

NOTICE TO ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS, AND PLANNERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City of Oklahoma City has a certain Capital Improvement project that requires the services of a consulting firm.

In order to be considered, the Consultant must comply with the Resolution establishing procedure for "Selection of Architects, Engineers, and Planners" adopted by the City Council on November 18, 1986, a copy of which may be obtained at <http://okc.gov/departments/public-works/engineer-architect-resources/notice-to-a-e> or from the office of the Public Works Department Director.

The Project is as follows: AT-0041, Replace asphalt with concrete on the terminal apron, located at the intersection of Taxiway K at Will Rogers World Airport; and repair or replace other Concrete Aprons as determined.

The selected firm will provide conceptual and final design services, prepare plans and specifications for bidding, provide construction administration services and inspection during construction.

Estimated Construction Cost: \$1,000,000


