Most lawns only need about 1 inch of water per week during the summer months. Use a rain gauge or sensor and let nature give your sprinkler system a break on rainy days.

Indoor and outdoor leaks can add thousands of gallons to your bill. Check for leaks in outdoor spigots, pool systems and toilets.
