

NOTICE TO ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS, AND PLANNERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City of Oklahoma City has a project that requires the services of a consulting firm.

In order to be considered, the Consultant must comply with the Resolution establishing procedure for "Selection of Architects, Engineers, and Planners" adopted by the City Council on November 18, 1986, a copy of which may be obtained at <http://www.okc.gov/pw/admin.html> from the office of the Public Works Department Director.

The Project is as follows:

Project No. ST-0141, Wet Weather Master Planning Report – North Canadian, Deer Creek and Chisholm Creek Wastewater Treatment Plants

The chosen consultant will complete an evaluation of the wet weather flows to the North Canadian, Deer Creek and Chisholm Creek Wastewater Treatment Plants (WWTP) and the required infrastructure necessary to store or treat the flows during wet weather events. The Purpose of this project is to:


1. Evaluate wet weather flow data to each WWTP to assess the volume of water required for storage or the maximum treatment rate necessary while still maintaining compliance;
2. Determine the most economical method to handling wet weather flows;
3. Facilitate discussions with regulatory agencies to achieve approval of recommendations at the completion of the report;
4. Coordinate pilot testing if necessary to obtain approval of new or emerging technologies to implement the most cost effective solution; and
5. Generate a final wet weather master plan that provides a clear plan of required capital improvements at each WWTP to be completed by subsequent engineering contracts.

As a part of your Letter of Interest, provide your understanding of the project and your expertise and experience on similar projects.
