Who Must File a Permit Application for Industries Associated with Cosmetic Cleaning Operations

Any person who engages in commercial cosmetic cleaning is required to apply for a permit. Cosmetic cleaning is defined as any system, machine, or substance used to remove undesirable substances from any surface or façade creating free foreign matter.

Oklahoma City Municipal Code Section 57-190 adopts by reference Federal law at 40 CFR part 122 and also by reference in Oklahoma Administrative Code 252:606-5-5 prohibiting point source discharges of storm water associated with industrial activity to a water of the US without a Municipal Storm Water Discharge Permit. Completing the Form

Obtain and read a copy of City of Oklahoma City <u>Municipal</u> <u>Code Sections 57-190 through 57-196</u>.

Section I. Business Information

Enter the business's name, complete street address, including city, state, and ZIP code, for which you are making this application.

Section II. Owner/Operator Information

Enter the legal name of the owner/operator of the business for which you are applying for a permit. Include the phone number and billing email address.

Section III. Vehicle Information

Enter the description and vehicle registration number of each vehicle to be registered under the license.

Enter the license number of the trailer, if one will be used.

Section IV. Disposal Method

Check the appropriate box for the filtration or containment process that will be used.

Any applicant who utilizes wash water recycling units must list all sanitary sewer discharge locations the applicant intends to use. List the Industrial Wastewater Pretreatment disposal location and Permit #, if applicable. Section V. Certification

General Information

The Cosmetic Cleaning Permit Number must be displayed in a visible location on the vehicle or trailer registered under this permit. A minimum character height of three inches is required.

A permit holder shall ensure that all of its employees engaged in mobile commercial cosmetic cleaning are knowledgeable of the discharge prohibitions to the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System and shall require all its employees to use best management practices when engaging in mobile commercial cosmetic cleaning.

A permit shall be valid for one year from the date of its issuance, unless suspended or revoked.

Permit Renewal

Should your cosmetic cleaning operations continue beyond one year, you must update and resubmit this form, along with a \$55 permit renewal fee, before permit expiration. Refer to the filing and payment methods listed under How to Submit the Permit Application. Late fees may be incurred if the permit is not renewed before expiration.
