### 2024 resident survey

Satisfaction with OKC as a place to live, work, raise children, visit and retire is significantly above the national average, according to results from the City's annual survey administered in July by surveyor ETC Institute. OKC rated above average in 30 areas and significantly above average in 26 of the 52 categories compared to ETC's national benchmarking. Although OKC sets the standard in many categories, areas residents would like to see the most improvement include homelessness and the condition of city streets. ### Snow and ice

If snow and ice begin to fall, City street crews will work around the clock to clear streets along the City's snow routes until conditions improve. The snow route map is available at okc.gov/winter. Neighborhood streets are not part of the snow routes and will not be treated. People are encouraged to avoid driving during hazardous conditions.

#### 2025 GO BOND PROGRAM | HELP US, HELP YOU

The City of Oklahoma City wants to hear about your infrastructure needs. Think about questions like this. "What roads need to be repaved? Where does the City need to add sidewalks?" You can help shape the 2025 general obligation (GO) bond program by answering those questions and more. GO bonds are the City's most important tool for funding major projects like building or rebuilding streets, bridges, police and fire facilities, sidewalks and more.

Ahead of the fall 2025 election, we are gathering feedback from all over the city. While we can't meet every need across OKC's 621 miles in one GO bond election, we have developed a few tools and resources to help identify priorities in our communities. ## Good Sam App

911 callers may struggle to communicate essential details during stressful situations, which is why the Oklahoma City Fire Department partnered with Good Sam App. Emergency dispatchers can send a link to callers' phones where they can share real-time video. If you accept the link, dispatchers gain a oneway video. With greater emergency details shared, OKCFD can make more informed decisions prior to arriving. While the Good Sam App can be used for various emergency situations, OKCFD is not using it for medical calls.

# Ward 1,3, 4 and 7 elections

A general election is set for Feb. 11, 2025. The nonpartisan election will decide who represents Wards 1,3, 4 and 7 on the Council for the next four-year term. Councilmembers elected will serve part-time as head of the City's Council-Manager form of government. All registerd voters in Wards 1,3, 4 and 7 are eligible to vote. Scammers, posing as OKC Court employees and law enforcement are calling residents from what appears to be an OKC Municipal Court phone number and demanding they pay their tickets over the phone, or they will go to jail. People who get this money-demanding phone call should hang up and do one of the following to pay their ticket:

- Call (405) 297-3898 (M-F, 8 a.m. 5 p.m.)
- Visit the Municipal Court Customer Service Window, 701 Couch Drive (M-F, 7:30 a.m. -5:30 p.m., *except City-observed holidays*)
- Go to okc.gov/court
