NEW ONLINE REGISTRATION AT WWW.OKC.GOV/PARKSIGNUP

Our new online registration system will make signing up and paying for our programs and rentals as easy as the click of a button.

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Visit www.okc.gov/parks via your web browser or smart phone and click on the "Register Here" link. OR, go directly to www.okc.gov/parksignup and follow the prompts to create an account.
2. Search for the program you wish to register for. There are two ways to search:
 - a. Browse all programs
 - b. Search for programs by type (athletics, aquatics, performing arts, etc.)
 - c. Select a program using the Event ID code listed next to each individual program. If a program does not have a code listed, then either no registration is required, or onsite registration is required.
3. Once you have found a program you wish to sign up for, click on the "Register Here" button. You will then select the program date you want.
4. Once you've selected your program, you can then **Create an Account** by clicking on the "Sign Up" button. Returning users can **Log In** using their User ID and Password.

Note: Users who had an account with our old system will need to create a new account as we were not able to transfer over the old data. Once you have created an account, you will be able to use this account for any future activity.
5. Fill in the information as directed on the **Create An Account** page and follow the steps to register yourself - or others - for the program you wish. Once you have completed this information, you will be directed to the **Payment Page**.
6. Follow the directions on the payment page to finalize your registration. The City of Oklahoma City accepts Visa, Mastercard, and Discover for online payment transactions.
7. Once you have submitted your registration, you will be sent a confirmation email to the address provided. Please check your spam, junk or other folders to ensure its delivery.

WELCOME



Happy Trails and Happy New Year from your Oklahoma City Parks & Recreation! As we get ready to start another season of bringing wellness, recreation and cultural arts to the Oklahoma City community, we want to share with you the many milestones we achieved in 2016.

In May, we joined other City leaders to dedicate the opening of the new white water facility at the River Sport Adventure Park along the Oklahoma River. The MAPS3 project, located in Regatta Park, not only provides ongoing economic benefit to

the City, but brings adventure and recreation opportunities to residents and visitors alike. In August, we opened six new indoor tennis courts at the Oklahoma City Tennis Center in Will Rogers Park. The new courts bring year-round playing opportunities to this neighborhood park and improve its value as a world-class facility. In September, we broke ground on space for a Vietnam War monument and improvements in Military Park to honor the American and South Vietnamese soldiers who sacrificed their lives in service during the Vietnam War. We ended the year with the opening of the City's first-ever dedicated equestrian park on the City's south side. Less than a mile from the State Fairgrounds, and with views of the downtown skyline, the new equestrian park gives horse enthusiasts more than 20 acres of open riding space along the Oklahoma River.

More is to come in 2017, including new tournament-ready soccer fields at South Lakes Park, skate courts at Stars & Stripes and Schilling parks, improvements to the Earlywine Family Aquatic Center, plus the new MAPS3-funded Will Rogers Trail, which will bring an additional 8 miles of recreational cycling and running space along the I-44 corridor. We're also making significant improvements to the visitor building at Martin Park Nature Center and the Will Rogers Garden Exhibition Center to better provide education and enrichment programs for Oklahoma City residents.

None of this could happen without the support of our Oklahoma City residents. In 2017, you will have the opportunity to vote on capital improvements to our parks through new General Obligation Bonds, helping us to continue a long-lasting legacy of quality-of-life projects for generations to come. We'll post more about the new bond program, as well as our many new recreation programs and offerings, on our website at www.okc.gov/parks.

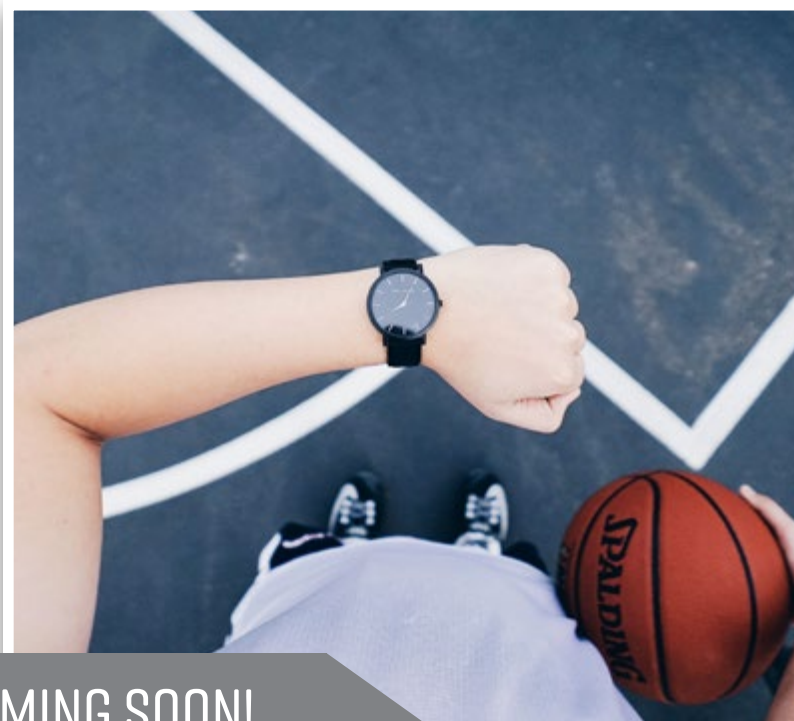

Group Swim Lessons

Starguard group swim lessons are designed to teach students to swim at their own pace and comfort level with water safety being emphasized in each class. Students are evaluated on the first day of class for placement. All classes are taught by Starfish Aquatic Institute certified instructors. Each session includes six 45-minute classes, with multiple daily class times available.

