Hammons, Trustees of the Townsite of Oklahoma City in the Second County in Oklahoma Territory, in trust for the several use and benefit of the occupants of the Townsite of Oklahoma City in said County and Territory, according to their respective interests, have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edgar N. Sweet, Levi C. Goe and David H. Hammons Trustees as aforesaid in trust as aforesaid, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April

1820 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, including the act of May 14th, 1890, for the South East quarter of Section thirty-three in Township twelve North of Range three West of Indian Meridian in Oklahoma Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Edgar N. Sweet, Levi C. Goe and David H. Hammons Trustees as aforesaid in trust as aforesaid.

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided Have given and granted and by these presents Do Give and Grant unto the said Edgar N. Sweet, Levi C. Goe

and David H. Hammons Trustees as
aforesaid in trust as aforesaid and to
their successors the said Tract above de-
scribed: To Have and To Hold the same
together with all the rights, privileges, im-
munities and appurtenances of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging unto the said
Edgar N. Sweet, Levi C. Coe and David
H. Hammons, Trustees as aforesaid in
trust as aforesaid and to their successors
and assigns in trust as aforesaid.

Patent and the Seal of the General Land
Office to be hereunto affixed.
