





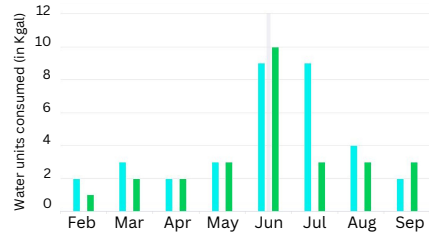
# Don't get burned by high bills this summer!

Follow these tips to conserve water and help prevent unnecessary high bills.

-  Homes with sprinkler systems use about 50% more water during the summer. Find and fix leaks and system issues quickly.
-  Sprinkler systems typically use 15 to 30 gallons per minute. Check your sprinkler system controller schedule for long runtimes, hidden programs and incorrect watering days.
-  Most lawns only need about 1 inch of water per week during the summer months. Use a rain gauge or sensor and let nature give your sprinkler system a break on rainy days.
-  Indoor and outdoor leaks can add thousands of gallons to your bill. Check for leaks in outdoor spigots, pool systems and toilets.
