National Recycling Day

Nov. 15 is National Recycling Day. Unfortunately, 31% of items customers put in green recycling carts cannot be recycled and must be sent to a landfill. Reduce contamination in green recycling carts with these tips:

- Do empty, clean and dry jars and bottles.
- Don't bag recyclables. Put all items loose in your cart. Plastic bags are considered contamination and delay the recycling process.
- Don't use your green recycling cart for household, yard waste or construction trash.

The Greenway River Trail, a new four-mile multi-use trail that connects the North Oklahoma River Trail to the Katy Trail, opened in late August. This \$6 million, four-mile trail section began construction in January 2022 and runs along the north shore of the Oklahoma River from Riversport Drive to NE 4th Street. It was funded through the 2007 General Obligation Bond and trail impact fees.

With the addition of this trail section, OKC Parks & Recreation now boasts nearly 100 miles of inner-connected recreational trails. Visit okc.gov/parks to learn more about OKC trails.

Public Safety Partnership

Mayor David Hold recently announced the OKC Public Safety Partnership. This is a continued effort to enhance and refine de-escalation, community engagement and accountability among law-enforcement policies.

The Public Safety Partnership is a collaboration between the Oklahoma City Council, City leaders, law enforcement, community members and other stakeholders working to implement 39 recommendations presented to Council in March 2022. Home heat safety

Be warm and safe this winter with these tips:

- Keep anything that can burn at least three feet away from heating equipment (furnace, fireplace, wood stove, space heaters, etc.).
- Have a three-foot "kid-free zone" around open fires and space heaters.
- Never use your oven to heat your home.
- Heating equipment and chimneys should be cleaned and inspected yearly by a qualified professional.
- Turn off portable heaters when you leave the room or go to bed.
- Make sure the fireplace has a sturdy screen to prevent sparks from flying.
- Open the flue when lighting and using the fireplace.
- Never use heaters to dry clothes or warm blankets.

Winter-ready irrigation

As colder weather approaches, it's crucial to protect your sprinkler or irrigation system. These systems are excellent for maintaining your landscape's health, but can be vulnerable in the winter. These simple steps can help protect your landscaping investment and prevent costly repairs.

- Use heat tape and an insulated pouch or cover to keep your backflow device from being exposed to the elements.
- Insulate outdoor faucets or spigots with foam covering.
- If you have above-ground systems like drip irrigation or hoses, drain the water and disconnect hoses from faucets and store them in a garage or shed for reuse.
