DEDUCT METER APPLICATION

Section 47-120 (b) of the Oklahoma City Code requires customers to make application for reduction in the volume of waste discharged to the public sewer. Installation of deduct meters must be made at the expense of the citizen and all information requested on this application form must be provided prior to approval by the Utilities Director. The location of requested deduct water meters must be approved as a part of this application. Under no circumstances will deduct water meters be used to reduce sewer volume without an approved copy of this application. An application must be filled out for each meter required and a flow diagram is required with the application for it to be considered for approval.
