NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City Council of Oklahoma City will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance, extending the limits of the SPUD-1654 Simplified Planned Unit Development District from AA Agricultural District. A public hearing will be held by the City Council on September 24, 2024. **The City Council meets in the Council Chamber, Third Floor, Municipal Building, 200 North Walker Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma beginning at 8:30 a.m.**

Under the terms of said ordinance, the limits of and boundaries of the SPUD Simplified Planned Unit Development District would be extended to include the following described property:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

A tract of land lying in and being a part of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Six (6) West of the Indian Meridian, Canadian County, Oklahoma, being more particularly described as follows: COMMENCING at the Southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4); THENCE North 00°16'23" East, along the West line of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4), a distance of 1,337.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE continuing North 00°16'23" East, along the West, a distance of 276.65 feet; THENCE South 89°22'12" East a distance of 788.65 feet; THENCE South 00°16'23" West, and parallel with said West line, a distance of 275.75 feet; THENCE North 89°26'07" West a distance of 788.65 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

PROPOSED USE: The purpose of this application is to allow two single-family residences.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ZONING DISTRICT:

This site will be developed in accordance with the regulation of the modified **RA2 Single-Family Two Acre Rural Residential District** (OKC Zoning Ordinance, 2020).

Any person having any objections to the proposed rezoning may appear before the City Council in the **COUNCIL CHAMBER** on the above date set for hearing and show cause why the proposed rezoning should not be carried out in accordance with said ordinance. At any time not later than three days prior to said hearing, any owner of property within the district affected, or any owner of property within a 300-foot radius of the exterior boundary of the subject property, may make legal written protest by filing the same with the Office of the City Clerk, 200 North Walker Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73102.
