As part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), the City of Oklahoma City received an allocation of \$78.5 million from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, Revenue Replacement Category to provide funding for the S. May Avenue Trail (aka Airport Trail).

Project MP-0608, Trail Alignment paralleling I-44 between Woodson Park and SW 74<sup>th</sup> Street ending in close proximity to Oklahoma City Community College. The scope of the work will provide a new 10-12 foot wide trail and include improved streetscape amenities such as wayfinding signage, bus stop benches/shelters, and solar lighting as well as some added low maintenance landscape features for property screening and enhancement. Other improvements along this new trail will include upgraded ADA-compliant pedestrian features at signalized intersections and a retaining wall at the I-240 bridge over May Avenue.

The City of Oklahoma City requires any contractor engaging in work on public property, for which a prequalification class of such work has been established, must be prequalified by the Prequalification Review Board for that class of work to perform such work. Additionally, to bid on this Project, the Bidder must be prequalified by the City of Oklahoma City's Prequalification Review Board prior to the bid date as: **PAVING CONTRACTOR "A"**. Notwithstanding the bidding requirement above, the contractor or subcontractor performing any work for which a prequalification class has been created, the contractor must be prequalified in that class to perform that work.