Star Babies/Star Tots 6 months-4 years

Star Tots classes introduce infants and toddlers (with parents) to the water, and help them become comfortable in the water. As students get older, they learn basic swimming techniques, including water safety. Infant and toddler classes require parent participation.

Swim School 4+ years

This class teaches basic swimming skills, including floating, kicking on the wall, holding breath underwater, and learning to swim unassisted for 30 feet.

Stroke School 4+ years

Students learn freestyle, backstroke, butterfly and breast stroke and learn to swim longer distances. Students must pass Swim School or similar program to participate. Cost: \$30 per session.

This course will provide you with the certifications necessary to become a professional lifeguard: CPR/AED, First Aid and Lifeguard Training. Certification is through the Star Guard Aquatics Institute. If you are hired by the City of Oklahoma City and meet specific training and employment requirements, you will receive a training \$200 rebate.

Cost: \$235 per session. Includes class materials.

Age Requirements

To enroll, candidates must be 15 years old before the final scheduled class session. They must be at least 16 years old to work for the city of Oklahoma City.

Qualifications

- Applicants must be able to:
- Swim 300 yards continuously using the front crawl and/or breaststrokes while demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing.
 - Swim 50 yards head-up to sigh for victim without stopping and swim 50 yards head-up with a rescue tube.
 - Tread water for 2 minutes using legs only.
 - Complete a timed swim and underwater brick retrieval.
 - Retrieve a 10-pound weighted object from the bottom of the pool (9-feet deep).

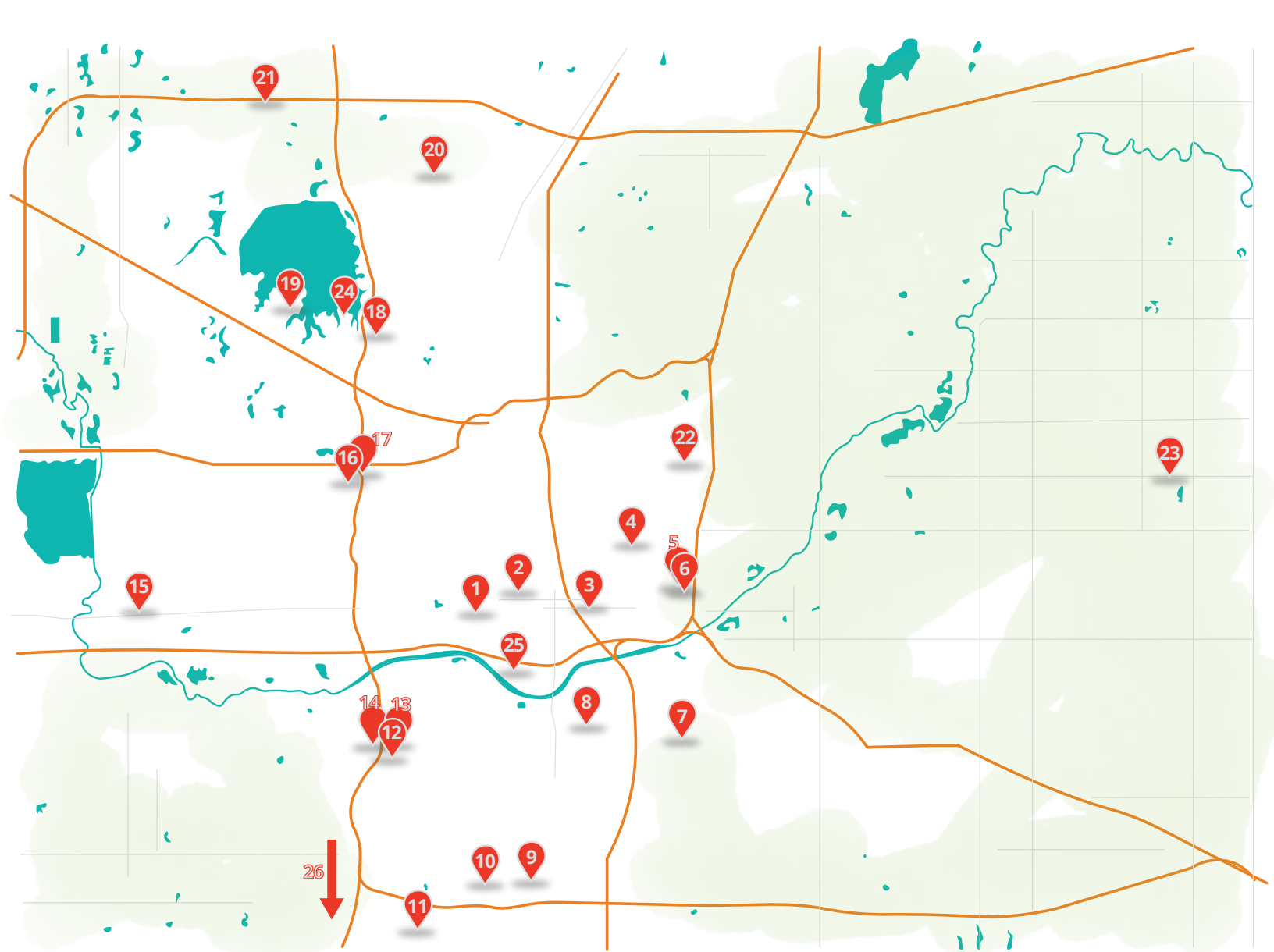
