FREE LANDFILL DAY

Spring cleaning? Take unwanted stuff to a local landfill during Free Landfill Day on May 18. Landfills will be open from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. This event is for OKC residential solid waste customers. An original current water bill or copy of an e-bill is required. Each household may make one trip to the landfill using a passenger vehicle or truck, up to 1-ton, and adding one trailer up to 16-feet. No commercial waste haulers. Participating landfills:

- Property taxes are current
- Property not located in a FEMA floodplain

Gourley is Oklahoma City's 50th Chief of Police and oversees 1,235 uniformed officer positions and 413 non-sworn employees.
