Toss fats, oils and grease into the trash to help prevent pipe clogs.

Fats, oils and grease (FOG) can build up inside your pipes over time, creating clogs and backups that can cost you money.

- Put cooking oils, grease, butter, gravies and fats in the trash or pour them into a can to freeze. Once the can is full, toss it in the trash.
- Wipe greasy pots and dishes with a paper towel before washing them in the sink or dishwasher.
- Never pour cooking grease down the sink or in the toilet.
