall obtain and maintain in effect an insurance policy with Comprehensive General Liability coverage sufficient to pay The City's maximum liability under the Governmental Tort Claims Act (51 Okla. Stat. §§ 151 *et seq.*) as it may be amended from time to time, covering any alleged liability and costs of defense of The City for any claim under any theory arising in connection with the Event. Said coverages shall be effective during the entire term of the Permit on an occurrence basis. Said insurance policy shall name The City of Oklahoma City and public trusts, of which it is the sole beneficiary, as additional insured and provide that coverage cannot be canceled or materially modified except upon 10 days' prior written notice to The City of Oklahoma City of said cancellation or modification. Organizer shall pay any and all insurance deductibles that are required to be paid under the insurance policy. An original certificate of insurance with proof of receipts of premium showing compliance with all of these terms and conditions shall be delivered to The City 15 days prior to the Council consideration of the Revocable Permit.

For each of the instances below, language on separate Certificates of Insurance should state that the affected entity be covered as additional insured and be listed as a Certificate Holder:
