# KNOW YOUR PIPE TYPE? LET US KNOW!

The City of Oklahoma City is working to determine the **private water service line** material type for every customer we serve. With more than 250,000 customers, it's a big task.

Water service lines are small-diameter water pipes that connect a public water system to a home or building. **Your property records—like plumbing repair receipts or building plans—might have the details we need.** Sharing this information with us helps us stay in compliance with federal guidelines for water systems. Don't worry if you're unsure—any effort to check your records helps.
