Eligible Applicants

- 501c3 Non-Profit
- Have active registration in the System for Award Management (SAM.gov)
- Match 100% of funds granted (ESG)
- Must house people through the Coordinated Entry System (CES) and enter all data into HMIS

- Jun 14— Local CoC NOFOs (RFP) & Applications Released
- Jun 21 Process Overview & TA
- July 12 Applications Due by 5pm
- Week of July 22 July 26 Allocations Committee Meets Project Allocations Announced
- Aug 2 Approved Agreements Due to CoC
- TBD Agreements Routed to City Council for Approval

- Transportation

- Case Management

HOPWA

Eligible Services

- Housing location/re-location & stabilization services
- Rental Assistance (including shared housing arrangements)
- Short-term rent, mortgage & utility payments
- Case Management
- Operations
- Administration

HOPWA

Eligible Service Recipients

- Individuals with HIV/AIDS diagnosis
- Families with family member with HIV/AIDS diagnosis
- Income below 80% of AMI (Area Median Income)

All Projects

Compliance

- Enter all client data into HMIS within 72 hours
- Clients are referred to programs through the Coordinated Entry System (CES)
- Must document client income, homelessness status, provision of housing and all supportive services

All Projects

Compliance

- Must document all service and housing costs + match payments
- If funding staff payroll must comply with federal requirements (show hours charged to individual grants)
- HOPWA Must complete annual report.
