REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Oklahoma City requests proposals from professionally qualified individuals to complete an intensive-level survey of portions of Rancho Village, as funding allows. Funding for this project is a federal matching grant-in-aid from the State Historic Preservation Office's allocation from the US Department of the Interior's Historic Preservation Fund. An estimated \$12,000 in funds has been set aside for this project. Of that amount, 100% will be funded through federal funds.

All project work must conform to the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and Guidelines for Archeology and Historic Preservation. The submittal requirements to submit for the Request for Proposals will be available November 15, 2024 at
