Building projects in the City's design review districts require a Certificate of Approval prior to obtaining a building permit. This report lists projects that have received an administratively approved Certificate of Approval issued by staff of the Oklahoma City Planning Department. Work on approved projects may not commence until after the mandatory 10-business day appeal period starting from the date of approval.
