GENERAL SERVICE ADMINISTRATION (GSA) Federal Employee SmartPay Credit Cards

There are three account types within SmartPay Program:

- 1. Centrally Billed Accounts (CBA): CBAs are card accounts where payment is made directly to the bank by the Government.
- 2. **Individually Billed Accounts (IBA):** IBAs are card accounts where payment is made directly to the bank by the individual.
- 3. Tax Advantage Travel Account: A combination of CBA and IBA. Charges for rental cars and lodging will be automatically billed to a CBA for payment. Charges for other travel-related purchases such as meals and incidentals are billed to the IBA portion of the account.

Travel and Integrated Cards:

Some states also provide tax exemption on individually billed travel accounts. To determine whether the travel or integrated card is a CBA or an IBA, refer to the 6th digit of the account number on the card. Here is a table that can help:
